



N4 HIGHWAY CLAIMS FOUR LIVES

Rustenburg – Rustenburg Police are investigating a case of culpable homicide following a head-on collision on the N4 outside Rustenburg on the morning of Saturday 24 August. Two vehicles, a Mercedes-Benz AGM and a Renault Duster were involved in the accident. According to police spokesperson Captain Elasabé Augoustides the driver of the Mercedes-Benz, Motsiri Mokoane was killed in the accident. He is the owner of his own VIP Protection/Security Company and was the designated driver for the well-known doctor Thandi Ndlovu. They were on their way from Johannesburg to attend a funeral in Rustenburg. Doctor Thandi sustained critical injuries and was transported to a local hospital, where she succumbed to her injuries later that day. The occupants of the Renault Duster, Arend Keulder and his brother Joubert Keulder who were traveling from Zeerust to Pretoria both died on impact.

DOUBLE MURDER- SUICIDE

Mogwase – A 51-year old man shot his girlfriend (45) and killed both her daughters (11 and 15) before presumably killing himself. The incident happened at Ramasedi Section, Legkraal village near Mogwase, after the couple had a quarrel. According to police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani, the suspect forced his girlfriend to accompany him into the veld where a fight ensued. It is alleged that he shot her in the shoulder before she managed to escape. The suspect then drove to her house where he shot and killed her two daughters while they were sleeping. He fled the scene in a Nissan bakkie. The burnt-out vehicle was later discovered about 20km from the murder scene, containing the charred remains of the suspect. The mother was taken to a local hospital where she is currently recovering. The provincial commissioner of North West, lieutenant general Baile Motswenyane condemned the incident which occurred during Women's Month. She said that it is disturbing to think that the victims were allegedly shot by someone who they turned to for protection. "While the police are doing their best to deal effectively with violence against women and children, it is important that professional assistance is sought to ensure that disputes are resolved amicably," said Baile. Police are investigating two counts of murder and one of attempted murder.



OLYMPIA PARK BECOMES AFTER HOURS CRIME HOTSPOT

Rustenburg – Olympia Park, the multi-purpose stadium with various sport fields and spectator seats, is a hotspot for sport enthusiasts. Recently the stadium has been marked with an increase in crime in its vicinity, especially after dark. In an interview with *Platinum Weekly* on 28 August, police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides firmly warned the community not to visit the stadium at night. "Criminals seek out secluded vehicles and visitors who they can rob. We would like to warn the community to not: go to the stadium alone or after dark to avoid becoming a victim of these criminals. Always be vigilant."
