Rustenburg – The Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) is concerned about the rampant and illegal practice of pasting posters on streetlight signs, poles, dustbins, municipal electrical distribution boxes and public infrastructure, which put community members at risk of losing money (and more) to fake and unregistered medical practitioners. In many parts of the city, posters advertising abortions, penis enlargements, and free satellite television are an eyesore. Those at the forefront of marketing these services and products, often put up the posters at night – a violation of the legal route, which requires them to approach the municipality and follow due procedure. MMC for Public Safety councillor Michael Mhlungu is also concerned about the dangers associated with the services advertised. "Despite the regular clean-up campaigns and fines issued, adverts for abortion services (and other medically induced procedures), place our community members at risk. The people offering these services are not qualified doctors and it puts those who seek their services in serious danger." Mhlungu also warned community members against seeking the services of unregistered DSTV and satellite installers. "Many community members threw their money down the drain... they paid and never got what they paid for."

Nowhere to run Robbers cornered in high-speed chase

Rustenburg – On Friday 7 May, a man was hitchhiking on the R24 when he was offered a lift by three men travelling in a white Fiat. He soon realised he was sitting in car with robbers, frightened for his life... Police officers from the protection services unit, doing their rounds in the Kloof vicinity, suspected a hijacking in progress after witnessing the victim being thrown out of a moving vehicle. "The man ran to the police and told them of his ordeal. The suspects sped off," said police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*. "A high-speed chase ensued as the police pursued the suspects all the way to Kock street, where the suspects were cornered and arrested. This was after the police shot at and damaged the rear wheel of their vehicle." The hitchhiker was grateful for the swift reaction of the police officers. His belongings were found inside the vehicle of the suspects. The three suspects aged 18, 20, and 22, appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday 10 May on charges of robbery.

Lodge targeted again

Rustenburg – Two Molokwane Lodge guards were held up at gunpoint by four assailants on Thursday 6 May. Police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides confirmed that the assailants accosted the security guards to the main house inside the lodge. The assailants then unmounted the safes that contained valuables and loaded it into the lodge's Toyota Land Cruiser and fled the scene. The vehicle has since been recovered in

Lefaragatlhe near Phokeng. Police are investigating a case of house robbery and no arrests have been made thus far. This is the second instance where the lodge was targeted. On 26 April four armed men held a security guard at gunpoint, robbed employees, and fled the scene with six hunting rifles, two shotguns, and two handguns. The suspects also took off with an undisclosed amount of cash, six laptops, cellular phones, a TV set, a recording machine, and liquor.

JACO REALLY NEEDS YOUR HELP

Rustenburg – Jaco Roodt's family is pleading for financial assistance to help cover his soaring medical and other costs. Roodt is unable to return to work for the foreseeable future. The past few months have been particularly unbearable for Jaco's wife and two children and the hospital bills only add to their sorrows. It all started on Wednesday 27 January when Roodt was taken for a COVID-19 test after he started exhibiting symptoms of the pandemic. The test came out negative. Says Jaco's wife: "He started getting very sick and was vomiting, so he went to another doctor for a check-up who then realised that Jaco (who is not a drinker) has a swollen liver and suffered heart failure." On Friday 5 February he was taken to Tshepong hospital in Klerksdorp where they diagnosed him with hepatitis. He was discharged the following day. On 11 February he went for more tests and would have gone for a sonar on 15 February, but on 13 February Jaco suffered a stroke. We immediately had to pay R3,600 for his assessment by the doctor and a drip but had to voluntarily discharge him as they requested a R50,000 deposit for him to be admitted. "By Sunday we raised R53,000 and Jaco was taken to Medicare by ambulance that Sunday evening." He was placed in the intensive care unit after his health seriously deteriorated. On 20 February, with rising medical costs and no medical aid support, Roodt's family transferred him to Job Shimankane Tabane (JST) hospital. When his condition stabilised a few days later Roodt's family voluntarily discharged him from hospital. On Friday 5 March, his family got the fright of their lives when he suffered a massive heart attack at around 03:00. Again, the Roodt family made an emergency trip to Medicare. They stabilised him and his wife had to voluntarily sign him out. That evening Jaco was back in JST. The next morning Jaco suffered a second massive heart attack. "It looked like my husband died!"

Jaco's wife, Elsabe, said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*. He lost consciousness and the doctor struggled to bring Jaco back. The two heart attacks also caused kidney failure. While the odometer rolled in fast-forward, bills mounted, and emotions heightened, Jaco was finally admitted to the Ga-Rankuwa hospital on 11 May. His family appeals for financial assistance from those willing to open up their hearts to this worthy cause. He will not be getting a salary at the end of May and his sick leave has now been exhausted. This has put a massive strain on the family's ability to pay school fees for their children as well as meet their day-to-day expenses. **If you would like to assist Jaco Roodt, please use the following banking details: Jacobus Roodt, FNB, Cheque Account, 62862339390, branch code 202009.** "We hope you find it in your heart to donate, even if it is small. No match for law enforcement

SWIFT RESPONSE LEADS TO ARREST OF 8 COURIER VEHICLE ROBBERS

Rustenburg – The police responded immediately after they were notified about a courier vehicle being robbed on the N4 near the Waterfall Mall on Wednesday 12 May. A Quantum, Ford Ranger, Iveco and Lexus with an unknown number of suspects which matched the description of the suspects' getaway vehicles, were soon spotted close to Krugersdorp. SAPS' Serious and Violent Crimes, Rapid Response Services and other law enforcement agencies were dispatched to Krugersdorp without delay. A high-speed chase ensued when law enforcement caught up with the robbers, followed by a shootout after the suspects opened fire on the cops.



Three unlicensed rifles, a pistol, four stolen vehicles, and suspected stolen property were confiscated.

The multidisciplinary team managed to arrest eight suspects, confiscating three unlicensed rifles, a pistol, four stolen vehicles, and suspected stolen property. Six of the suspects arrested were from the Quantum, one from the Iveco, and one from the Ford Ranger. The Lexus was later found abandoned, with a pistol inside. No injuries from the shootout were reported. The suspects will be charged with armed robbery, possession of unlicensed firearms, attempted murder, the possession of stolen property, and negligent driving. They will be profiled to determine if they are linked to other crimes – especially to that of the robbery of courier vehicles.

Ambulance coming – veer left or right?

[Letter to the editor]

SA – Whenever I hear sirens, I immediately go on high alert and check around me to see where they are coming from. Because I know every minute counts when it comes to saving lives, so I want to ensure that I am not the one blocking an ambulance. I just wish others had the same courtesy! Veering to the left or right depends if you are on a freeway or not. If not on a freeway, veer to the left and let the ambulance pass. Do not pull to the right or stop in the middle lane when there is room to pull to the left. If on a freeway – make sure you are not in the emergency lane (yellow lane) as it is reserved for police vehicles, fire-fighting vehicles and ambulances. Regulation 298A of the National Road Traffic Act explains that yellow lane driving is not allowed except for a real emergency like a breakdown, a medical emergency, or if you are rushing to a hospital. It may not be used as a passing lane or as a free way. Only emergency vehicles may use the yellow lane with the exception of single-lane carriageways. In this case vehicles may move into the yellow lane to allow faster moving vehicles to pass. So, next time when you hear the sirens, don't be that [insert swear word of your choice here] and move safely out of the way of the ambulance so that they can pass you to save someone's life.

SPIKE INCIDENTS SPIKING!

N1/N4 – The Community Policing Forum (CPF) is warning motorists to be aware of the hotspot areas where criminals have been using spikes and other objects to create road hazards before robbing or killing their victims.

Several incidents have been reported between 19:00 and 03:00 in areas along the N4 and the N1. HOTSPOTS: Donkerhoek Plaza (19:00 – 04:00), Solomom Mahlangu interchange (23:00 – 04:00) as well as the Proefplaas interchange (19:00 – 04:00) – all situated along the N4. Incidents have also been reported along the N4 in Brits, M17 at Garankua Bridge, the R101 old Warmbaths road, and the R80 road in Hercules and Shoshanguve.

Motorists must be aware of criminals who put stones on the road or throw it at vehicles from bridges. Cars breaking down in these areas are also at risk.

Through the barrel of a gun...

Rustenburg – An incident in which a Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) councillor survived an attempt on his life by an unknown gunman on Tuesday 27 April casts a shadow on the dangers that African National Congress (ANC) politicians often face during an election year. Councillor Zenzele Xhinela of ward 41 was hospitalised after he was shot by an intruder who had gained access into his home in the Seraleng area of Rustenburg.

- **Twelve years earlier – on 14 March 2009 to be exact – councillor Moss Phakoe was shot dead in a similar fashion.**

His killer, like the one who attempted to take Xhinela's life, pulled the trigger after gaining access into the councillor's home. Phakoe's death came just two days after he had met with the then Cooperative Governance minister, the late Sicelo Shiceka. During

that meeting he handed over a document of allegations implicating certain RLM councillors in corrupt practices with regards to the outsourcing of the Rustenburg Kloof Holiday Resort and Conference Centre. Solly Phetoe, a senior COSATU member in the North West at that time, alleged that Phakoe's death was orchestrated by a rival ANC faction that feared the damage the contents of the document could inflict if made public.

- **With the script of Phakoe's murder very similar to Xhinela's shooting, are such shootings random criminal acts or political hits?**

Reacting to Xhinela's shooting, police spokesperson captain Afje Botma could not say whether the shooting could have been politically motivated. She said: "No suspects have been arrested yet. Police are still busy with the investigation."

Bakwena N1N4 route – Bakwena implemented additional measures along their route including six route patrol vehicles through their partnership with Motus Corporation and Kia Motors South Africa from 1 April to 3 May during the Easter, Freedom Day and Workers Day public holidays. **Collectively, these six vehicles travelled a distance of 54,142 kilometres, assisted at 48 crashes, issued 1,804 fines, and assisted 70 road users along the Bakwena N1N4 route.**

While delivering the preliminary easter report which recorded an overall decrease in the number of road fatalities from 2019 figures, Transport minister Fikile Mbalula raised a concern of an increase in pedestrian fatalities by 5% compared to 2019’s figures. Over the 2021 Easter weekend and April

school holidays, 9 fatalities were recorded along the N1N4 route. The peak hour traffic volumes reached just under 2,500 vehicles per hour on the N1 north through Pumulani on Thursday 1 April, and approximately **2,500 vehicles per hour** on the N1 south on Sunday 5 April and Sunday 2 May.

Bakwena works very closely with traffic authorities from Tshwane Metro Police, Limpopo, Gauteng and North West Provincial traffic authorities as well as SAPS, EMS and would like to thank them as well as other stakeholders for their ongoing efforts in striving to reduce incidents and fatalities on South Africa’s roads

At first, he used the excuse that we must wait for the rainy season to pass. Then he said "after the Covid-19 lockdown" ... Excuses, excuses, excuses.

Sies man! Last week I decided to try again. I was informed by the new owner that he bought the business from the 'snake catcher'. Company name and everything was still the same – just under new management. The new owner

didn't know anything about the botched job that was done and that promises were made to come and spray again. I then asked him, seeing that it is still the same business that gave me a written five-year guarantee if he will then redo the job? He then said that I do not have a certificate where those specific words are written.

The fact that it is on his company's letterhead, and no private name is mentioned on the invoice, only my name and the company name... does not matter to this new owner. He did not want to give me the Afrikaans speaking person's new number, and he himself also refused to help me.

I hope that this might help other people, to be careful, and not be scammed and cheated the way I was.

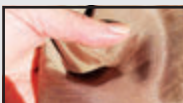




‘Art helped me find my purpose’

Freedom Park/ Rustenburg – Dropping out of tertiary education because of the inability to meet the financial obligations of higher learning can deal a devastating blow to one’s aspirations. Instead of wallowing in self-pity, Sifiso Qhantsi – who dropped out of college before completing his course – kept his cool and decided to pursue his passion for painting with energy and commitment. “Art helped me to find my purpose in life. I feel good and fulfilled whenever I complete a painting or a sketch. It has become a way of life for me,” Qhantsi told *Platinum Weekly*. This 25-year-old artist, who did his primary education in the Eastern Cape before completing his matric in Freedom Park, said his work reflects nature and the everyday issues that society often grapples with. As a self-employed artist, Sifiso earns money from commissioned portraits. “It is not much but I’m grateful for the little I earn. With hard work, I’m sure the rewards will also increase,” he said. “Art should be used to address societal ills and for me this means highlighting the negative effects of domestic abuse,” he added, while holding up a portrait of a woman crying. “The idea is to change the attitudes and behaviour of our communities and help reduce the high rate of gender-based violence.” He describes his mother – who has encouraged him to follow his passion with enthusiasm – as a pillar of strength. With job opportunities becoming scarce as unemployment levels continue to rise, Sifiso describes his creativity as a vital asset.




