RHS MAAK SKOONSKIP

Rustenburg – Die eerste netbalspan van die Hoërskool Rustenburg (RHS) spog ná die pas afgelope Suid-Afrikaanse skole-netbalkampioenskappe van die top skole met 'n volledige stel SA medaljes.

RHS het in die eindstryd van dié toernooi, wat van 19 tot 21 Julie by die Hoërskool EG Jansen in Boksburg plaasgevind het, teen die span van die Afrikaans Hoër Meisieskool (Affies) vasgeval. Die telling was 23-35.

Die meisies in groen het sewe wedstryde gespeel om vir die eindstryd te kwalifiseer. Hulle het in dié opmars met 72-1 met die span van Nqabara Secondary School van die Oos-Kaap afgereken, gevolg deur 'n oortuigende 34-24 oorwinning oor die Hoërskool Goudveld, 33-29 oor Stellenberg, 49-8 oor Idlangamabala Secondary School, 30-29 oor Eldoraigne, 29-19 oor Waterkloof en 34-24 oor Shayamoya Secondary School van Kokstad.

Elsa Morris, wat die afgelope vyf jaar die span afrig, sê haar span het vanjaar altesaam 43 wedstryde gespeel waarvan hulle enigste twee nederlae juis teen die van Affies was.

Die span bestaan uit sewe matrieks vir wie netbal hul passie is en drie graad 11's wat bereid was om die span se kampioene met karakter-integriteit, werketiek en waardes te laat voortleef. Hierdie meisies is bereid om ongelooflik hard te werk en hulle speel vir mekaar en glo in mekaar. Die span se leuse vir vanjaar was 'Doen jou bes, God die res'.

Só 'n medalje val beslis nie in 'n span se skoot nie. Hul het vanjaar 1,727 doele aangeteken. Die meeste van die spanlede speel reeds sedert graad agt saam en sommiges van hul laerskooldae af. As o/14's het die span derde geëindig by die SAs, o/16 was hulle die SA-wenners en vanjaar se silwer medalje rond die stel nou mooi af.
