Rustenburg – I would like to draw your attention to the hardships we are enduring here in Seraleng, after we were relocated from the Yizo-Yizo informal settlement by the municipality.

We are living in an area called Nkandla RDP houses and our standard of living is nowhere near what we were promised.

There are no water services or electricity (despite electricity cables in our area) and our drains are always blocked.

People here are using wheelbarrows to fetch water and we are living in very filthy conditions.

We call upon the municipality to take immediate action and deliver on the promises they made to us.
