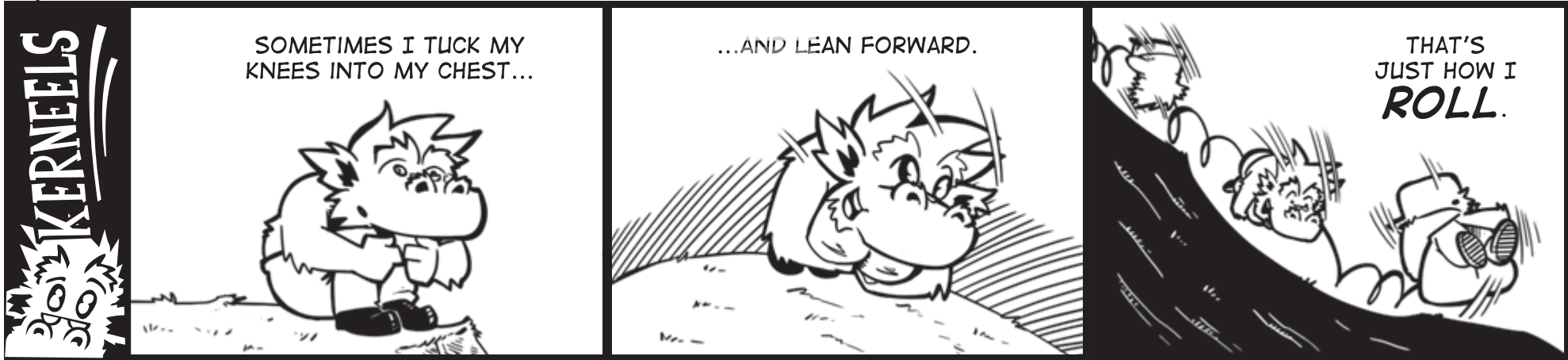

SHOOTOUT AFTER CIT BOMBING

Rustenburg – Two minutes past six on Thursday evening, 8 October, an explosion ripped through the air. Soon messages about a CIT heist flared up on social media. Ten seconds later a second explosion was heard... Within minutes high-calibre gunshots could be heard. An eyewitness told *Platinum Weekly* that a man working for Fidelity, immediately responded to help his colleagues. "Upon arrival a shootout ensued between him and the robbers – the robbers split up and fled the scene," he said. A high-speed chase ensued. Some of the robbers fled on foot – making their way through

the Rustenburg Golf Club's course. A silver Mercedes and a silver Ford Ranger were initially used by the robbers. They hijacked a black Opel Corsa while fleeing the scene. Apparently, they were all armed with R5s. The chase turned to Thlabane and then to Zinniville (at the time of going to print). Information that surfaced on social media indicated that one of the suspects was shot and killed and that a police officer was also shot in the process. Teamwork was clear between the police and local community safety forums.

A PUBLIC STATEMENT for A PUBLIC STATEMENT

Senekal – Tying the body of the brutally killed young farm manager Brandon Horner (21) to a pole was nothing less than a public statement. "This public statement was met by the [obvious] public statement of farmers that can no longer stand by while innocent farmers and farmworkers are killed, and that while their requests to have it declared a priority crime are falling on deaf ears," the *Platinum Weekly* was told. A crowd of protestors showed up for the court hearing [on 6 October] of the two suspects arrested for the murder of young Brandon.

The protestors forced their way into the court. At a stage one of the police vehicles was overturned. Social media is abuzz with videos of the incident. A 52-year-old farmer has been arrested for the alleged involvement in the vandalism and damage to property and the minister is calling for more arrests. Sekwetje Isaiah Mahlamba (32), and Sekola Piet Matlaletsa (44) were arrested by Senekal detectives at Fateng Tse Ntsho in Paul Roux, Free State on Saturday 3 October. The suspects were found with bloodstained

clothes and shoes, which taken for forensic testing. The two suspects are alleged stock thieves. According to Free State police spokesperson brigadier Montantsi Makhele, Brandon was found tied up with a rope to a pole at an open space situated at De Rots - on 2 October at about 06:30. The police received a call from other farmers reporting the attack at De Rots Farm and upon their arrival, they found the body of young Brandon with injuries to his body, head and face. A knife was seized from the scene and his bloodstained Toyota Hilux was later

found abandoned near Duikfontein Farm in Paul Roux.



CONCERN GROWS FOR MISSING MAN

Rustenburg – Residents from Geelhout Park and surrounding areas gathered outside the Rustenburg Police station on the evening of Tuesday 6 October and called for an increase in efforts to locate the whereabouts of a local missing man.

Martin Karabo Molosi was last seen on Saturday 3 October at around 19:30 when he went for a walk in the Geelhout Park extension 6 area. He has not returned home since then and his family, relatives, friends, and community members are very concerned about his safety. Democratic Alliance (DA) councillor Luan Sneiders, who was among the group of people who gathered at the police station, dispelled rumours of forced entry into the police station. He said: "As a witness to this, there was no such thing as forced entry and violence. It was concerned residents expressing their frustration over a missing brother." Police promised to deploy officers to assist the community in an intensive search for the missing person. CAR HIT BY TRAIN, YOUNG MOTHER AND SON KILLED

Rustenburg – Shortly before four o'clock on Tuesday afternoon (6 October) a young mother and her son were killed when the car they were travelling in was hit by a train - as they attempted to cross the railway line. Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse

Mokgadi confirmed that the accident occurred at the rail crossing between Zinniaville and Rustenburg North. "We do not have the full details of what transpired. What we can confirm is that the lady and her son passed away when they were hit by an approaching train, as they tried to cross. A case of culpable homicide is being investigated."

SAFETY TIPS TO AVOID KIDNAPPING

Rustenburg – With kidnapping cases on the rise, children must be taught safety tips on how they can sense danger before it happens and the steps they must take when confronted by a potentially dangerous situation.
“Never get inside a stranger’s vehicle and do not accept any kind of drink or food from strangers. Always inform your parents where you are going,” warned police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides.

SAFETY TIPS CAN KEEP A CHILD OR YOUNG ADULT SAFE

- Ensure that you have data and airtime on your mobile phone.
- If you are followed, try to remember the number plate, colour, make and type of vehicle, and run in the opposite direction.
- Seek help from others in the street. Indicate that you are being followed.
- Do not walk home late at night.
- Do not visit taverns and drink too much. This will make you vulnerable and you might be followed.
- Young children must attract attention by waving their arms and shout: “Help me!” “I don’t know these people!” “They want to steal me!”
- Walk home from school in groups.
- Always lock your gates and doors at home.
- When a small child is grabbed from a trolley in a mall or shopping complex, immediately alert the security and request for the management to lock the entrances and exits.
- Search toilets, escape routes and storerooms.
- Check security cameras for footage of the

incident and alert the SAPS.

- Immediately report a child as missing. There is no waiting period. Keep the most recent photo of your child.
- Inform family members and friends to immediately start searching.
- Caution your child not to befriend strangers. Do not give out personal information on social media.
- Alert your children of the dangers of posting naked images of their bodies on social media.
- Take time to know your children’s “inner circle” of friends. Keep their contact numbers and know where they live.
- Discourage girls to have relationships with older men or “blessers”. Do not allow them to take money or gifts from them.
- When they are alone at home, ensure that they have access to emergency numbers in case they might need help.



POLICE TIPS ON HOW TO PREVENT HIJACKINGS

Rustenburg – With vehicles being stolen and people being hijacked at an alarming rate, motorists must do whatever they can to prevent becoming victims.

Police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides shared the following tips on how to protect yourself:

- Make sure that your vehicle is well maintained so that you are not left stranded next to the road.
- Always inform your family or friends of your whereabouts.
- Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- Be alert and attentive – do not be distracted by strangers.
- Rather use outside parking than basement parking.
- Report suspicious-looking vehicles and persons.
- Do not acquaint strangers on social media and set up meetings in isolated areas.
- Do not leave valuables in unattended vehicles as it will attract negative attention.
- Make sure that your vehicle is locked before you walk away, also check

- physically check your doors.
- Ensure that the boot is always locked.
- Avoid driving alone late at night or in unfamiliar areas.
- Never pick up strangers.
- Park in central, well-lit areas – preferably areas where security guards are on duty.
- Always check your rear-view mirror to see if someone is following you. If you notice suspicious activity drive to your nearest police station.
- Don’t drive with your windows open or your doors unlocked.
- Ensure that your vehicle’s tracker is activated.

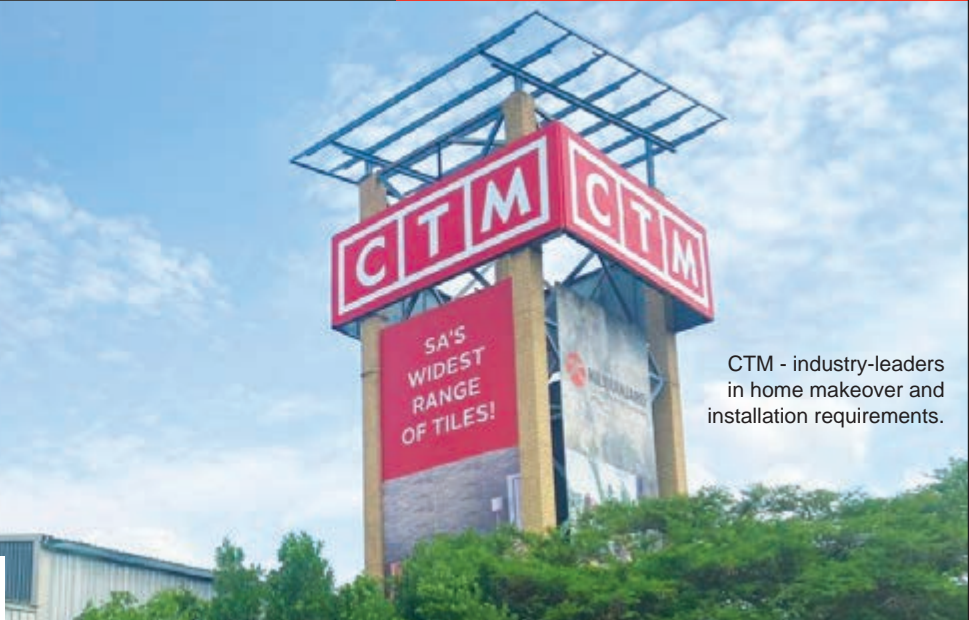

With the Rustenburg Rapid Transport (RRT) project, the city has invested so much in public transport infrastructure that has resulted in job creation, small business development to improve efficiency in public transport by introducing the Yarona Bus, an Integrated Public Transport System that will soon ferry commuters from their places to their destinations.

The launch of Yarona Bus service will commence with a mixed fleet of ten standard buses and up to two hundred minibus taxis with the entire mixed fleet managed by the Bus Operating Company, formed by the affected minibus taxi

and bus operators. RRT is engaging the affected minibus taxis and bus operators thoroughly and both parties are expected to enter into various agreements with the municipality to implement an integrated public transport system in the city of Rustenburg. Over the next three years, the services are expected to be increased to cover more areas and ferry commuters, with more buses to be purchased to replace and in some areas, integrate with the minibus-taxis on some of the routes.

Rustenburg aims to be one of the cities to integrate the minibus taxis with buses which will operate under the company management, and affected drivers from the minibus taxi industry will also be afforded an opportunity to be trained as drivers should they qualify, and be employed by the company. Other affected employees of the minibus taxi industry will as well be trained for other employment opportunities within the company, so as the entire public residents will be given the opportunity to apply for any career opportunities on offer. The municipality has been working closely with the local and affected taxi industry whom are supportive and have become a part of the transformative agenda of the RRT project. Some of the key milestones achieved with the local taxi industry include the establishment of the Taxi Negotiating Forum, conclusion Memorandum of agreement, establishment of the bus operating company which, in due course the affected taxi operators would transit into.

Also, the municipality plans to roll-out ten buses for Phase1A of the system before the end of the year with a further thirty buses planned in the coming twenty-four months. In total forty buses and hundred and fifty taxis would form part of the first phase of the system, and the municipality is further undertaking construction of eighteen station on two trunks and in the CBD. Once complete, the Yarona Bus service is envisaged to transport up to hundred thousand passengers on trips daily, connecting many corridors, with eighteen stations, four hundred and fifty bus stops, one depot and one operations control centre to manage the services.

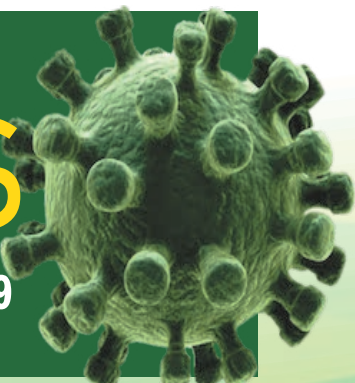

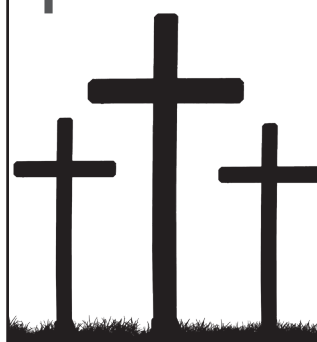
