

WOMEN ON THE MOVE

Rustenburg/ Mooinooi – Women and children of Grace Help Centre celebrated the second ‘Women on the move’ event on Saturday 17 August. They sang, danced and laughed during celebrations held to honour the virtues and strength of women and children who have overcome domestic violence and abuse.

This event is about encouraging the survivors to have a positive outlook towards life and not to let their past experiences dictate their future.

This activity has become an important part of Grace Help Centre’s initiative of providing emergency care, shelter and support to victims of gender-based violence, human-trafficking, abandoned new-borns and abused children.

The survivors were addressed and encouraged by various speakers. The children from the centre performed a play which showed how love and care

towards people in abusive relationships can turn around lives.

“Sometimes, there are people who come to the centre with only the clothes on their backs. We give them hope, we find work for them, we nourish, encourage and take care of them,” Grace Help Centre founder Rina van der Berg explained.

“We’ve been doing this for more than 20 years now and the aim is to empower survivors of abuse so that they can continue with their lives” she added.

Masechaba Makhena, who has been working very closely with Rina over the years, reminded the audience that they are all special and that they must be confident in the way they approach life.

Currently, Grace Help Centre takes care of 50 children and 20 women.
