Rustenburg - A local paramedic was arrested on Friday 15 March after police found rock cocaine worth an estimated value of R650 000 in her possession. The paramedic, who appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday 18 March, was apprehended along the R510 after she was pulled off the road and the vehicle she was driving, was searched by the police.

"The police made a follow-up after receiving information that an advanced life support practitioner was in the possession of drugs," lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani said.

Members of the Rustenburg cluster intercepted the marked emergency response vehicle. It was searched and three Ziplock bags containing rock cocaine was found in her possession.

The suspects were arrested after the police were tipped off by a local

allegedly demanded R5 million from the businessman in exchange for a tender. The suspects further demanded an upfront payment of R50 000 deposit – which the businessman agreed to pay a few days later.

The matter was reported to the police, who planned and executed an operation in which the suspects were arrested at the Waterfall Mall. External hard drives, four cellular phones and documents with the

letterhead of the department of local government and human settlements were found in the suspects' possession. The suspects' vehicle, a green and white Ford Mustang, was seized during

the arrest. The police would like to urge anyone who

STABBED AT SCHOOL




