

MASSA PATROLLIE GROOT SUKSES

Rustenburg - Verskeie Rustenburg patrolliegroepe het misdadigers ore aangesit tydens die massa-patrollie van Vrydag 13 tot Saterdag 14 Maart. Die suksesvolle massa-patrollie is deur AfriForum Buurtwag se Rustenburg-tak aangebied en het ondersteuning gehad van groepe soos die Rustenburg Community Crime Forum (RCCF), Gemeenskap Polisie Forum (GPF), Wen Komando, Bojanala Crime Unit en die NCA. Daar het ongeveer 164 mense deelgeneem wat altesaam 538 man-ure ingesit het en 1 704 km is afgeleë om die kriminele op te hok. Die gesamentlike operasionele sentrum was by die Gereformeerde Kerk Wes se saal waar die massas as

een man saamgestaan het. Die patrollie het nie net in Rustenburg plaasgevind nie maar AfriForum se buurt - en plaaswagte in Brits, Coligny, Hartbeespoort, Koster, Mooi-nooi en Zeerust het ook in hul verskeie areas aan patrollies deelgeneem om polisiëringsigbaarheid te verhoog. Altesaam het 637 patrolleerders 7 304 km in 348 voertuie afgeleë. AfriForum het vyf insidente hanteer, wat huismoles, die ondersoek van vuurwapenskote en poging tot huisbraak ingesluit het. "AfriForum se veiligheidsstrukture in Marico sal aanhou om veiligheidskwesties in dorpe op te los en sigbaarheid in die streek te verbeter. Ons strategie is proaktief en fokus daarop om pogings tot misdaad

te verminder. Veiligheid is baie belangrik in enige gemeenskap en die AfriForum-takke neem dit ook baie ernstig op. Met goeie samewerking tussen AfriForum-buurtwagte, die SAPD en ander rolspele kan ons soveel meer bereik en ons gemeenskappe beter beveilig," sê AfriForum distrikskoördineerder vir Marico Petrus Coetzee. AfriForum Buurtwag Rustenburg-tak voorsitter Dawie Odendaal en AfriForum Buurtwag Rustenburg-tak lid Marlene Odendaal wil graag baie dankie sê aan dominee Ockert Oosthuizen vir die kerksaal, Peter Frankleyn, Jan Erasmus en Cemblocks vir die koeldranke, Nadene Loots vir die worsrolletjies, RCCF vir die wors, Sanet Odendaal vir die vuurmaakhout,

Pack & Spice vir die kerrie en rys bakkies. Marlene Odendaal het ook gesorg vir die botteltjies water en al die kos voorbereiding. Die volgende massapatrollie sal op 19 Junie plaasvind en AfriForum Buurtwag Rustenburg-tak beplan om weer vir al die deelnemers van kos en drinkgoed te voorsien, wat sal insluit: groentesop met brood, worsrolletjies, koeldrank, water, koffie en tee.

Despite high demand and high impact, the low affordability and inadequate funding compromises the feasibility of the occupation and in turn the ability of Business Advisors to self-fund their professional development.

- At least a D-symbol in Higher Grade Mathematics and English or C-Symbol in Standard Grade Mathematics and English; or 60% (achievement level 5) in N4 level Mathematics and English
- Computer literacy
- Interested in a career in business advising
- Committed to remaining in the programme for the full duration (6 months)

2. BUSINESS ADVISORY CANDIDACY PROGRAMME (100 CANDIDATES)

The SETAs Workplace Based Learning Programme Agreement Regulations, 2018, issued on 16 November 2018 define 'Candidacy' to mean a period of workplace based learning undertaken by a graduate as part of the requirement for registration as a professional in the required professional designation as stipulated by a professional body. Participants in a candidacy programme will undergo a combination of a pre-assessment and skills programmes training, which will be supported by a mentoring and coaching of candidates by experienced mentors in partnership with a national professional body. The outputs for a Candidacy programme will include:

- The gaining of skills, experience and competencies in business advising by candidates and possible awarding of professional designations by relevant professional bodies, thus contributing the drive towards professionalization of business advising. These will be higher level business advisors.
- Support to plus-minus 500 SMMEs with business advisory support by the candidates as part of the experiential learning and collection of PoE's during the candidacy: and the
- Creation of about 100 business advising Micro-enterprises.

5. Under the age of 35 years
