

The public is cautioned against accepting any dye-stained notes as legal tender because the onward use and value of these notes will not be honoured. Liquid dyes may stain the notes with a bluish-purple,

SA - The slogan, "A stained note is probably red, black or green colour. Such notes may give off a smell like that of paint initially and will stain fingers when touched. In a press statement by SABRIC, ATMs hold cash in special containers that protect cash with dye-stain technology that is activated when someone tries to break open the container. Once activated, the cash is stained with a green dye, thus defacing the notes, rendering them unusable as currency. SABRIC is a NPF company formed by South African banks to support the banking industry in combating crime.



So when his contract ended, he started designing a scale model underground locomotive. 



- 150g grated cheddar
- 20g parmesan 100g breadcrumbs




