PLANNING FOR CHANGE

Rustenburg – Agapé Gemeente hosted a meeting on Wednesday 29 May to discuss the future of Rustenburg.

Official representatives from three of the four big mining companies, Rustenburg Chamber of Commerce, Rustenburg Local Municipality, companies like Standard Bank, a member of Parliament, and pastors from the Rustenburg Church Leaders Indaba attended the meeting.

The chairman was doctor Braam Hanekom from the Centre of Public Witness, and the host was Reverent Dawie de Koker from Agapé Gemeente.

The aim of the gathering was to bring together the big role players in our community to discuss and plan the way forward to bring a

positive change to Rustenburg.

The group reached consensus that they need to collaborate and work together to address the *Big Seven Giants* that are facing the Rustenburg community.

These seven giants are:

- The long-term sustainability of the mines
- Massive unemployment
- Crime and violence
- Absence of law and order
- Drugs and human trafficking
- Education and skills development
- A broken community with broken families and loss of hope

A follow-up meeting is planned for July, and a multi-stakeholder conference is planned for September.
