

Rustenburg - On 15 March 2019, Anglo American Platinum donated more than 270 hectares of vacant land to the Rustenburg Local Municipality and the Rustenburg Community Development Trust, heeding president Cyril Ramaphosa's thuma mina ('send me' in isiZulu) call.

More than 5,000 community members, dignitaries and Platinum employees witnessed and celebrated the official handover at the Paardekraal Community Hall.

Executive mayor of the Rustenburg Local Municipality Mpho Khunou lauded Platinum for the continued support they give their local communities, which has developed into a solid relationship with them, reflecting the Company's values of care and respect.

The land will be used for housing and human settlement projects. The Rustenburg Local Municipality received 242 hectares of land, valued at almost R17 million, for mainly housing and community resettlement projects. The land includes Portion 26, Portion 109 and Portion 187 (a portion of Portion 50) of the Farm Paardekraal 279 JQ.

The Rustenburg Community Development Trust has undertaken to construct a home-based care centre, named Mphatlalatsane Tswelopele. The centre will offer home-based care to 155 people and will see to the needs of the disabled and the elderly. The trust will also extend a helping hand to orphans and child-headed households in the area. The donation of land to the trust provides the necessary space for future infrastructure development, which will enable the non-profit organisations to cast a wider net into some of the poorest communities in the region.

In addition, Platinum has refurbished the water reservoir supplying the area and constructed a new sewage treatment plant on the donated land.

In 2014, Anglo American Platinum donated 204 hectares to the Rustenburg Local Municipality for the establishment of two townships in the Bokamoso area. Platinum also funded the main roads to the development, which will ultimately see 4,000 housing units being built with the support of the Department of Human Settlements.

Platinum, in partnership with the municipality and the North West Department of Human Settlements, sourced funding grants for the project and committed subsidies and related grants to the Bokamoso community.

If all stakeholders in South Africa do their bit for land redistribution, then expropriation of land without compensation will only ever need to be implemented as an absolute last resort.

Said chief executive officer Chris Griffith: "We are honoured to partner with the Rustenburg Local Municipality in the development of local communities by making land available that our company no longer requires. Anglo American Platinum's purpose is to re-imagine mining to improve people's lives. One of the ways we do this is by making a lasting contribution to the communities surrounding our operations."
