

GIVING HOPE TO THE HOPELESS

Rustenburg – Alicia Ramdharee lost her entire family at the age of 12. This was after her dad shot and killed her mother, brother and sister before turning the gun on himself. While she could have allowed this tragic event to overshadow the rest of her life, she arose from the ashes, making a positive impact in the lives of people on the verge of committing suicide. "My dad killed our family and himself

in Durban. I survived because I was on holiday in Johannesburg," Alicia said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*. Alicia, who now lives in Safari Gardens, runs a Facebook suicide awareness support group, 'Surviving Suicide'. With more than 1,000 members, the group has provided counselling and advice. "I am using my story and strength to create awareness about suicide and the stigma that is attached to it," said Alicia.

"I am a trauma de-briefer and we also have a counsellor in the group who is always ready to assist when needed." With September being suicide awareness month, Alicia encourages those who feel helpless, hopeless and who feel like suicide is the only solution left, to seek help.

MULTI-MILLION RAND RUSTENBURG MALL UNDERWAY

Rustenburg – Rustenburg shoppers can look forward to a brand-new shopping centre – Rustenburg Mall – set to introduce its first phase in April 2021.

The Moolman Group, Twin City and JB Holdings have joined forces in this exciting development. Collectively, they own and manage around 750,000m² of gross leasable area (GLA) across their retail portfolios, including properties in the North West Province, with more than 100 years of retail experience behind them. On 6 August the investors had their sod-turning ceremony to celebrate the commencement of bulk earthworks on the new property.

The project will be a one-stop solution, providing shoppers with a convenient and safe shopping environment. "Rustenburg Mall will aim to address the current scattered retail shopping offering in the area, with a focus on a family-friendly shopping experience," said Steph Beyers of the Moolman Group.

The new mall is near the Rustenburg CBD, conveniently located 500 metres from the main taxi rank. It will serve more than 80,000 households in the primary trade area, which includes established suburbs such as Geelhoutpark, Proteapark, Karlienpark and the newer suburbs of Tlhabane and Tlhabane West. The mall will accommodate approximately 120 retailers as part of the first phase, measuring over 40,000m².

Dis-Chem, Shoprite, Checkers, Game and Woolworths will be the anchor tenants at Rustenburg Mall. Other tenants will include Cape Union Mart, Old Khaki, Tread & Miller, Keedo, Foschini, Fabiani, G-Star, American Swiss, Truworths, Identity, Kurt Geiger, Spitz, Contempo, Clicks, Mr Price Home, Miladys, Mr Price Apparel, Mr Price Sport, Totalsports, Exact, Sportscene, Markham, The Fix, Sterns, Cross Trainer, Jam Clothing, Pep, Ackermans, Power Clothing, Beaver Canoe, Legit, Side Step, Skipper Bar, Dodos, Sheet Street, Rand Outfitters, Chicken Licken, Debonairs, Roots Butchery, ABSA, Nedbank and Capitec Bank.

The current road infrastructure around the development will be enhanced and new roads will boost access and traffic flow in the area. Hedeira and Watsonia roads will be extended to improve access from the surrounding suburbs and main arterials will stem from the Rustenburg CBD to provide easy access to motorists, busses and taxis.

Rustenburg Mall will make a positive contribution to the South African job market by creating 800 jobs in the construction phase; and with more than 75% of the first phase GLA already committed for occupation by keen retailers, and 1,000 permanent jobs will be created once the mall is open and trading.
