

RAF donates R1 million worth of medical equipment

Klerksdorp – Road Accident Fund (RAF) donated medical equipment to Klerksdorp Tshepong Hospital Complex on Thursday 7 February worth R1 million. The donation includes two resuscitation beds, two cardiac monitors, a mobile cardiac monitor, mobile ventilator including accessories, and a stationary ventilator.

The hospital complex requested a donation from RAF to increase capacity and decrease turnaround time in the casualty department. The hospital treats a high number of patients who are victims of road accidents. The casualty department treated 13,268 patients between October and December 2018. This number includes 371 cases of motor vehicle accidents and 143 cases of pedestrian accidents.

RAF's corporate service manager Momelezi Kula said the donation is part of the organisation's corporate social responsibility (CSR) which is an integration of social, environmental and economic contribution towards society.

North West Department of Health member of executive council (MEC) Madoda Sambatha accepted the donation on behalf of the hospital complex and thanked RAF. "We appreciate the donation by RAF. The medical equipment will help fast track service delivery especially during emergencies. The donation is already making a difference," the MEC said during the handover ceremony held at the hospital.
