
warning to the community **FAKE COPS**

Rustenburg – Police are urging the community to be vigilant after two men were robbed on the R24 road outside Rustenburg on Wednesday 29 May.

According to police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, three males in a white Toyota Corolla Quest with blue lights on the dash posed as police officers. They pulled over the two men and robbed them of their cash and cell phones.

Beware the dangers of hitchhiking!

"The suspect, who had threatened the woman with a toy gun, was arrested as he tried to flee," police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said.

According to police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, this was not the thieves' first offence.







The 'clients' scam

Rustenburg - A local dietician was tied up and robbed after three suspects, a man and two women entered her practice pretending to be clients.

According to police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, the dietician runs her business from home. The suspects convinced the dietician to consult with them simultaneously. Once they entered the consultation room, they pulled out a firearm, and robbed and assaulted her at gunpoint. The suspects fled with electronics and jewellery among other items.

No arrests have been made as yet.

"We urge the community to be vigilant. This is not the first case where the culprits pretended to be clients to gain access to a home. Try to not be alone when consulting with unknown clients," said sergeant Ofentse.
