ELDERLY WOMAN BEATEN INTO A COMA

Rustenburg – A 72-year-old woman is currently in a coma after she was severely assaulted on Thursday 24 September. According to police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides, the woman came across an intruder in her garden when she arrived at home. She yelled at him and he fled the scene. Later that afternoon, the victim's family received a call from their security company saying that someone pressed the panic button. They requested the company to please go and check on the woman as she was home alone. When they arrived on the scene, they found the elderly victim lying on the floor. She was rushed to hospital where she is currently in a critical condition. The attackers fled the scene with a laptop, cellphone and a 3G device as well as keys to her house and her car. Police are investigating cases of house robbery and attempted murder.





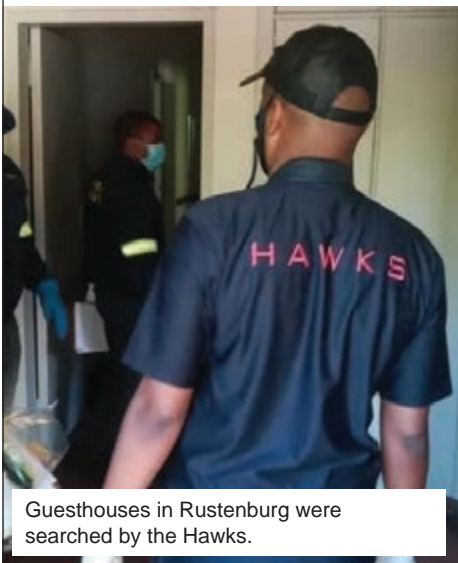

NO COURT DATE FOR SUSPECTED HUMAN TRAFFICKERS



Guesthouses in Rustenburg were searched by the Hawks.

Rustenburg – Three suspects arrested in Rustenburg on allegations of human trafficking and operating a brothel are yet to appear before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court after the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) decided that the state needed to gather more evidence before prosecuting. The suspects were supposed to make their first court appearance on Tuesday 29 September after they were nabbed in Rustenburg by the Hawks and other law enforcement agents three days before. However, this did not realise at the time of going to print and it is not yet clear if the suspects are still in police custody. NPA spokesperson for the North West, Henry Mamothame, said: "Two foreign nationals and one South African were arrested and charged for alleged human trafficking and operating a brothel respectively. However, the case was not registered on the court roll by

the NPA. It was referred back to the Hawks for further investigations." The three were part of a group of suspects who were nabbed during two simultaneous Hawks-led operations in Rustenburg and Kuruman. Three guesthouses – two in Rustenburg and another in Kuruman – were shut down during the raids on allegations they were being run as brothels. Hawks spokesperson brigadier Hangwani Mulaudzi said seven victims who had allegedly been lured into prostitution through fake promises of employment were also rescued in Rustenburg. Meanwhile, the Kuruman suspects have appeared in court on charges of human trafficking. Chikwuma Emmanuel Ibekwe, Ifeanhi Michel Udechui and Emmanuel Ikechkwu will remain in police custody until their next court appearance on Tuesday 6 October.

MOB JUSTICE MURDER AT DINIE ESTATES

Rustenburg – A man who was allegedly implicated in the murder of a woman on a smallholding on the Dinie Estates road on Sunday 27 September was identified by the community... who then decided to take justice into their own hands. The woman was brutally murdered earlier that day. According to police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides, the man was found in a tavern and severely assaulted by members of the community. He succumbed to his injuries. The next morning the police arrested seven people who were allegedly involved in the murder of the man. Outraged by their arrest, the community demanded their release.

They closed off the Dinie Estates road and burned tyres in protest. At the time of going to print, the details around their court appearance was not yet available.



SERIAL RAPIST TO SPEND A LONG TIME IN JAIL

Mogwase – A 45-year old man who was serving a 25-year jail term for rape, will be behind bars for much longer after he was sentenced to three

additional life terms by the Mogwase Regional Court on Monday 28 September.

A further three life terms were handed down by the court after the state proved the man was also responsible for a string of further sexual offences. The additional sentence was handed down after police investigators uncovered how the man was behind separate incidents of rape, armed robbery, and illegal possession of firearms.

The man was first sentenced on 12 December 2017 after he had been convicted of raping a 15-year-old child, armed robbery, and illegal possession of a firearm and ammunition. Further investigations led by sergeant Matlhomola Mokodutlo revealed that the man also robbed and raped other victims from March 2012 to October 2017 at the small and rural village of Mabasakraal, just outside Sun City.

In one of the incidents which occurred in 2012, the man approached a 35-year-old victim while she was sleeping, threatened her with a knife before raping her. A few days later, the man kidnapped and repeatedly raped a 56-year-old woman.

In another incident which occurred in July 2013, the suspect approached yet another woman who was sleeping in her room. He threatened her before overpowering and raping her.

"The accused was linked with all these three cases through forensic evidence," police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh said. "Apart from the three life sentences, the accused was also sentenced to a further five years for housebreaking with the intent to kidnap and fifteen years for kidnapping the 56-year-old woman. The sentences will run concurrently with the three life terms."

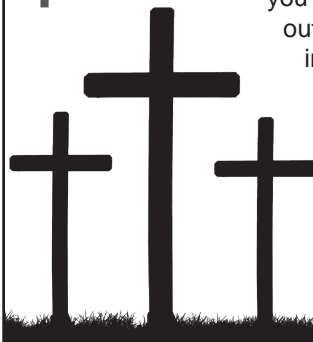
²⁷ "But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, ²⁸ bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. ²⁹ If someone slaps you on one cheek, turn to them the other also. 4 ESCAPE FROM POLICE CUSTODY... 1 REARRESTED

Hartbeesfontein – One of the four men who escaped from police custody in Hartbeesfontein on Saturday 26 September has been rearrested.

Tebogo Moloko's 'freedom' lasted for four days only. He was rearrested in Coligny on Wednesday 9 September. The suspect, who was due to stand trial for business robbery, will now also stand trial for escaping from police detention when he appears before the Hartbeesfontein Magistrates' Court.

Police are calling on anyone with information about the whereabouts of the remaining trio – Tebogo Monnamogolo, Piet Sechele and Ranthati Mothobi – to come forward. All three suspects have pending cases and were due to

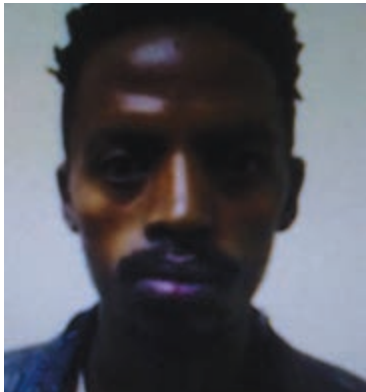
appear in court for charges related to burglary, murder, and rape before they escaped. The circumstances surrounding their escape are not yet clear.

"The escape was discovered during a routine cell inspection at the police station. The police are currently busy with an internal investigation to determine the circumstances surrounding the escape," police spokesperson captain Aafje Botma said. "Members of the community are urged not to try and apprehend or confront any of the escapees as they are dangerous."

THE FALL OF TREES ...and the rule of law



Rustenburg – For many years, September has been celebrated as Arbour Month in South Africa. This year, the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries chose the inspiring theme *Trees in our lives*. This theme should resonate well with people living and working in Rustenburg – we are blessed with magnificent and diverse indigenous trees that grace our town, suburbs, and surrounding areas. Unfortunately, unscrupulous and large-scale tree felling has been taking place along the Magaliesberg Protected Environment adjoining the Kgawane Nature Reserve, as well as other areas that still have indigenous vegetation.

No doubt this is partly due to the many people who find themselves in economic difficulties – but even so – disregarding environmental legislation that has been put in place after careful consideration of climate change, air quality, species facing extinction and the functioning of ecosystems, should not be condoned or supported.

The rule of law is that before removing significant amounts of any natural resource such as indigenous trees, the harvester should approach the competent environmental authority – which is the North West Province - Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT). Expertise exists within DEDECT to determine whether the tree species that will be removed is protected or has medicinal or cultural value in the area. DEDECT should also be able to make recommendations on how felling should be done to induce regrowth, give inputs on what area could be cleared or selectively cleared to protect threatened and protected species, improve pasture or biodiversity and prevent soil erosion and ecosystem deterioration. There are many areas in the bushveld where the inappropriate use or control of veld fires or the introduction of cattle, has resulted in overgrowth of one species of woody plant known as

bush encroachment. It would be beneficial to remove such species for firewood.

Due to the large-scale poaching of indigenous wood from natural areas, people who appreciate trees must start to ask questions about the source of braai wood before they buy it. Even deadwood should not be removed from the environment as it provides a habitat for insects, food for birds and lizards and enriches the soil.

Any suspicious tree cutting should be reported locally to Rustenburg Nature conservator Simon Netshithuthuni on 083 702 3065 or Hanlie Strydom at the National environmental crimes and incidents hotline on 012 001 7641 or office@theline.co.za. Remember to supply the date, time, clear location, number plate of the vehicle and a few lines describing the problem.

RUSTENBURG ROADS CLAIM FOUR LIVES

Rustenburg – One person was killed, and four others were left injured in a collision between a truck and a light motor vehicle on the R104 between Rustenburg and Buffelspoort on Friday 25 September.

According to an ER24 press release, dated 26 September, paramedics arrived at the scene shortly before 13:00 and found the driver and the passenger still inside the light motor vehicle. Unfortunately, the driver of the vehicle was showing no signs of life and was declared dead at the scene. The passenger sustained serious injuries and was treated at the scene before being transported to a hospital for further medical care.

The truck driver and two occupants sustained

injuries ranging from minor to moderate. ER24, as well as another service, treated them at the scene before transporting them to the hospital for further medical care. The exact circumstances surrounding the incident were not known to our paramedics, but local authorities were on the scene for further investigations.

Later that same evening, three people were killed in a collision between two vehicles on the N4 between Rustenburg and Moedwil.

When ER24 paramedics arrived at the scene shortly after 19:00, they found two people in the one-vehicle who had sustained fatal injuries. The driver of the second vehicle also sustained fatal injuries. All three were declared dead at the scene by paramedics.

POLICE CONFIRM ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING INCIDENT

Tlhabane/ Rustenburg – A case of attempted kidnapping was registered in Tlhabane after a 12-year-old learner was allegedly forced into a silver-grey Kia Picanto on Monday 28 September.

According to police spokesperson Captain Elsalé Augoustides, the incident occurred in Ramokoka street in the vicinity of Chill Tavern. The three males – speaking a ‘foreign’ language – forced the child into the vehicle. The driver of a white bakkie observed what was happening. About 700m further, the driver of the Kia stopped when he noticed that the bakkie was following them. They urged the child to get out of the vehicle and sped off.

Captain Elsalé said that this is the first incident of its kind in the Rustenburg district and that the case is being investigated. Police urge parents to, where possible, ensure that their children are accompanied by an adult when walking home from school. “Teach children to be aware of their surroundings and look out for people who might be following them. If they notice that they are being followed, advise them to run in the opposite direction and shout as loudly as they can to get the attention of bystanders.”

ATTEMPTED ABDUCTION OF LEARNER [LETTER TO THE EDITOR]

Rustenburg – At Meridian, the safety of our learners, staff and their families are our number one priority. Today I am writing to inform you about a serious incident involving the attempted abduction of a Grade 6 learner.

On Monday, 28 September, one of our learners on her way home was forced into a vehicle. Fortunately, a person travelling in another vehicle saw the incident and followed the car. Once the kidnappers realised that they were being followed, they dropped the learner off unscathed. The learners sought help and the authorities and police were contacted immediately.

Cases can be very unsettling for parents and learners... but my goal is to inform you of these incidents so that you can be proactive in getting the information out to the community that might be useful in protecting our children.

Learners and parents must always be alert whether they are walking to from school, at the mall and even at home – everywhere. We would like to urge parents to be punctual when collecting learners as at our school there is only supervision until 15:00. We will continue to provide support to the family and their identities will not be made public. If any other similar incidents are brought to your attention, please inform your child’s school as well as the authorities immediately.

GRADE 5 LEARNER HIDES IN BATHROOM WHILE THUGS RANSACK THE HOUSE

Rustenburg – A Grade 5 learner of Laerskool Vastrap and the family’s cleaning lady were left traumatised after three men gained access to their home on Tuesday 29 September.

In an interview with *Platinum Weekly* the girl’s mother said that the girl was at home with the cleaning lady while her older sister went to the dentist. She heard the front gate opening and first thought it was her sister returning, but when she looked through the window, she saw a man

sitting in the driver’s seat of a white Toyota Yaris while two unknown men were entering the property.

She grabbed her phone and warned the cleaning lady to go and hide somewhere as there were two assailants in the yard. She then locked herself in the bathroom. Before the cleaning lady could react, the two men were standing in front of the sliding door. They used a knife to open the door.

The one man held the cleaning lady down while the other ransacked the house.

The girl, still trapped in the bathroom, phoned her father who immediately alerted their security company while staying on the line with his daughter.

One of the suspects was unsuccessful in trying to force open the bathroom door. It was very difficult for her dad to stay calm as he heard his daughter yelling at the intruder to leave her alone.

The call to the girl’s father was made at 10:57 and video footage shows the criminals leaving the neighbourhood at 11:11.

Kroondal – As residents on the Arnoldstad road... we are no strangers to power outages.

This has become a regular occurrence where we are left without electricity for hours. However, we reached a new low on Thursday 24 September when our six-day struggle began.

A reckless driver ran over one of the power poles, leaving several smallholdings in the area without electricity and dangerous live wires all over the place. We reported it to the municipality and received a reference number. Later that afternoon, we sent photos to the municipality of the pole lying on the ground and received yet another reference number. Then all communication went quiet.

By Saturday, we still didn't hear anything from the municipality. Over 30 people are living on our smallholding, most of them receive only SASSA... so they can't afford to throw away any food. We started getting anxious and used all the contacts that we had to help us. At around 15:00, someone phoned me and asked me what the pole number is as they are on their way – nobody came.

We were also worried about the live wires just lying on the ground and on Sunday we were informed that the wires have been isolated and that they will repair everything on Monday. We went to check, but nothing was done.

...On Monday they came to dig a hole and on Tuesday they planted the pole...

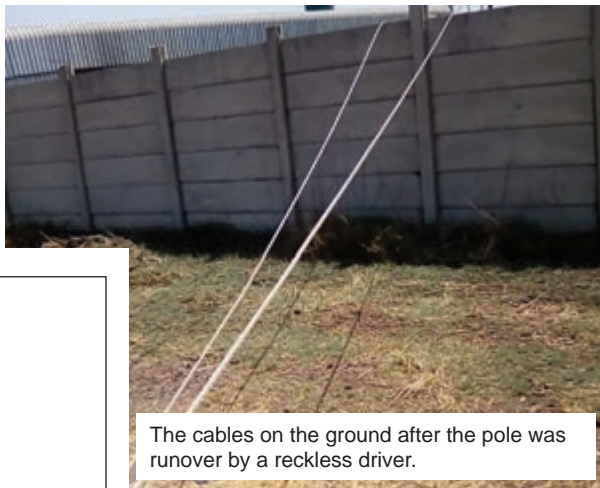
On Wednesday we finally saw the light at the end of a very dark and long tunnel when the power was restored.

Most of the smallholding owners on our road have other houses and flats on their properties; so there were a lot of people who had to throw away food – and this is not the first time this has happened. Of all the electrical problems, many have also had to repair or replace electrical appliances. We understand that there are other challenges like overtime not being paid, not having the proper equipment and lack of manpower – but six days is unacceptable!

Somebody needs to take responsibility and must come up with solutions for these problems.

After all, these residents are paying that person's salary.

For days, we could not take a bath or have any water to drink. If we needed water, we had to go and buy it.

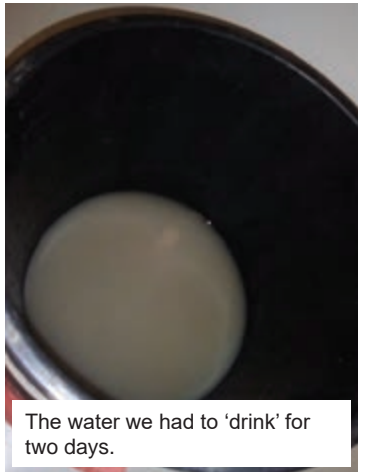
Some people with boreholes even tried to extort the people by charging those in need. To restore the water, a pump brought from the sewage plant was installed without being cleaned. For two days, we were lucky enough to have a few drops of very murky water before the pump broke again...

Even the hospital was left dry and buckets of water had to be carried around to ensure that patients had water to drink and could be washed – if they were lucky. Otherwise, the sick had to stay dirty. There were not even water trucks that could assist with this basic need. Our water has not been tested in years and if we have water it is undrinkable.

HTH pool chemicals are floating around in the water reserves to 'clean' our water and then they expect us to drink this water? Quick fix repairs are done here and there and once one thing is working, three other things break. There is always some shortage of proper service delivery because if we do not struggle without water, we do not have electricity.

Nobody even believes the stories that the cables were stolen anymore – because we all know it was sabotaged. Some of the contractors that are hired just waste the municipality's money. We cannot complain about bad service delivery because there is no service delivery in Swartruggens. This is unacceptable and somebody needs to take responsibility for this.

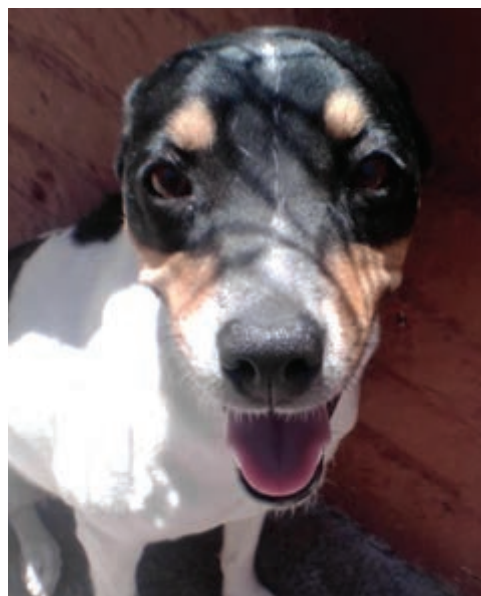

- You have three months from the date of your divorce to change your will. If you fail to do so, your ex-spouse will be entitled to inherit in terms of your will.
- If there is a cash shortfall in a deceased estate, assets of the estate will have to be sold or the heirs will have to pay in cash funds to cover the shortfall if they do not want to sell.
- Where the deceased was registered for VAT, the tax position upon death is similar to where the deceased had sold all his assets, forming part of his VAT enterprise, during his lifetime.
- Children can claim maintenance from a deceased estate where they do not inherit enough and are not yet self-supportive.
- Any accrual claim of the surviving spouse enjoys preference over bequests and inheritances.
- If someone inherits a house, that beneficiary is also entitled to receive the rental income of that house from the date of death.
- Fixed property or any other asset that is sold out of the deceased estate does not have to be valued. The sales price is used for the liquidation and distribution account.
