Call for comments on the Amendment of the Service Level Agreement between Rustenburg Local Municipality and C&M Consulting Engineers (RLM/DCD/0009/2017/18: Appointment of a qualified service provider for Data Management of the Rustenburg Air Quality Monitoring Network for a period of three (03) years).

The Rustenburg Local Municipality Council resolved, as per Item 10 of the 27 February 2019, that a notice for the amendment of the service level Agreement between Rustenburg Local Municipality and C&M Consulting Engineers should be subjected to public participation.

Notice is hereby given in terms of section 116 (3) (b) of Municipal Finance Management Act 56 of 2003 that a Service Level Agreement between Rustenburg Local Municipality and C&M Consulting Engineers: (RLM/DCD/0009/2017/18) appointed for Data Management of the Rustenburg Air Quality Monitoring Network for a Period of three years will be amended due to the following reasons:

- Marikana Air Monitoring Station of the Rustenburg Local Municipality was chosen as one of the stations for the National Air Quality Index (NAQI) reporting in the North West Province by the Department of Environmental Affairs.
- C&M Consulting Engineers was subsequently appointed as a contractor for the Department of Environmental Affairs NAQI Station Management and Reporting Project for a period of five years, of which the Rustenburg Local Municipality contracted the same service provider (C&M Consulting Engineers) for Data Management of Marikana Air Monitoring Station for a period of three years.

C&M will therefore, do maintenance and reporting on this station for a 5-year period for the Department of Environmental Affairs, hence the amendment of the service level agreement to avoid duplication of services by the municipality and the Department.

Copies of the proposed amendment are available for viewing at our website at www.rustenburg.gov.za and the following venues during working hours: Municipal Libraries situated at Boitekong, Karlienpark, Marikana and Rustenburg. Municipal Regional Community Centres (RCC) situated in Boitekong, Lethabong, Monnakato, Marikana, Phatsima and Thabane.

An invitation is hereby made in terms of MFMA section 116 (3) (a) that the reasons for the proposed amendment have been tabled in the council of the municipality. Attention is specifically drawn to the fact that in terms of section 116(b) the local community must be given reasonable notice of the intention to amend the contract or agreement; and must invited to submit representations to the municipality or municipal entity.
