10 NABBED FOR UNLICENSED FIREARMS AND STOLEN GOODS

Mooionoos/ Brits – Ten men appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Friday 30 October on charges of possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition, suspected stolen property and housebreaking implements. The accused are remanded in custody until 9 November when they are expected to make their second court appearance. All ten suspects were arrested by Mooionoos Detectives and Brits Tactical Response Team (TRT) on Wednesday 28 October following a tip-off about suspicious armed men who were spotted in Matamong informal settlement on the outskirts of Brits. It is alleged that the accused were found at a rented house. During a search of two shacks the police found three unlicensed 9mm pistols, a rifle, 38 rounds of ammunition, suspected stolen goods including cell phones, a computer monitor and various tools. Further investigations have revealed that one of the firearms was reported stolen in Tsakane, Gauteng province.

Provincial commissioner of North West, lieutenant general Sello Kwenja applauded all the police members involved for their rapid response and ensuring that the alleged criminals were arrested. He also thanked members of the community for working together with the police in the fight against crime.



BRUTAL FARM ATTACK – NOTHING STOLEN

Brits – A couple living on a farm near Brits was brutally attacked on Saturday 31 October. According to police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani, the 65-year-old man and his wife were in their garden preparing for a braai when an unknown man jumped over the wall and attacked him. The man was stabbed several times before the attacker fled the scene. The attacker did not make any demands, and nothing was stolen. The victim is currently recuperating in hospital. Police are investigating a case of assault with the intent to cause grievous bodily harm and no arrests have been made. SHEPHERD BUSHIRI OUT ON BAIL

Rustenburg – The arrest of Shepherd Bushiri, owner of Sparkling Waters and Spa resort located at the foot of the Magaliesberg, has not prevented the resort from operating. Prophet Bushiri or 'Major 1' as he is fondly called by the Enlightened Christian Gathering appeared in court on Wednesday 4 November on a bail re application that has dragged on for almost two weeks. According to Hawks spokesperson colonel Katlego Mogale, the accused is facing charges of fraud and money laundering. Colonel Mogale confirmed that Shepherd, his wife Mary Bushiri and Landiwe Ntlokane were investigated by the Hawks' Serious Organised Crime Investigation unit. Mary was arrested at her home whilst her husband and Landiwe handed themselves over at the Silverton police station. Bail were granted for the trio. Prophet Bushiri's facebook page shows diametrically opposed commentary from the public with regards to his arrest and the charges against him.

Rustenburg – Excitement and anticipation filled the air on Friday 30 October as scores of people witnessed the arrival of 10 Yarona buses that will be used in the Rustenburg Rapid Transport (RRT) system. Yarona is a Setswana word meaning “it is ours”. The buses were officially handed over to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) to pave the way for the much-anticipated modern transport system planned for the platinum mining capitol. Member for the executive council (MEC) for Community Safety and Transport Management Sello Lehari and executive mayor of Rustenburg councillor Mpho Khunou were among the government officials and members of the community who officiated at the handover. The arrival of the bus fleet comes hard on the heels of an array of milestones achieved in the past few months by the RRT which conducted a technical test with one of the buses and also completed two kerb stations within the central

business district (CBD). “The municipality prides itself with the progressive partnership it has with the local taxi industry. Since 2014, the municipality entered a memorandum of understating with affected local public transport operators represented by the Taxi Negotiating Forum to meaningfully engage and collaborate on the implementation of the RRT,” Khunou said. “I would like to commend the RRT team for their sterling work from the inception of the project. As the leadership, we also wish to express our gratitude to the contractors, labourers, and the local public transport operators for their contribution towards the overall agenda for a world class city.” Some of the buses were given a test run to Boitekong and Waterfall malls as well as to some of the stations that will be used when the RRT is fully operational. Watch out for the modern bright orange buses and look forward to a comfortable bus drive and less congested streets.

WATER SAFETY FOR SUMMER OUTINGS [Letter to the Editor]

SA – The summer holidays are often enjoyed by families at dams, rivers, and the sea. The Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS) urges citizens to observe safety procedures around water bodies to prevent injury and drowning. Lack of water safety knowledge and intoxication around water bodies have claimed many lives especially those of unattended children. It is of essence that activity around dams, rivers, and the sea happen under the watchful eye of an adult. Before entering the water check the strength of the water flow and be sure that it won't carry you or anyone else away. If you are caught in a fast-flowing river current, travel feet first so if you crash into a rock or other hard object the head and body will be protected from serious injuries. Avoid sunbathing, picnicking, or camping in an area below dams that may suddenly become flooded due to daily or weekly water level releases. Stay off dam structures and restrict activities to areas marked for public use.

Public swimming pools are supervised by lifeguards and bathers must obey safety notices. Diving into pools must only be done if the water is sufficiently deep and the activity is condoned. Before leaping or plunging into water check that no one else is in your way to reduce the likelihood of hitting and hurting both you and others in the water.

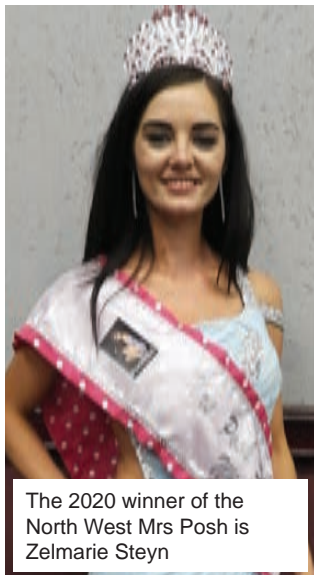



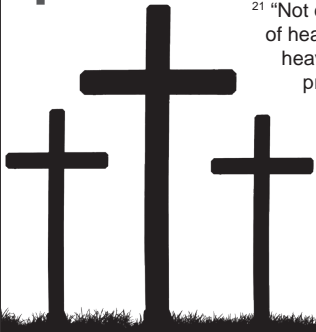

PROTECT PETS FROM HEATSTROKE

Rustenburg – Summer is here and with it come hot, long days. Pets often do not have the luxury of cooling off in a swimming pool or an airconditioned room and can experience heatstroke. Responsible pet owners make sure that their pets have enough water and shelter to protect them from the scorching summer sun.

According to the Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), a dog's body temperature is on average 38.5°C. A mere increase of two degrees in body temperature is all it takes for a heatstroke to kick in. The SPCA cautions that it takes as little as 15 minutes for a dog to die of a heatstroke. The average survival rate for dogs suffering from heat stroke is 50%.

How to keep you dog cool on hot days:

- Restrict exercise
- Never leave your pet in a vehicle, hot room, or suntrap
- Ensure that they have enough cool drinking water and a shaded spot during the day
- Walk you dog early in the morning or later in the evening
- Spray your dog with cool water

Signs of a heatstroke in dogs include:

- Brain seizures
- Glazy eyes
- Fearful expression
- Racing heart
- High body temperature
- Heavy panting
- Excess drooling
- Red or purple gums and tongue
- Vomiting
- Collapsing or staggering

Steps to take if heat stroke is suspected:

- Move the animal to a cool area
- Offer small amounts of tepid water
- Use cool wet towels gently reduce the temperature but don't stress the body further with cold water
- Use a fan to create airflow
- Contact your vet straight away
