# A new dawn for local farmers

**Rustenburg** – The Department of Rural, Environment and Agricultural Development (READ) held a meeting with local farmers at the Rustenburg City Hall on 15 January to find a way forward to better sustain agricultural and rural developments. Prominent speakers of READ, including MEC Desbo Mohono were present and addressed the attendees.

The MEC emphasised the importance of working together as a unit and encouraged the farmers to express to the department how they can better assist them in building and sustaining their prospective farming fields. The MEC arranged meetings with farmers across the province as part of her plans to improve stakeholder engagement, public participation and to promote accountability as well as transparency in government.

The event was concluded with a question-and-answer session so that local farmers and prospective farmers can voice their grievances, and suggestions to assist the department with solutions and results.
