GBV is violence that is directed at an individual based on his or her gender. It includes physical, sexual, verbal, emotional, and psychological abuse, threats, coercion as well as economic and educational deprivation.

By keeping open the channels of communication between you and your child, you will give them the confidence they need to confide in you if they feel victimised or are exposed to GBV at school.

They will also develop the necessary skills to assist other learners who might need help.

Statistics from the United Nations Children's Fund website are just a small indication of the seriousness of GBV towards girls. According to research, up to 120 million girls from

every corner of the world will have experienced sexual violence. On their way to school, in classrooms, at homes,

in refugee camps, and on playgrounds - girls experience harassment and violence. Globally, more than eight out of 10 girls experience

street harassment before they turn 17.
