Rustenburg - Vernon Pestana decided to head home after a successful career in training dogs to sniff for bombs, a calling that kept him in the middle east since 2009. He worked with the South African Police Service K9 unit before heading to Irag 2009. There he worked with a K9 unit at the United States (US) Embassy where they patrolled and guarded entrances, checking for explosives.

In 2011 he was stationed in Afghanistan for a year and worked with the US Department of Defence at their forward operating bases. Here he and his dog companion would check vehicles for explosives. They also did route clearing in danger zones - sniffing out hidden improvised explosive devices (IED). Together the handler and his dog countered the enemy's IED capabilities.

"It was like in the movies - we sometimes found bombs hidden in walls. We would go in and make sure that the area is free of any explosive devices before the rest of the military personnel could enter," Vernon said in an interview with Platinum Weekly.



WHAT ARE THEY DOING?

Rustenburg – A concerned resident sent a photo of a Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) vehicle transporting perishable food in extremely warm weather conditions on 19 October. RLM spokesperson David Magae confirmed that the products in question were expired and confiscated.

The RLM has noted with concern the number of expired food stuffs placed on shelves of numerous retail outlets in Rustenburg and surrounding areas.

Officials of the Public Safety Directorate descended on Lekgalong, where a number of tuck shops were found to be selling expired food stuffs. Fines were imposed on

the owners of the outlets and expired food stuffs were confiscated for disposal. An additional six stores within the central business district (CBD) were equally charged for selling expired food stuffs including soft drinks and baking powder. Three stores in the Marikana Shopping Complex precinct were also inspected and fined for contravention of municipal by-laws as well as selling expired food stuffs.

"We have been conducting random searches of outlets to check basic compliance. What worries me, is that we have had people dying from consuming expired food stuffs, as it happened when there was listeriosis. In the past three weeks, we have fined over 25 stores within the CBD and in the surrounding areas. I plead with consumers to be extra vigilant," said member of the mayoral committee (MMC) on Public Safety, councillor Victoria Makhaula.

The Fourth Industrial Revolution (4IR) and the Taxes that may accompany it.

The Fourth Industrial Revolution represents a new era of innovation in technology that will improve human-machine relationships. The 4IR will unlock new market opportunities and promote growth for South Africa across the global economy. President Cyril Ramaphosa's 4IR Commission has published a new report taking into consideration the state of technology in the Country as well as probable tax changes to South Africa's digital policy that could help us prepare for the 'Fourth Industrial Revolution'.

The Commission consists of 33 experts and 60 groups. Their mandate is to assess changes Government can implement as part of its focus on technology.

The Commission has recommended a series of tax proposals, among which include a new digital tax for companies such as Netflix, Amazon, and Facebook. The 4IR Commission argued that such companies should pay tax on their South African operations and these same companies should not be able to avoid tax obligations.

There are three tax changes proposed which include:

- 1. A digital tax for international technology companies
- 2. A Tax structure on minerals used in 4IR components
- 3. A Research and Development tax incentive for industry 4.0 start-ups. Industry 4.0 refers to a new phase in the Industrial Revolution that mainly focuses on interconnectivity, automation, and machine learning.

It is a priority that the Country dynamically participates in international efforts so that foreign technology companies pay their fair share of tax in South Africa. The Commission states that these Companies should "not be allowed to avoid and evade tax the way they currently do so". These avoidance techniques allow them to accumulate profits with minimal or no tax accruing in their operational countries.

PwC's head of Indirect Tax says, "We are living in an era of unprecedented digital change. South Africa's tax laws are outdated and have not kept pace with the growth of the digital economy."

Foreign company content providers supply "tax-free" services to South African customers. This creates an economic burden for local streaming suppliers as they are required to levy VAT on their services supplied AND pay Income Tax of 28% on their profits earned. This creates a drastic gap between local and foreign suppliers in the online media industry which in turn has an adverse effect on profits collected to finance essential public services for our residents.

Technology companies have always tried to compete with one another to provide the peoples' entry to the digital world. If foreign technology companies hardly pay any taxes, it makes it almost impossible for our local streaming providers to compete. The digital economy is taking over and South Africa needs to make viable provisions for these changes.

If the recommendation by the 4IR Commission is implemented, companies such as Netflix and Facebook will be required to pay tax on their operations in South Africa. This could result in an increase in subscription fees unless the company chooses to take the tax knock and not pass on the additional cost to its customers.

Food for thought:

If the Government succeeds in imposing the proposed digital tax, is it possible that the same will be applied to digital cryptocurrency mining? If so, the tax imposed will yield a lesser return to cryptocurrency investors who are meant to be taxed, either as revenue or capital.

HOSPITALS MUST SHOW MORE EMPATHY [LETTER TO THE EDITOR]

Rustenburg – While the year 2020 has certainly been a very difficult one for all of us because of COVID-19, the way in which some hospitals have responded to the pandemic – with regards to how they handle those passing through their doors – leaves a lot to be desired.

My experience is certainly one I wish to forget in a hurry!

Firstly, when you are admitted with COVID-19, nobody is allowed to see you. Secondly, no food from outside the hospital can be passed on to the patient. Also, a simple telephone call to enquire about the welfare of your relative is a nightmare because you are unlikely to get proper feedback. In my experience, the doctor did not answer my calls at all and there were no messages or any other feedback whatsoever regarding the condition of the relative I was enquiring about. In fact, as a relative, I did not have a say at all on what was going on in there. When they put a patient on a ventilator, it seems to be the beginning of the end and the sad part is no close relative is able to give consent to the medical procedures that take place

You as the relative have no say at all on what goes on in there.

They administer whatever procedure and medication they think will work and it is as if the patient is a puppet. When the doctor informs you of the passing of your relative, you are left with an empty feeling – as it is done without an inclination of compassion.

As a COVID-19 patient, you are under their control and they refuse to discharge you even if you want to be discharged. I had a terrible experience trying to get the actual medical condition and the treatment history of my loved one from the hospital. It took them two months to provide the information that I needed after several attempts and I had to pay them for it!

My advice to everyone is: Try and stay at home when you fall ill, only go to hospital as the very last resort. Tonnes of money have been made by hospitals this year. It is a rough and tough world out there. Be careful. For some of us, life will never be the same again without our loved ones. May God protect us all during these trying times. **Unhappy Relative**

HOME OWNERSHIP DREAMS COME TRUE

SA – The North West Housing Corporation (NWHC) is determined to clear the current backlog on the home ownership waiting list as a priority that will pave way for the implementation of new housing developments to benefit residents of the North West province.

NWHC beneficiaries in Tlhabane, Lehurutshe, Itsoseng, Pudomoe, Atamelang, Madikwe, and Mogwase will all receive their long-awaited title deeds before the end of the year.






