
WHY SHOULD YOUR HOME **NUMBER BE CLEARLY VISIBLE?**

Our renewed focus on passionate resilient safety leadership and mining discipline has driven improvements in our safety performance but we are not yet where we must be.

Our health strategy addresses occupational and non-occupational health and is focused on preventing harm to our employees. It is structured around three main pillars: wellness, education, and treatment. The principal health risks facing our employees are pulmonary tuberculosis (TB) and the associated human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) co-infection, both of which are of epidemic proportions in southern Africa. The major occupational health risk associated with our mining is noise-induced hearing loss (NIHL). Other risks relate to lifestyle health risks, particularly smoking, nutrition, stress and mental wellbeing.
