MONEY STOL

Rustenburg - Heartless criminals stole donations intended for cancer-fighter, 5-year old Mihla Engelbrecht. Staff members at Party Box in Kock street, Rustenburg, were tied up and held at gunpoint on Saturday 19 January. A large amount of cash was stolen. This money was raised by the community during a coin laying campaign for the shop owner Selmari Pelser's granddaughter Mihla Engelbrecht.

Three men entered the store and waited for the customers to leave before turning on Lena Molapisi, an employee of the store. She was tied up and taken to a room at the back. Lela Mompati, another employee was standing outside when the suspects grabbed her and tied her up.

The perpetrators then proceeded to a locked bathroom where several buckets full of donated cash were held. Another suspect kept guard outside, whilst the criminals loaded buckets filled with donations into a vehicle. While the suspects were busy loading the cash, Lena managed to untie herself and lurched over an electric

fence to raise alarm Once the culprits realised she escaped, they fled the scene.

They got away with a large amount of cash. This money was raised by the community during coin laying campaigns for the shop owner Selmari Pelser's granddaughter Mihla Engelbrecht.

Mihla is a five-year-old girl who was only three when she was diagnosed with cerebral neuroblastoma, a rare form of cancer.

The diagnosis of this rare form of cancer was a devastating shock to Mihla's parents Rudo and Shani.

To receive the best possible treatment, she had to go to the United

States of America (USA) to get treatment. An amount of R6 895 000 was required to save her life.

Mihla has undergone surgery, had a near total resection of the tumour last year and multi-agent chemotherapy was proposed allowing Mihla to be at least five years old before receiving full brain and spinal radiation.

Mihla is currently in New Jersey and is staying at the Ronald McDonald Charity house while undergoing treatment. She has just finished her first ten sessions of craniospinal radiation but still has a long road ahead. Everyone is looking forward to once again see Mihla with her long blond

Police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides confirmed that this matter might be linked to the Sweet Express business robbery that took place a few days earlier, on 14 January

Chris Pieterse. Oom Ben se swaer het egter bevestig dat ten spyte van die feit dat Oom Ben verward was en skaars kon loop. sy maatskaplike werker hom op 14 Desember in Oos Einde langs die pad gaan aflaai het omdat hy geen ander heenkome gehad het nie.

Chris en sy vrou het dadelik plan gemaak om van die Kaap af na Rustenburg te kom om hom te help - maar hulle was te laat.

Op 24 Desember is 'n baie siek en swak Oom Ben gevind waa hy op 'n stuk lap lê in 'n leë huis in Oos Einde.

Hy was dadelik gehaas na Tlhabane kliniek maar moes weereens oorgeplaas word na JST. Oom Ben is op 25 Desember in die ambulans op pad na JST oorlede en is op 4 Januarie begrawe. Daar is baie vrae omtrent Oom Ben se dood en die noodlot van ander persone in sy posisie.
