Her newsletter – Tank Girls – has almost 30,000 subscribers and it documents her completely unplanned biking adventures with friends worldwide. She races, performs stunts, and has attended almost every rally countrywide... and now she's getting ready to impress audiences at the South Coast Bike Fest™ as part of the Shredbetty's performance.

"I'm nervous but really looking forward to this year's South Coast Bike Fest™," said Skinny. "My now famous Yamaha R6 – 'Billy Bob' – is a little injured so I'll be performing on another bike for the festival. It should be interesting!"

NEWRAK IMPALA AIMS  
FOR ANOTHER WIN

**Rustenburg** – Newrak Impala defeated Welkom Rugby Club 50-19 on Saturday 30 March to reach the semi-final of the Gold Cup. They are hoping that the advantage of playing at their home ground will once again count in their favour.

The team will now face Northam Rhinos on Saturday 6 April at Impala Rugby Club, anticipating another inspiring performance from their players as they look for a victory that will book their place in the final.

Some of the players to watch out for include André Grobler and André Olivier, who both performed exceptionally well during the victory over Welkom Rugby Club. Although they were champions in 2014 and 2016 Gold Cups, they will face a stiff challenge from the Northam Rhinos team, also eager to reach the finals.

Entrance for the game will cost just R10 and proceeds will go to Jaco Fourie, who suffered lung injuries, a hip fracture and a C2 neck fracture in a car crash on 24 March 2018. Jaco, who has been on a steady path to recovery since then, needs funds to undergo physiotherapy, speech therapy and occupational therapy.

What makes this match particularly special is that both teams represent two Rustenburg mining groups, and bragging rights are likely to motivate the players to go all out for victory.

From a spectator's point of view, contractors who have business interests in the two mining companies, friends and neighbours will be watching the game with anticipation from the very first drop kick at 16:00.

Apart from the action on the field, supporters can

also look forward to a fun outing for the whole family with tasty food, drinks and jumping castles for the kids.
