salons in Rustenburg are atwitter about visits from the national bargaining council for the hairdressing, cosmetology, beauty and skincare industry (HCSBC).

The HCSBC was challenged in a CCMA hearing held in Rustenburg on Thursday, 28 January. They were given time to reply to the allegations that they improperly forced self-employed stylists to join the HCSBC and incur fees when they were never legally required to do so.

Amidst the legal jargon and acronyms, the important question a stylist or beautician should ask is whether they are an employee. employer, an independent contractor, or a self-employed person such as people that 'rent-a-chair' from a salon.

Only employers and employees must register with the bargaining council, Rustenburg however, Platinum Weekly has been told by stylists [falling into other categories] that they felt intimidated by the agents of the bargaining council to join them.

Upon Platinum Weekly's request for information, the financial manager and acting chief executive officer of the HCSBC, Frik Bekker, said that he will investigate any cases of intimidation that stylists report to him. 


#### BLASTED FOR SELLING EXPLOSIVES





# STEPPING UP TO THE CHALLENGE

After receiving complaints about contaminated water in Swartruggens, the team worked tirelessly on 18 February to bleed for clean water. One drop in the bucket... this is just one of the actions undertaken.

"We are now in the process of cleaning the clarifying system. It looks like it hasn't been cleaned in years," said Andreas Peens, attorney for the Kgetlengrivier residents.

The teams are currently working hard to ensure that all areas receive clean water, but this will take a bit of time. "We didn't receive a new plant where we just have to turn on a switch. There is a lot of maintenance that has to be done first, but we are busy and appreciate the community's patience."



#### **NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE INCREASED TO R21.69 PER HOUR**

South Africa - Employment and Labour minister Thulas Nxesi on Tuesday 9 February said that as of 1 March 2021, the National Minimum Wage (NMW) will increase to R21.69 per hour.

The increase of 93c is in line with the NMW legislation that came into effect on 1 January 2019, at a level of R20 per hour.

"In considering the annual adjustment, the Commission considered the following factors: inflation, the cost of living, and the need to retain the value of the minimum wage; gross domestic product; wage levels and collective bargaining outcomes; productivity; ability of employers to carry on their businesses successfully; the operation of small, medium or micro-enterprises and new enterprises, and the likely impact of the recommendation adjustment on employment or the creation of employment," a Department of Employment and Labour statement reads.

The department said following a transitional phase, the farm worker sector has been aligned with the NMW rate of R21.69 per hour. The domestic workers sector will be entitled to R19.09 per hour and could be expected to be aligned with the NMW when the next review is considered.



#### **MOOINOOI MOB JUSTICE**

Brits - The SAPS provincial commissioner in the North West, lieutenant general Sello Kwena has urged communities not to take the law into their own hands when dealing with perpetrators of crime. This warning follows an incident on Saturday 13 February in which a man was allegedly burnt to death and another person assaulted during mob justice incidents. The incidents were reported in Segwaelane village in Mooinooi.

On the day in question, police were summoned to the village at about 23:40, finding a mob severely assaulting a man. Despite threats, police rescued the man and a woman from a group of people that barricaded the road. They were heavily armed with sticks, pangas, and knobkerries. The Public Order Police (POP) unit had to be summoned to the scene for backup after community members started throwing stones at the police. The burnt remains

of a man were discovered by the police when they inspected a minibus that had been torched by the angry mob. The victims were apparently accused of several incidents of house robbery recently committed. No arrests have been made yet.



#### **KILLED TRYING TO PROTECT A FRIEND**

Brits - The senseless murder of Dieter Grabie (22) of Brits who was stabbed to death when he pulled his friend Chris Malan (19) out of the way of five knife-wielding attackers, is hard to digest. The incident occured shortly after 02:00 AM in Van Deventer Street, Brits. Dieter and his friend caught a lift from a local hangout for youngsters... the lift only took them part of the way and dropped them off... upon which Malan reportedly phoned his mom to come and fetch them. They soon realised they were in trouble when a gang of five appeared and started attacking them. Grabie collapsed soon after being stabbed. Malan summoned an ambulance from a nearby filling station. Sadly Grabie died shortly after being admitted to hospital. "He was stabbed in the upper body. The suspects fled the scene and the friend then sought assistance from a local garage," police spokesperson Maria Nkabinde said. You couldn't give her a plastic spoon to eat from without her trying to chew it off, so we had no choice but to feed her through a pipe," recalls Martin.

"There were many times I would just get up and start walking for hours on end," he said. "My motivation for walking is so that I can live my life outdoors. It takes discipline to walk that far. While you are walking you can just admire nature. The one thing you should never focus on is the distance you are walking. That starts to slow you down. All you need is a water bottle, good walking shoes and endurance." His all-time best for a single day walk totalled 63km and was a roundtrip from his home on the Donkerhoek road to the Marikana toll gate and back. It was done on the summer solstice the longest day of the year and took 11 hours and 46 minutes at an average speed of 4.8 km/h. For now, Martin is sticking to day trips so you may see his camper van parked at the foot of the Magaliesberg mountain.


