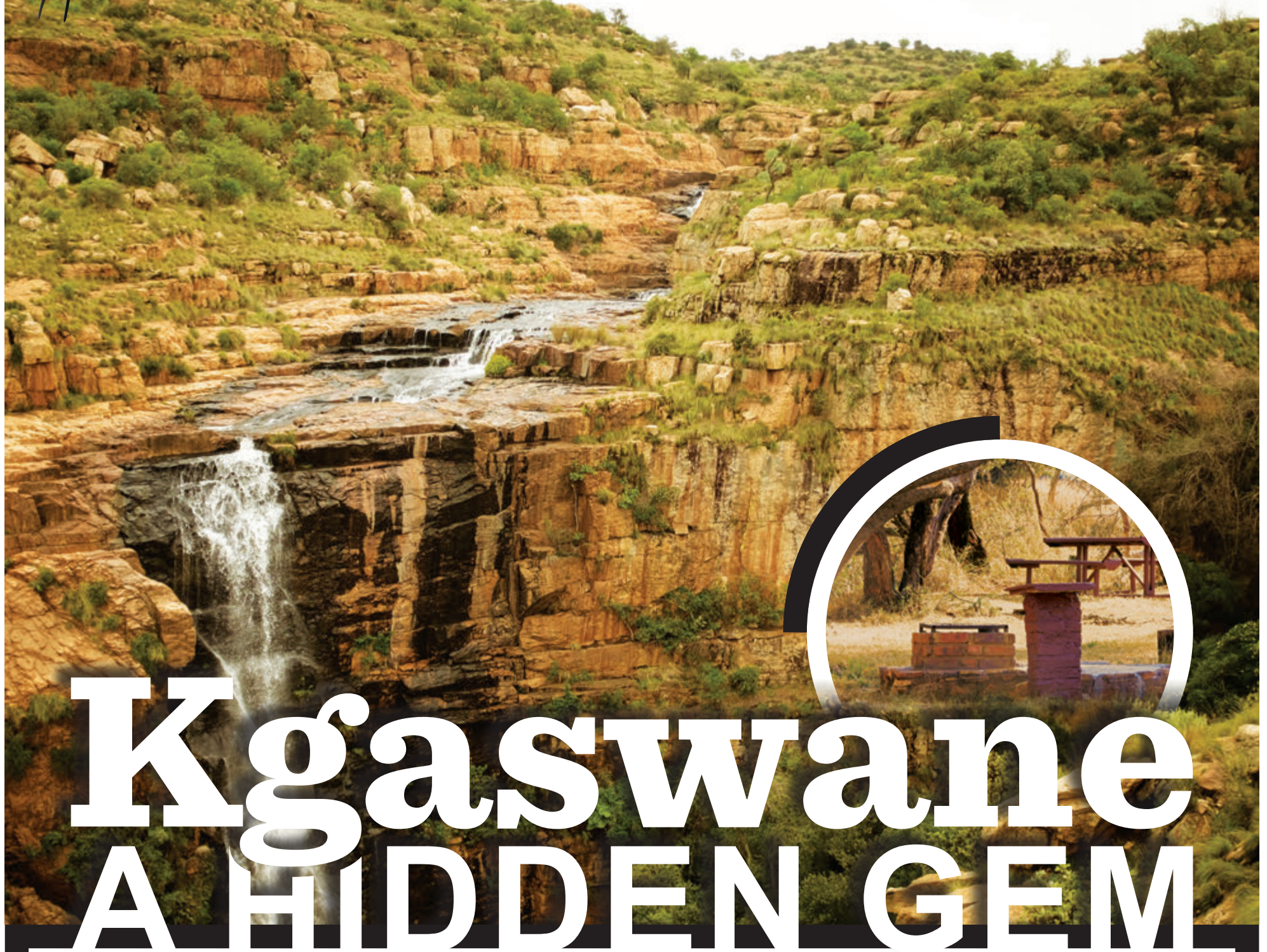

Kgaswane A HIDDEN GEM

Rustenburg – The Kgaswane Mountain Reserve is tucked away in the northern slopes of the Magaliesberg, some 10km from Rustenburg's CBD.

Kgaswane is the perfect destination for hiking because of its amazing rock formations and streams that wind their way through the valleys, giving rise to a unique and lush vegetation.

"The reserve, 54 years in existence, hosts more than 600 plant species and the wildlife includes the sable, rock rabbits, oribi, and eagles," ecologist

at North West Parks Board Pieter Nel said. There are 320 bird species at the reserve – an enthralling statistic for those who enjoy bird viewing. Visitors have also cited predators such as caracals, black-backed jackals, and leopards.

Originally established on Rietvallei Farm, which once belonged to President Paul Kruger, the reserve has gradually expanded over the years and now covers some 5,300 hectares. Vegetation comprising grassland, mixed woodland, and even

scattered pockets of fynbos thrive in this tranquil tourist attraction. More than 100 tree and bush species grow in this mountain reserve as well as several rare South African plants. Kgaswane has a large wetland that crosses the central part of the reserve. It was designated as a protected UNESCO Ramsar site in 2019, which identifies wetlands of international importance, particularly those providing wildfowl habitat. Those who have visited the reserve say the 5km Peglerae hiking trail is the best

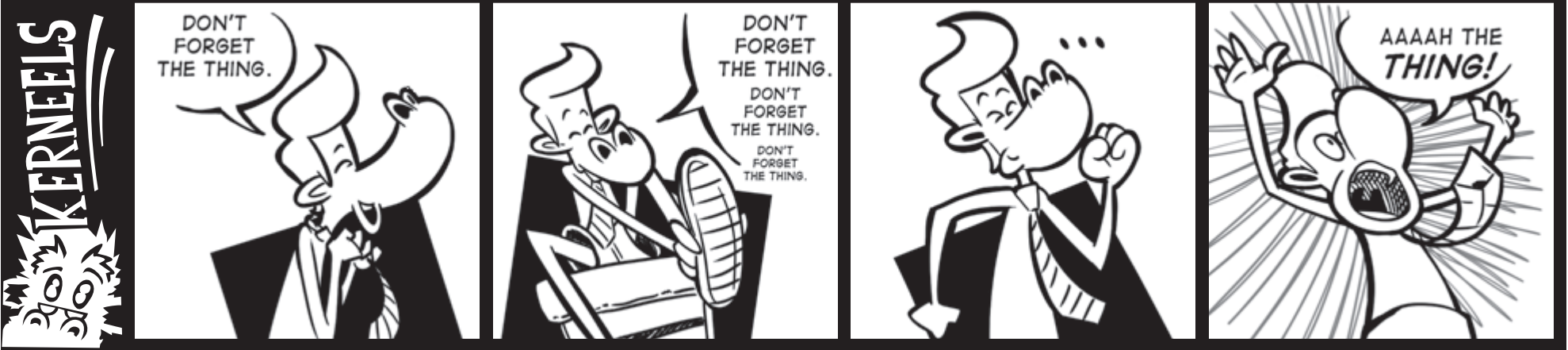
way to explore Kgaswane Mountain Reserve.

Daytime visitors can enjoy the reserve and access to its facilities at R40 per adult, R20 for children (aged 2 to 12), R20 for pensioners, and an additional R20 to enter with your vehicle.

"We have breath-taking trails and overnight hikers can enjoy accommodation in huts that have cooking utensils and firewood. Escape the hustle and bustle of the city – just around the corner!"

‘Camping’ in Kwaggapan



Rustenburg – Kwaggapan used to be hotspot for families to spend the day in nature and stories of a giraffe living there still echoes in the minds of many Rustenburg locals. I remember going on a school tour there as a grade 1 learner many moons ago...

Over the last few years, it has received a reputation of a dirty, unsafe slum, rape-area, and fires from the illegal structures can be seen flickering in the night.

In a joint effort, Community Policing Forum Sector 1, Rustenburg Crime Combatting Forum and METASEC Security Solutions general manager Morné Engelbrecht patrolled the area on Saturday 15 May. Among other things, they found several structures near the tar road as well as at the top of the hill. Since the gate at the entrance to Kwaggapan was stolen a long time ago (also published in our newspaper at the time), the area near the tower has also been used as a dumping site.

Most of these structures are alleged to belong to informal traders who sell items next to the road. This matter was brought to the attention of the municipality during a special council meeting on 7 May by Democratic Alliance councillor for ward 14 Gert du Plessis.

Said Gert: "In Kloofweg and Boven street, hawkers stay overnight with their merchandise next to the road. With no access to ablution or running water, the issue becomes muddy. We need the mayor and LED directorate to lay down rules that informal traders must not shack up with their store next to the road."

"Public Safety responded to the concerns and on 18 May, demolished four informal structures in accordance with the by-laws," said RLM spokesperson David Magae.

Do domestic workers and gardeners have the same rights as other employees?

The Constitutional Court of South Africa was faced with an issue concerning domestic workers. The issue arose from the Compensation for Occupational Injuries and Diseases Act ("COIDA Act") because it excluded domestic workers who are employed in private households from the definition of "employee" in the COIDA Act. The consequence of that exclusion was that it denied them compensation in the event they contract diseases, suffer disablement, injuries, or death in the course of their employment. For convenience, the reference to homeowners who have a domestic worker means "employer/s". In Sylvia Bongi Mahlangu and Another v Minister of Labour and Others 2020, Sylvia worked as a domestic worker until her unfortunate death. She drowned in her employer's pool. She had a daughter who was financially depended on her. The daughter claimed with the Department of Labour ("the Compensation Commissioner") and was advised that she could neither get compensation under the COIDA Act nor could she get unemployment insurance benefits.

This article does not discuss the ruling of the Constitutional Court. Rather, it provides some practical steps to employees and awareness to domestic workers to avoid being on the wrong side of the law. The objective of the COIDA Act is to facilitate a process that provides for payment of medical treatment and compensation for disablement caused by occupational injuries and diseases sustained by domestic workers, in the course of their employment, or for death, resulting from such injuries or diseases. Previously, the COIDA Act was silent on including domestic workers. The COIDA Amendment Bill ("the Bill") is before Parliament and includes domestic workers. A failure by an employer to attend to the above might result in exposure to financial or reputational risk and penalties. Please note that at the time of publishing, parliament had yet to call for written submission from the broader public. **Van Velden Duffey Inc.**

Tlhabane/ Rustenburg – Tlhabane Square, which is situated next to Ferncrest Hospital along the R104 Swaruggens Road, has already empowered community members by providing them with employment opportunities during the ongoing construction phase. With a rising unemployment rate in Tlhabane that has been worsened by the Covid-19 pandemic, the facility is already providing a livelihood to the many unskilled and semi-skilled locals who were finding it

difficult to make ends meet. Additionally, building materials such as sand, cement, bricks, concrete, mortar, reinforcing steel, filling material, plant equipment, and other items such as Covid-19 PPE (PPE) are being sourced from local suppliers. Once complete, Tlhabane Square will consist of a spacious mall, a hotel, a new Magistrate's Court, a taxi rank, offices for at least three government departments, a market for traders and many other facilities.

Meet the world's largest iceberg

Antarctica – An enormous iceberg has calved from the western side of the Ronne Ice Shelf, lying in the Weddell Sea, in Antarctica. The iceberg, dubbed A-76, measures around 4,320 square km in size – currently making it the largest berg in the world! Spotted in recent images captured by the Copernicus Sentinel-1 mission, the iceberg is around 170 km in length and 25 km wide, and is slightly larger than the Spanish island of Majorca. Rustenburg – Residents of Waterfall East are appealing to the Rustenburg Local Municipality to construct speed humps along Korokoro Avenue and 3rd Avenue after a car ploughed through the perimeter wall of a house in that area.

At around 11:00 on Sunday 25 April, a Mercedes Benz crashed through the wall and narrowly missed a security officer who was on patrol. MMC for Roads and Transport councillor Lucky Kgaladi told *Platinum Weekly* that the municipality is seriously looking into the safety concerns raised by the residents with a view of constructing speedhumps at strategic points.

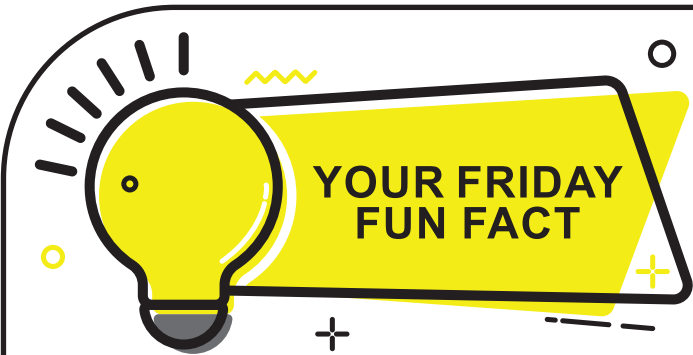

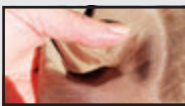

COVID REGULATIONS MAKES YOU FAT

Survey: more than half of South Africans gained weight during the pandemic, 69% bordering on obese



SA – While the intention of lockdown regulations and physical distancing was to contain the spread of COVID-19, the unintended consequences have been an economic crisis, record-high unemployment, and a “plumper” population.

A national survey conducted in the last two months among almost 2,000 South African adults paints a dire picture:

- 45% of respondents said lockdown regulations impacted their eating and exercise habits for the worse.
- 44% picked up between 2-5 kg; 15% are 6-10 kg heavier and 4% gained an extra 10 kgs or more.
- 58% of family members (spouse/ children) also packed on a few pounds.
- Increased weight gain in 15% of pets were also reported, which has equally real health consequences.
- 34% said their diet consists mainly of takeout and ready-made meals, while a further 30% said they eat what they can afford since their income has been impacted.
- 42% are exercising less than before the pandemic.
- 59% are currently on medication for a comorbidity such as heart disease, diabetes, or hypertension.

The survey was commissioned by Pharma Dynamics, the largest provider of cardiovascular medicine in the country, to assess the effect of the pandemic and the subsequent lockdown on the nation's eating and exercise patterns.

Nicole Jennings, spokesperson for Pharma Dynamics, said they are concerned about the long-term, negative effects that lockdown regulations have on SA's obesity epidemic. “SA's obesity-associated costs already stack up to an estimated R53.9-bn per annum, which puts a tremendous strain on our already fragile healthcare system.”

“The key to preventing heart disease or a stroke is to manage risk factors, such as high blood pressure, cholesterol and blood glucose levels. Regular blood pressure screening could mean the difference between life and death. In SA, ten people suffer a stroke every hour, while five succumb to a heart attack. Don't become a statistic, get yourself screened,” she encouraged. The public can visit either their GP or a pharmacy to have their blood pressure, cholesterol, and glucose levels taken and is advised to do so at least annually.

Rustenburg – Jaco Roodt's family is pleading for financial assistance to help cover his soaring medical and other costs. Roodt is unable to return to work for the foreseeable future. The past few months have been particularly unbearable for Jaco's wife and two children and the hospital bills only add to their sorrows. It all started on Wednesday 27 January when Roodt was taken for a COVID-19 test after he started exhibiting symptoms of the pandemic. The test came out negative. Says Jaco's wife: “He started getting very sick and was vomiting, so he went to another doctor for a check-up who then realised that Jaco (who is not a drinker) has a swollen liver and suffered heart failure.”

On Friday 5 February he was taken to Tshepong hospital in Klerksdorp where they diagnosed him with hepatitis. He was discharged the following day. On 11 February he went for more tests and would have gone for a sonar on 15 February, but on 13 February Jaco suffered a stroke. We immediately had to pay R3,600 for his assessment by the doctor and a drip but had to voluntarily discharge him as they requested a R50,000 deposit for him to be admitted. “By Sunday we raised R53,000 and Jaco was taken to Medicare by ambulance that Sunday evening.” He was placed in the intensive care unit after his health seriously deteriorated. On 20 February, with rising medical costs and no medical aid support, Roodt's family transferred him to Job Shimankane Tabane (JST) hospital.

When his condition stabilised a few days later Roodt's family voluntarily discharged him from hospital. On Friday 5 March, his family got the fright of their lives when he suffered a massive heart attack at around 03:00. Again, the Roodt family made an emergency trip to Medicare. They stabilised him and his wife had to voluntarily sign him out. That evening Jaco was back in JST.

The next morning Jaco suffered a second massive heart attack. “It looked like my husband died!”

Jaco's wife, Elsabe, said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*. He lost consciousness and the doctor struggled to bring Jaco back.

The two heart attacks also caused kidney failure. While the odometer rolled in fast-forward, bills mounted, and emotions heightened, Jaco was finally admitted to the Ga-Rankuwa hospital on 11 May.

His family appeals for financial assistance from those willing to open up their hearts to this worthy cause. He will not be getting a salary at the end of May and his sick leave has now been exhausted. This has put a massive strain on the family's ability to pay school fees for their children as well as meet their day-to-day expenses.
