# DIESEL THIEVES CAUGHT RED-HANDED


Rustenburg – Two people were arrested along the R104 in Rustenburg on Saturday 11 July for the theft of diesel worth an estimated R480,000.

The long arm of the law caught up with the two during a multipronged operation involving the Hawks, police from the crime intelligence unit, K9 and flying squad units as well as personnel from Transnet.

'The suspects were allegedly caught while illegally extracting diesel from an underground pipeline site in Rustenburg and pumping it into a fuel tanker," Hawks spokesperson Tlangelani Rikhotso said. "Two of the three suspects were arrested immediately, while the third suspect managed to escape. The fuel tanker and other equipment were seized for further investigations.

The two suspects appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court to face charges related to tampering with essential infrastructure and theft of diesel. Further investigations are being carried out by the Hawks.

Rustenburg - Illegal structures, recently erected by a group of people who also started demarcating the land were demolished by the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) on Saturday 11 July. The piece of land in question, which is situated along the Dinie Estates Road outside Rustenburg, is owned by the municipality.

RLM spokesperson David Magae said the demolition was carried out by the municipality's law enforcement unit. All illegally built structures and partially completed dwellings were demolished and removed using tractor-loader-backhoes

Personnel from the South African Police Service (SAPS) as well as the South African National Defence Force (SANDF) were also present and made sure that law and order were maintained during the operation.

Magae told Platinum Weekly that the action was necessary and should serve as a warning against those bent on undermining the rule of law. He said: "People wanted to take over the land there, so the municipality had no choice but to move in and remove their structures.'
