# I HAVE A DREAM

**Rustenburg/Freedom Park** – I am a dreamer foundation is a non-profit organisation that focuses on empowering orphans and vulnerable children to achieve their goals. They are making a positive difference in the Freedom Park community. Founded by Simon Mapakanye in 2016, the organisation currently has 220 orphaned and vulnerable children under its wing. "The children are being taken care of by guardians or relatives. Each day, after school, we teach and advise the young boys to stay away from drugs and alcohol abuse and show them how to be responsible adults," Simon told *Platinum Weekly*. "There are many activities that the girls take part in and we teach them about issues related to womanhood," he added. Although the organisation does not have an administrative structure yet, it is playing a positive role in the lives of these children. "We are appealing for assistance from well-wishers. We aim to construct a facility to accommodate the children.
