During the accident, Jaco sustained lung injuries, a hip fracture and a C2 neck fracture. He was connected to a ventilator and was kept under sedation. He was later transferred to rehab where he remained until 20 February 2019 and is now back home with his family and smiling. Jaco is starting to string words into sentences. When you ask him how he is doing, he proudly gives a thumbs-up! Jaco celebrated his 21st birthday on 3 March.

Being with his family has accelerated his healing process and he is doing very well. However, he has a long expensive road to recovery ahead of him. "The next step towards recovery is physiotherapy, speech therapy and occupational therapy. He also requires a full-time caregiver. Because of his keen rugby acumen, it was decided that a rugby day was the way to go, to help raise funds," said Jaco Fourie Senior, Jaco's dad.
