# THE UPSIDE OF DOWN SYNDROME

**Rustenburg** – For the last decade, the United Nations have recognised 21 March as World Down Syndrome Day. The number 21 is significant as 21 is the chromosome which is duplicated in people with Down Syndrome.

The aim of the day is to have a global voice for advocating for the rights, inclusion, and well-being of people with Down Syndrome.

Mothers pregnant with a baby with Down Syndrome are often advised to abort without knowing what their child could accomplish. In the past, parents were given a grim diagnosis of what their child might accomplish, and many were encouraged to institutionalise them. Thankfully there have been parents and people with the syndrome who have broken the stereotype of Down Syndrome.

Shéri Brynard is South Africa's own success

story and is beautiful – both inside and out. She is the first and so far, only person with Down Syndrome in the world with a tertiary teacher's diploma, achieved without any concessions. She holds a full-time job and is a sought-after motivational speaker that has spoken twice at the United Nations and at other fora in India, Israel, and many European countries.

Shéri's legacy will have far reaching consequences as she has endured a painful lumbar puncture and other tests at King's College University to contribute to research aimed at assisting people with Down Syndrome and Alzheimer's disease. Rustenburg has its own ambassador for Down Syndrome – Willem Meter. He runs Gwan's Coffee Shop at a private eye clinic in Brink street and as with Shéri, is fluent in Afrikaans and English. Before COVID-19, he worked as a class assistant at Rustenburg Skool vir Buitengewone Onderwys. A work colleague, Hendrik Bodenstein, described him as an absolute gentleman and well-rounded individual. "Willem is so many things that one sentence will not do him justice." Willem is valued and loved by his family who are thankful that he is part of their lives.

Caitlyn Moonsammy often relies on her younger sister and best friend Natasha to interpret her words to family and friends. Caitlyn is *Platinum Weekly's* choice for personality and cuteness this World Down Syndrome Day.

# WILL THINGS EVER CHANGE?

**Rustenburg** – A lack of water, lack of electricity, and lack of service delivery from Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) has been burning issues for the Rustenburg community for a while now. Some areas go for days without water or electricity.

**What's new?**

Residents – again – took to the streets to voice their dismay in a protest march on Friday 12 March. Escorted by the Police and Public Safety, the peaceful protestors marched to the RLM building down Nelson Mandela drive with signs indicating their discontent with phrases like 'enough is enough'.

"I am losing money at my business because of electrical problems. I reported a faulty phase almost three months ago and still nothing has been done to fix it. I work in the electrical industry myself and can't understand why it takes so long to fix a simple phase problem. It should not take more than 20 minutes," said local business owner Hennie Fourie.

A memorandum stating their demands was handed over the RLM stating the community's concerns to which the RLM had 48 hours to respond to. At the time of going to press, the organisers of the march had not yet received a response.

The organisers would like to thank everyone who attended the march, all the marshals who assisted, and Wilfred for sponsoring the water as well as Signtopia and Mine Print and Signs for printing the signs. Although only a handful of residents attended, organisers said that it is the first of many and that they plan on marching until the residents are heard.

**ONGOING SERVICE DELIVERY ISSUES IN RUSTENBURG**

The level of service delivery has slumped to a disgracefully low level. Basic services, such as water and electricity provision are basically non-existent in most parts of Rustenburg. Crime is increasing rapidly, and most people see no future in Rustenburg due to lack of job opportunities.

The areas that are greatly affected by interruptions to power supply mainly include: Waterkloof, Rhenosterfontein, Zuurplaat, Arnoldstad, Kroondal, Waterval, Modderfontein, Boschfontein, Oorsaak, Thlabane, Boitekong as well as the northern regions.

The residents of the aforementioned areas have been suffering constant electrical blackouts for several months.

Many of these residents reside on smallholdings and their only source of water is the boreholes on their properties. The electrical interruptions limit their access to clean water, because the pumps cannot function during the affected times. The interruptions damage electrical appliances and pose a major safety threat as electrical fencing also does not work during these periods.

Furthermore, the following issues is also a disgrace throughout the entire RLM:

- Potable water provision
- Waste collection services
- Condition of roads
- Safety and drugs
- Streetlights
- Sewerage infrastructure
- Maintenance of parks and public spaces
- Set up meeting to view all contracts pertaining to service delivery within and around Rustenburg

**Therefore, we as members of the community, demand the following:**

1. Action plan for improved electricity provision within 48 hours.
2. The striking of municipal workers is resolved within 48 hours.
3. Sustainable electricity provision is restored to the affected areas within seven days.
4. Qualified workers are appointed in the electrical and water departments.
5. The community is consulted in the monitoring of work done to electrical infrastructure and water infrastructure.
6. Sustainable water provision is restored within 24 hours.
7. RLM must provide us with an economic blueprint on how they plan to grow and support local businesses within two months.
8. RLM must provide us the with a strategic plan on how they intend to maintain and create jobs within two months.
9. RLM must provide a detailed plan on how they plan to eradicate poverty within two months.
10. RLM must provide us with a plan to protect the rights of women and for women empowerment within two months.
11. RLM must provide us with a strategic plan on how they will improve service delivery within two months.

## REPORTING WATER METER THEFTS

**Rustenburg** – Following the theft of another water meter from Abelia Ave on Monday 15 March, the question of who should lay a case with the police came up... again.

As a water meter is a municipal asset, it is the responsibility of the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) to open a case for the police to investigate. Police spokesperson Ofentse Mokgadi said that the property owner can also open a case if they indicate the meter is a municipal asset supplying water to their property. The Rustenburg Police confirmed that cases have been opened and they are investigating the thefts.

Boronia, Santolina, and Felicia Ave are some streets targeted by the water meter thieves in the last few months. Ironically, a stolen water meter results in large amounts of potable water being wasted before repair and these areas have not had unreliable municipal water in the last few months.

## DOGGY PARLOUR UP IN FLAMES

**Rustenburg** – Christelle Pretorius' business, Sharloms YorkitiQue Doggy Spa just outside of town, took a hard knock in the early hours of Saturday 13 March as she had to stand by and watch everything she worked so hard for, go up in flames. "One of the neighbours heard a loud bang and peeked through the window. As she watched the flames engulf the business, she alarmed me and the fire department," Christelle said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*. "Three fire extinguishers could not even make a small difference and when the fire department arrived on scene, the charred and collapsed structure was all that was left."

Sharloms YorkitiQue Doggy Spa is a well-known name in the Rustenburg and surrounding community where your pooch could receive the pampering it deserves. What started as a hobby soon turned into a thriving business.

"All my tools, treatments and clientele's doggy-food are now soaked ashes. I lost everything! It was like watching a piece of my heart burn down."

The estimated damage is about R400,000 but for Christelle, the sentimental loss is worse. Forensic evidence is being gathered as to the cause of the fire and a case of arson was opened.

## ELDERLY COUPLE TRAUMATISED ON FARM

**Swartruggens** – An elderly couple was held at gunpoint by two suspects on their farm near Swartruggens from late in the evening of Friday 12 March until the early hours of Saturday morning.

According to SAPS, the women heard dogs barking earlier in the evening but thought that it was the neighbour's dogs. Later that same evening, she was woken by a light, when she saw two intruders in her room. Her husband who is recovering from a serious surgery was sleeping in another room. The attackers forced her into his room where they were both tied up. Police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburg confirmed that the intruders managed to

get the keys to the safe where they found a pistol, jewellery, and cash. They then proceeded to ransack the house for electrical appliances and tools.

They stored their loot in the victims' bakkie which indicates that they planned to use it as a getaway vehicle. The couple's son arrived on the farm at around 04:00 the Saturday morning, interrupting the attackers, who then fled the scene.

Although severely traumatised, the victims were fortunate to not sustain any physical injuries.

Swartruggens police are investigating a case of house robbery.

## NEWBORN BRUTALLY KILLED

**Hartbeespoort Dam/ Brits** – A 29-year-old woman is expected to appear before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Friday 19 March in connection with the murder of her newborn baby. According to SAPS, a friend of the mother alerted them about the murder of the baby. Apparently, the mother confided in the friend. It is alleged that the suspect gave birth in her home in Sunway in Rietfontein, Hartbeespoort Dam, on 12 March. She then allegedly placed the newborn baby in boiling water, wrapped the baby with plastic and buried him in a shallow grave in a nearby field. During the initial investigation, police found the body of the baby, buried in a shallow grave. The suspect was arrested and charged with murder. Investigations continue.

# THIRD TIME LUCKY? [Letter to the editor]

**Rustenburg** – After struggling for more than a week with a water leak, the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) finally came to fix it late one night. After it was 'fixed' we didn't have water for a whole week. On Monday 15 March municipal officials returned to repair it for a second time. On Tuesday, the driver of a waste collection service had to swerve out of the road to avoid an object and his trailer landed right in the hole where they fixed the leak. Turns out they never covered the hole... and guess what – it is leaking again! Do they take pride in doing a job so half-heartedly? Would it have taken so long and been such an inconvenience just to close the hole? Is this the reason why everyone is complaining about everything breaking?

Now we have to wait patiently to see how long it will take for the RLM to show up and fix the leak for the third time. All while the water keeps leaking and causing the muddy, slippery road to become a safety hazard.

# WHAT HAPPENED TO WORKING FOR WATER?

**Rustenburg** – In 2006 the Working for Water Programme (WfW), now administered by the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries, was recognised in an international journal for its contribution to pro-poor rural employment, removing alien invasive plants from rivers and mountain catchments, protecting biodiversity, and securing South Africa's freshwater resources. Unfortunately, the state of the Dorpspruit left since October 2020 after WfW contractors started clearing alien invasive plants is less optimistic. The alien invasive Arundo donax (Spanish reed) was cut and left for moths on the site. The cut stems were not poisoned so the invasive reed has grown back. It seems as if nothing is being accomplished. The Dorpspruit has in the course of ten years deteriorated from a charming river where children could fish to an

environmental disaster. Earth moving equipment is not legally allowed in a river unless an environmental impact assessment (EIA) and environmental management plan (EMP) have been conducted by an aquatic ecologist. An aquatic ecologist would have realised that the earthworks in the Dorpspruit captured on film on 11 November 2017 would favour the spread of the Spanish reed at the expense of the natural fauna and flora. Spanish reed forms dense stands on the disturbed banks of watercourses where it interferes with water flow and in winter becomes a fire risk as it is highly flammable. Opportunities to use the Spanish reed exist as the stem material is strong and flexible and has been used as support for climbing plants. It also is used to make flutes and pan pipes and in woodwind instruments such as the oboe, bassoon, clarinet, and saxophone.

## Always worth looking TWICE AT WASPS!

Most people think of wasps as a nuisance when they start to build their nests under the eaves, but they're wrong! Wasps are amazing! The paper wasps found in South Africa are incredible tiny societies. If you watch them closely, you realise these societies are full of acts of selfless cooperation, internal power struggles, fascinating dominance hierarchies, and so many mysteries that we don't yet understand. Life on a wasp nest is like a mini soap opera, but one that can give us insights into big evolutionary questions such as the origin of cooperation. We use wasps to study how 'altruism' evolves. We want to understand why a young female wasp would make the decision not to leave the family and find her own nest, but rather to stay and help rear her brothers and sisters. Biologists think this is all about helping other wasps who share the same genes and are close family to populate further than other wasp families.

But there are loads of factors that can tip the balance one way or the other. Dr Patrick Kennedy a postdoctoral research associate in the School of Biological Sciences, University of Bristol in the United Kingdom has chosen the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve to research wasps and their behaviour.

## Traditional Indian Matar Paneer

- Prep time: 15 minutes
- Cook time: 45 minutes

- Serves: 4

### Ingredients

- 2 litres milk
- 1/4 cup lemon juice
- 1/2 cup vinegar
- 2 green chillies
- 1 1/4 cup green peas (fresh or frozen)
- 1 onion
- 5 tomatoes
- 1 tsp garlic paste
- 3/4 tsp ginger paste
- 1 cinnamon stick
- 5 black peppercorns
- 2 tsp salt
- 1/2 tsp turmeric powder
- 3 tbsp oil
- 3/4 tsp cumin seeds
- 5 tsp yogurt
- 1 tsp red chilli powder

### Instructions to make Paneer

1. Bring the milk to a full boil.
2. Add the lemon and vinegar to the milk and stir for 2 minutes.
3. Remove from the heat and pour the mixture through a cloth then press out the remaining water.
4. Lay the mixture flat in a tray and place in a deep freezer till it hardens.
5. Cut into squares.

### Instructions to make Gravy

1. Heat oil in a pan, add cumin seeds, and cinnamon and fry for 15 seconds.
2. Add chopped onion and fry on medium heat until pink and translucent.
3. Add, garlic and ginger paste, fry for a minute until raw smell goes away.
4. Add green chilli paste and sauté on high for 3-4 minutes.
5. Add chilli powder, turmeric, and salt.
6. Add chopped tomatoes and mix.
7. Let the mixture cool and then liquidise.
8. Add peas and sauté for a minute follow by adding warm water and bringing to the boil. Cover and simmer for 3-4 minutes or until the peas are cooked, add yogurt, and cook for 2-3 minutes.
9. Finally, add the paneer cubes and mix while cooking for a minute.
