













Laaste eerbetoon: Kaptein Henry Visagie



Rustenburg/ Northam/ Thabazimbi - Henry Visagie is in Zeerust gebore en het in Northam grootgeword waar sy pa die stasiekommissaris van die polisie was.

Uiteraard het dié jong seun baie by sy pa geleer van dissipline, asook die belangrikheid van diens aan die wapen in die hand geneem het. Hy was die trotse gemeenskap. Henry het in 1978 gematrikuleer aan die Hoërskool Frikkie Meyer, Thabazimbi, en het op 1 Desember 1978 by die polisie aangesluit. Hy het 36 jaar ononderbroke diens gehad en was bemind

onder almal met wie sy pad gekruis het. In 1991 is hy bevorder tot die rang van sersant en in 1994 tot die rang van adjudant offisier. Hy word bevorder tot die rang van kaptein gedurende 2009 en behou hierdie rang tot hy op 30 Junie 2015 uit die SAPD bedank. Hy was 'n alombekende en geliefde offisier, wat meestal in Phokeng en Rustenburg gestasioneer was.

Hy was die voormalige 'kantienmeester' in Rustenburg en het na-ure heerlik sosiaal verkeer saam met polisie-kollegas en lede van die publiek vir 'n tydperk van vier jaar. Hy was ook deel van die bestuur van die 'Teeninsurgensie (TIN) Eenheid Veterane' se komitee en het 'n waardevolle inset gelewer om hierdie trotse eenheid se herinneringe te laat voortleef.

Henry het as jong konstabel reeds vroeg sy staal gewys. Na voltooiing van sy kollege opleiding het hy kursusse in teeninsurgensie, "SWAT", vuurwapenopleiding, stelselbestuur en bestuur en instandhouding van swaarvoertuie suksesvol deurloop. Hy het vroeg reeds belangstelling en aanleg getoon in logistieke administrasie en homself hierin bekwaam. Hy was welbekend as die 'moeilike' man wat nie sou skroom om die wêreld vir polisielede moeilik te maak indien hulle nie kon verduidelik waar hul toerusting, vuurwapens, en uniformstukke was nie.

Hannelie Redelinghuys liefdevol beskryf word as haar Lovey van die afgelope 17 jaar. Hierdie troetelnaampie word selfs deur sommige van sy agt kleinkinders gebruik wanneer hul na Oupa verwys.

Baie polisielede ken hom as 'Fish' – vanweë sy van Visagie. Hy was 'n uiters bekwame skut en het groot respek op die skietbaan afgedwing wanneer hy 'n pa van drie biologiese dogters uit 'n eerste huwelik met Anita Visagie, naamlik Natalie, getroud met Cliff, en Doreen en Anita. Hannelie se kinders, Pieter en Carla, Marelize en Willem, asook Tanya en Eben Elsabe Augoustides

was baie lief vir Henry en hul het wonderlike tye as 'n familie geken.

Henry was uiters skeppend en kunstig en sy hande het vir niks verkeerd gestaan nie. Hy was lewenslustig, spitsvondig en 'n regte terggees. Hy het nie gehuiwer om enige geleentheid in 'n partytjie te omskep nie en was vreeslik lief vir musiek. Hy het menige persone laat skrik met sy welbekende hondeblaf-geluid wat hy graag geuiter het om mense op hol te jaag. Wanneer hul vererg omgevlieg het, het hy gewoonlik geskater van die lag.

Na sy bedanking uit die SAPD het Henry hom besig gehou met algemene instandhouding en het hy 'n heerlike tuiste vir hom, Hannelie en die familie geskep op hul kleinhoewe in die Dinie Estates omgewing. Henry was veral erg oor sy Boerboel 'Visagie' en het geboer met ganse, hase, visse, skilpaaie, en hoenders. Hy het steeds sy tyd tot beskikking van die polisie en gemeenskap gestel en was altyd beskikbaar om met landelike beveiliging te help. Hannelie en Henry was reeds sedert 2004 in 'n verhouding, maar sy onthou hoe hul op 5 Februarie 2011 besluit het om, op haar vyftigste verjaardag ook sommer in die huwelik te tree. Dit was 'n spesiale en glansryke geleentheid waaraan Henry ure se beplanning spandeer het. Hul resep vir 'n gelukkige huwelik was wedersydse respek, betrokkenheid, en waardering vir mekaar.

Hy was op sy gelukkigste as hy kon video's en foto's neem. Die SAPD se Lugvleuel van Potchefstroom was daardie betrokke dag in die omgewing en het 'n spesiale verbyvlug en landing uitgevoer.

Henry het 'n spesiale band met die vlieëniers boordbemanning gehad en het geen geleentheid laat verbygaan om saam met hul aan misdaadvoorkomingsoperasies deel te neem nie. Hy was 'n wonderlike leermeester en het met groot geduld talle polisielede opgelei en hul kennis van polisiewerksaamhede uitgebrei.

Henry was sonder pretensie en het altyd gesê: "What you see, is what you get". Met sy bedanking uit die polisie het hy hartseer verklaar dat hy nie voorsien dat hy 'n lang aftrede sou hê nie.

Juis daarom het hy in oorvloed gelewe en het hy elke dag as 'n geskenk van die Skepper ervaar. Ons groet 'n "Groot Gees" vanuit ons Polisie geledere. Sy erfenis van omgee, dissipline, en trots sal vir ewig voortleef.

According to information received the Rainbow processing plant was supposed to **Spearheading the community** shut down on Friday 11 June 2021, due to environmental non-compliance. Apparently, the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality's (BPDM) municipal manager ordered the said he knows that the community shutdown to be suspended.

In a letter drafted by a representative of the Zinniaville community it reads: 'The Zinniaville community is thwarted at every turn by the apparent alliance between certain officials of the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality (BPDM) and RCL/ Rainbow. Having started the latest bout of their campaign to clean up RCL/ Rainbow in April, the BPDM inspectors meticulously followed every procedure and to clean up their act and fulfil their regulatory Duty of Care."

However, RCL/ Rainbow apparently did not on Friday 11 June, the plant was meant to be shut down due to persistent non-compliance. "To the utter surprise of disheartened inspectors, they saw four months of work unilaterally and casually discarded because of the actions of the Bojanala acting municipal manager Tshepo Bloom, who unilaterally ordered the shutdown to be suspended," the letter reads.

Discussions between community lawyers and municipal officials, including the head of the legal department, agreed that the executive mayor and municipal manager would address

the issue with the community on Monday 14 June at 19h30 at the Zinniaville Sports Ground. However, they reneged on this commitment later the day and said that they would send representatives. The community then decided to cancel the meeting as it would have been a waste of time, not meeting with the decision makers.

ZINNIAVILLE ELECTRICITY OUTAGE SPARKS PROTEST

Zinniaville/ Rustenburg - A two-day power failure in parts of Zinniaville and Karlien Park caused community members to embark on a protest.

On Saturday 12 June, an angry group of protestors brought traffic to a standstill at the railway crossing on the road from Rustenburg North to Zinniaville. The protestors - who said they had gone for two days without electricity - placed rocks, burning tyres, and tree branches at the four-way stop and made it impossible for traffic to pass through. During the protest, they loudly clamoured for electricity to be restored.

The arrival of the police, after about two hours, led to the dispersion of the protestors who feared being arrested. Police, personnel from the Rustenburg Department of Public Safety, as well as passers-by eventually cleared the road to enable traffic to pass through.

Power utility Eskom has implementing load-shedding across many parts of the country. "The situation is being made worse by some people who are connecting electricity illegally because this trips the system and causes power outages," said a disgruntled Karlien Park community member.

NORTH WEST DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT 2021/2022 BUDGET SPEECH

FOOD AND NUTRITION SECURITY

In the financial year 2020/21, a total of 3761 households benefitted from Agricultural food security initiatives. A total of 11 939.8 hectares were planted for food production in communal areas and land reform projects.

In an effort to improve the provincial status on Food and Nutrition Security, during the 2021/22 financial year, the Department will, through the Conditional Grants of CASP and ILIMA, assist two-hundred and ten (210) farmers across the province to plant 13 500 hectares of land within the Grain commodity. An amount of R55, 882,242 is earmarked for this.

From the 13 500ha, 12 000ha will be planted in Ngaka Modiri Molema district, within 50Km radius of Springbokpan silos. A total of hundred and thirteen (113) farmers from the nearby 15 villages will benefit from these project.

To deal with the issue of households food inadequacy, 2 400 households across the province will be assisted (through the ILIMA fund) with food and nutrition security intervention packages, which inter alia, include packages for household gardens, layer packages and goat production packages. An amount of R13, 958,974 is earmarked for this.

The department will produce seedlings at its centres like Kgora Farmer Training, Taung and Potchefstroom College of Agriculture to augment the ILIMA Household food and nutrition security packages which will then be distributed to households for establishment of gardens.

The department will further provide households with indigenous chickens for rearing.

The chickens will be hatched and supplied from our Kgora Farmer.

FARMER SUPPORT AND DEVELOPMENT

For farmers who are affected by drought, the Department will plant one-hundred and sixty (160) hectares of Lucerne through the ILIMA conditional grant. A total of R6.8 million will be spent in this regard, to benefit 422 farmers.

SUPPORT FOR PRIMARY PRODUCERS

Primary production remains fundamental to various commodities for the provincial agricultural economy to sustainably grow within previously disadvantaged farming sector. For that, the department has earmarked R79.6 million from the CASP grant to assist 987 smallholder producers in primary production across the province.

WATER PROVISION FOR LIVESTOCK

Areas and farmers struggling with access to livestock water will be assisted this financial year. A total of R10.3 million from the CASP grant will be used to drill and equip boreholes, with 681 farmers benefitting from this initiative.

SMALLHOLDER HORTICULTURE EMPOWERMENT & PROMOTION PROGRAMME (SHEP)

The North West Province has completed training on smallholder horticulture empowerment & promotion on its Agricultural Extension Personnel, and will roll-out the programme with farmers throughout the financial year, in an effort to enable access to markets.

ARABLE FARMING

The department will strengthen capacity of grain production for Extension and grain producers through on-farm trials and structured empowerment programmes in partnership with commodity organizations such as Grain SA, Dry Bean Producers Organization and South African Agriculture Association

VET SERVICES

For the financial year 2021/22 the Department has received eleven (11) Compulsory Community Service Veterinarians (CCS). They are distributed to the rural component of province and have started to make an impact there. Primary Animal Health Care (PAHC) programme is unfolding in all the rural areas of the North West and is complimented by the Compulsory Community Service (CCS) programme. The programme focuses on preventative interventions in farming enterprises and it deals with such activities like de-worming, control of external parasites, vaccination and general animal husbandry.

AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS SERVICES

North West farming communities will be supported with the development of bankable business plans that will assist in sourcing of funding for their operations from government and financial institutions.

STRUCTURED AGRICULTURAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING

The Department has acquired two hundred and seventy five (275) laptops for students in response to Covid-19's impact on teaching and learning. The objective is to promote blended learning model. Both Colleges will continue to embrace the digital space in the academic arena.

RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND JOB CREATION

The department will roll out the implementation of three (3) rural infrastructure development initiatives. A total of 600 jobs will be created during the current fiscal year. The breakdown is as follows 250 Green Jobs created through Sustainable Resource Management, 150 Jobs created through Rural Development and the 200 temporary jobs through CASP and ILIMA.

The department will further construct a 6km access road to the Kgora Farmer Training Centre in Mahikeng (Ngaka Modiri Molema District) whilst creating 20 temporary jobs in the process, to the tune of R10million.

In its endeavour to establish a knowledgeable, prosperous & competitive sector, the department will further train 980 participants in Skills Development Programmes.

SUSTAINABLE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

North West Department of Agriculture and Rural Development has managed to rehabilitate 3 639, hectares of agricultural land to increase the grazing capacity and arable land. The department will further roll out Global Soil Campaigns to empower communities about the importance of soil for vegetation and crops during the fiscal year 2021/2022.

NON-FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE & HR MATTERS

In ensuring that the department execute and out its mandate effectively, the Department has prioritized filling of critical including that of the Head of Department. The new Head of North West Department of Agriculture and Rural Development is Mr Thupi Zacharia Mokhatla.

The Department has also appointed forty six (46) Agricultural Extension officers, 18 of which are appointed on contract basis through the CASP's Extension Recovery Programme (ERP). These are the foot soldiers and are committed to ensure that every community member receives quality agricultural extension services.

MEC MADODA SAMBATHA TABLES DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH BUDGET FOR 2021/22 FINANCIAL

The North West Health MEC Madoda Sambatha tabled a departmental budget vote for 2021/22 financial at the North West Provincial Legislature on 27 May 2021 in Mahikeng. The budget outlined the department of Health allocations for the current financial year and beamed the way forward for the department's aspirations to meet its mandate and obligations to provide essential services to the people.

The health budget allocation for the 2021/22 financial year is R 14,119 billion as indicated by North West Provincial Treasury. This amount is inclusive of the COVID 19 earmarked fund amounting to R562 million. From an economic classification point of view, this year's budget allocation includes:

- R9.4 billion for compensation of employees; 67% of the total budget
- R 3.8 billion for Goods and Services; 28% of the total budget
- R 140.1 million for transfers and subsidies; 1% of the total budget
- R 549.1 million for capital assets, 4% of the total budget.

The MEC hastened to announce that the current budget is tabled under the difficult economic outlook of the country due to pressures exacerbated by the Covid-19 pandemic.

"The Covid-19 health pandemic has now assumed the make-up of a serious socioeconomic challenge. As we speak, this virus has significantly disrupted lifestyles, businesses have been severely affected and public health institutions are experiencing unprecedented levels of financial and clinical stress. We report to this august house that the department could not implement its Revenue Enhancement Strategies properly due to the Covid-19 related Disaster Regulations" added MEC Sambatha.

The Department of Health will forge ahead with most of its plans to improve health services by maintaining the existing infrastructures, improvement of health facilities to meet the Ideal Clinic model standards. To build strong and concrete stakeholder, partnerships as well as collaborations with different role-players in the health sector.

"We however remain committed to use the 2021/22 allocation to provide quality healthcare to the people of this province. We strive to add value by applying this budget in the most efficient way in order to make a positive impact" concluded Sambatha.

MEC MADODA SAMBATHA COMMITS THE DEPARTMENT BUDGET TO HEALTH INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT ACROSS THE PROVINCE

The North West Department of Health MEC Madoda Sambatha has committed to health infrastructure improvement and maintenance during the tabling of the 2021/22 budget vote presented to the House (Provincial Legislature) today, 27 May 2021 in Mahikeng. This is explicitly expressed by the department's commitment of R 618 922 000 (Six hundred and eighteen million, nine hundred and twenty two thousands rand) in the current financial year.

The department of Health remains committed to use the 2021/22 allocation to provide quality healthcare to the people of this province. As it strives to add value by applying this budget in the most efficient way in order to make a positive impact.

The Department has continued to roll out the ideal clinic realization programme and strengthen the ideal hospital programme. Progress made is that 48 of 310 facilities have attained ideal status. A total of 20 facilities have attained a Platinum status while 18 are at gold and 10 on silver. For the first time all Districts in this province have facilities that attained Platinum status" said MEC Madoda Sambatha

MEC Sambatha reiterated the Department of Health mandate of ensuring access to health facilities by constructing new ones and maintaining existing ones. Sekhing CHC and staff accommodation is at 85% progress and the revised completion date is September 2021. Jouberton CHC admitted its first patients on 12 May 2021. The Existing Exelcius Nursing College construction is in progress at 90% completion and the revised target date for completion is November 2021.

"The Department is in the process of awarding in 2021/22 the contract for the replacement of Motswedi CHC and Rapulana clinic. A contract for the refurbishment of

the dilapidated Gelukspan Hospital will also be awarded in 21/22 financial year. The Department is in the processes of advertising the following projects: Bophelong Psychiatric Hospital Phase 3, Maintenance projects for Taung Hospital, Ganyesa Hospital, Lehurutshe Hospital and Koster Hospital. Planning and Design of the following facilities will be completed in 2020/21: Lebotloane CHC, Maquassie Hills CHC and Manthe CHC. Renovation will be done to 34 clinics and local SMMEs will be awarded this work" concluded MEC Sambatha

MORE RESOURCES CHANNELED TO FIGHT COVID-19

The North West Health MEC Madoda Samabatha has during his tabling of the 2021-22 Budget Speech, indicated that the Province has channelled more of the available resources to fight the Coronavirus.

Sambatha said that the 2020/21 financial year was a period within which much of our resources were used to prevent and contain Covid-19 and current statistics in the country and in the province indicate that the fight against Covid-19 will continue in the current financial year.

"We extend our heartfelt condolences to the families of All NW people and especially of the health care workers who lost their lives due to Covid-19. In the same vein I wish to convey our deep appreciation to the health care workers of North West Province for their dedication in managing the pandemic in both our community and health facility settings", said MEC Sambatha

The Budget Speech noted that the province managed to create a total of 1179 beds specifically for Covid-19 of which 50 are ICU beds and 57 are high care beds. We still feature amongst the provinces with the lowest per-population incidence of Covid-19 and the NW has the lowest case fatality rate among all provinces.


This is due to:

- Dedicated frontline staff and managers with willingness to multi-task, take problems in their stride, immediately think of options for solutions and act
- Guidance and cooperation from the NW Covid-19 Command Council
- Action from NW Covid-19 District Command Councils
- Good cooperation with Provincial Treasury
- Good cooperation with sister departments (provincial and national), other provincial departments, private sector, NGO sector, traditional leaders and academia

In February 2021, the NW Province, along with the other eight provinces in the country, started the Covid-19 vaccine roll-out.

Employees of the Department particularly health professionals were appreciated for their contribution in the fight against the pandemic. "Again, our staff proved their mettle by enthusiastically throwing their efforts behind this endeavor. In the week of 17 May we continued with vaccination of health workers while starting to vaccinate persons over 60 years of age", said MEC Sambatha.

A full security plan for safe guarding the vaccination and quarantine sites for Covid-19 was developed and implemented. The Department also continue to rely on the South African Police Services (SAPS) to assist with vandalism at health facilities caused by criminal elements.

Department of Social Development BUDGET FOR 2021/22 FINANCIAL by MEC Molloa

DEVELOPMENTAL SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITY

THE WELFARE of the vulnerable in the society – children, women, persons with disabilities, older persons and substance abuse – will continue to top service delivery priorities of the Department of Social Development in the financial year of 2021/2022.

Tabling the 2021/2022 Budget Vote for the department of Social Development, MEC Boitumelo Moiloa says the services of children will not suffer despite the migration of Early Childhood Development services to the department of Education.

MEC Moiloa has assured the province that, "the two departments have pledged their commitment that there will be no interruption to service delivery during the transition process".

On children in conflict with the law, alternative care placement for them remains critical to the department. We have two Child and Youth Care Centres for Secure Care Programmes that accommodate 130 children in conflict with the law awaiting trial and residential diversion services. An amount of R83.6 million is committed to ensure full operation of these centres this financial year.

The department will honour the North Gauteng High Court order to extend foster care placements and payments in collaboration with SASSA and Department of Justice and Constitutional Development by the end of the financial year.

Our task at hand is to place 1 685 children on foster care and ensure that 19 366 have valid foster care court orders during 2021/22.

The department has committed R360 million to fund 658 Non Profit Organisations (NPOs), of which R44,8 million will be transferred to 37 Child and Youth Care Centres and Child Protection organisations across the province.

The pockets of poverty continue to dominate many areas of our society, "we have established four District Departmental Poverty Eradication Coordination Forums to:

- Pian, coordinate and align inter-departmental programmes and budgets.
- Monitor and evaluate the service delivery commitments and programme performance and budget expenditure per intervention and per project.
- · To serve as a resource in the piloting of poverty eradication programmes
- Refer profiles of various community members to core programmes for implementation of interventions.

Majority of our youth have resigned themselves to life of unemployment but not under the watch of this caring government. For Social Development, "we have set aside an amount of R15 million to train 300 unemployed young people on civil construction and mixed farming through our National Youth Service programme".

Other opportunities are opened through Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP), whereby the department has created work opportunities for 2 368 participants.

Support for women cooperatives and SMME's to improve their livelihoods will continue. The support translates in capacity building, mentoring and procurement of equipment and other necessities for women cooperatives and SMME's.

About 60 women will participate in empowerment programmes, while 158 will benefit from economic strengthening initiatives. The department has set aside an amount of R4 million to implement this programme.

We remain steadfast on our fight on abuse of women and children, while providing counselling to mental-scarred victims.

The White Doors facilities across the province continue to offer hope and solace to the victims. We have 950 victims of Gender Based Violence to access sheltering services at state run Khuseleka One Stop centre and crisis centres.

There will be psychological support in the form of counselling, and they will also be prepared for court appearance once they are admitted at these centres for 8 493 Victims of Gender Based Violence.

DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ENVIRONMENT, CONSERVATION AND TOURISM 2021/22 BUDGET SPEECH HIGHLIGHTS

The department through North West Development Corporation (NWDC) will continue to disperse R10 million of Relief Fund to support SMMEs and informal traders with recovery packages.

The Department, together with Provincial Treasury has appointed the University of North West to conduct research on identifying key products that government procures within and outside the province.

The research findings will be made available by the end of the first quarter in 2021/22. For this financial year, the focus will be to continue to set aside 30 % of the provincial goods and services budget to procure from local SMMEs without fail.

The Bojanala Special Economic Zone will continue to build an industrial estate to host investment mixed use zone, capital equipment manufacturing zone, renewable energy zone, agro-processing zone and minerals beneficiation zone.

The department will during this financial year revise the business case for the application of the Operator Licence. The SEZ Operator Company will be formalized before the end of August 2021 and the Accounting Authority will be appointed to operationalise the company.

The department in partnership with Small Enterprise Development Agency (SEDA) will expand the Digital and Township Hubs in other districts in the Province toprovide start-up business development support services in manufacturing and digital solutions.

The department has set aside R10 million, to implement Informal Trade Market Programme, to support municipalities to establish informal traders market. The informal traders market, will support the integration of the informal trading businesses into beneficial buyer groups and distribution networks. The project is implemented in partnership with Mamusa Local Municipality and Dr Ruth District Municipality.

In an effort to boost sustainable trade markets and permanent flea markets an amount of R8million has been set aside. The Department in collaboration with key municipalities and stakeholders will ensure that this sector creates the much-needed jobs for the people in the Province. This intervention is intended to start with Mahikeng Trade Market Project.

The department has partnered with Automotive Industrial Development Centre (AIDC) to implement Youth Automotive Skills Development Programme at a budget of R3.8 million. To-date 120 youth/in Bojanala and Dr Kenneth Kaunda District Municipalities have been placed in the programme, it is envisaged that the programme will continue in this current financial year.

In an effort to create jobs the department will implement Youth Technical Skills and Infrastructure Maintenance programme at a budget of R6.7 million. The programme will empower youth skills in road marking and pothole patching in partnership with the municipalities.

This partnership was promoted in 2020 with a number of municipalities that have already provided the budget for Road Marking and Pothole sealing. The Department will be providing work gear, training on pothole repairs and stipend for the participating youth.

In addressing business skills for SMMEs and Cooperatives, the department is implementing Business Advisory Programme in partnership with Service Sector Education and Training Authority (Services SETA). Call for applications from unemployed graduates within the province to be trained as Business advisors was advertised and was closed on the 31st of May 2021.

The programme will create one hundred (100) business advisors in the province and graduates will be empowered with the aim of opening their own business coaching enterprises. They will be required to train five (5) SMMEs each as per contract deliverables.

To revive the rural economy through the Township Bakery Skill Support Programme, R1.3 million will be pent in the first year of implementation. The programme will provide support and enhance the productivity of 10 township and village bakeries and confectionaries. The programme will be implemented over a three year period.

As part of the skills development programme, 10 young women will receive training and be assisted to register their own companies in the energy efficiency and green energy space.

The Awarding of the application for the Fifth Casino license to create more sustainable jobs in the retail industry and tourism sectors.
