# It's almost time for soup

**Rustenburg** – The days are getting shorter and the cool breeze of the winter can be felt in the evenings.

As the leaves start turning brown and we all get our jackets and blankets from the back of the cupboard we know that winter is coming.

It is almost time to snuggle up in front of the television with a hot cup of soup, so why not try this one?

**Lucia's pea soup**

1kg dried split peas  
1 onion  
28g bacon or ham  
500g lamb shanks  
1 celery  
1 grated carrot  
8 cups of cold water  
1 tablespoon flour  
1 tablespoon butter  
1 cup of milk  
1 tablespoon of parsley (optional)  
Salt and pepper according to taste

**Instructions**

Wash the peas and let it soak in water during the night. In the morning, throw off the water.

Add peas, lamb shanks and cold water to a pot. Slowly

bring to a boil and add the vegetables, celery and bacon. Let the mixture cook for about two hours. Once the vegetables are soft, mash everything together. You can also push the mixture through a sieve to ensure that there are no lumps.

In a small saucepan, melt butter over medium heat. Whisk in the flour until smooth, remove from the stove and add salt, pepper and parsley. Gradually mix in the milk with the flour and butter. Add the completed butter/flower mixture to the soup. Let it simmer for about two minutes until the soup is nice and thick.



## RESTORATION OF ORDER AT MANKWE CAMPUS

**Mankwe** – Order has been restored at Mankwe Campus after the protest action that was initiated by student representative committee (SRC) members was called off on Wednesday, 4 March. Senior management visited the campus together with representatives from the Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) when they were approached by students who were frustrated and desperate to continue with their studies.

After deliberations between students, management and SRC members, the gates to the campus were opened.

Assistance to affected students to catch up with their academic backlog is currently a key priority. Campus management is in the process of developing academic catch-up plans to help students to meet academic demands they face after having lost out on a considerable amount of teaching and learning time.

The non-attendance of classes due to the strike will not affect bursary beneficiaries to receive their allowances and tuition fees. With the campus being operational, students must attend classes

as the 80% class attendance remains a factor in determining receipt of the monthly allowance from NSFAS.

With the campus in operation, proper attention will now also be given to the maintenance of Campus infrastructure as a matter of priority for the safety and wellbeing of enrolled students.

The matter relating to the academic exclusion of the former SRC president has not been resolved and is still pending the enrolment processes of the college.
