

STOCK THEFT LANDS DUO IN COURT

NW – Two men accused of stock theft appeared before the Lehurutshe Magistrates' Court for a second time on Tuesday 27 July. Orapeleng Seletse and Keineetse, who were arrested on Thursday 15 July, have been linked to an incident in which at least eight cattle were stolen on a farm in Groot Marico. "The two were arrested by members of Lehurutshe Stock Theft Unit during a controlled operation. Eight stolen cattle were retrieved to the value of R70,000," police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh said. During the appearance, Seletse was granted R500 bail while Tau was remanded in custody. Police are carrying out further investigations to establish more facts on the case. Provincial commissioner of police in the North West lieutenant general Sello Kwenja applauded the Stilfontein, Phokeng and Lehurutshe South African Police Services (SAPS) stock theft units for achieving this breakthrough.

EXPECT TO BE SCAMMED



NW – Police in the North West have urged members of the community to be vigilant whenever they visit online sites to avoid falling prey to scams involving the sale of vehicles or livestock. The warning comes following an increase in reports of people losing money to scammers operating in Makwassie, Leeudoringstad, Boskuil and Wolmaransstad. Police spokesperson colonel Adèle Myburgh revealed that a man lost R100,000 in one such scam, which occurred on Monday 19 July. This was after the man, thinking he was buying a taxi, deposited money into a bank account in response to an "advertisement" from a scammer posing as an auctioneer. "On his way to collect his taxi, the seller, who agreed to meet the 'buyer' in Wolmaransstad, switched his phone off and could not be reached," Myburgh said.

"In another incident, a victim drove from East London to Wolmaransstad to buy a Toyota Hilux. He was taken to a house where they showed him the vehicle. The victim, accompanied by his brother, met the seller while sitting inside their vehicle, waiting for the vehicle and documentation. Four suspects approached them, pointed a firearm at them and robbed them of R200,000," colonel Myburgh added. An advertised car that does not have a vehicle registration document (V5C) or has an altered document for example, is likely to have been stolen. "Look at a wide range of vehicles and don't get pressured to buy immediately. It is also a good idea to bring along friends before a transaction is concluded so that they can assist you to verify the legalities," Myburgh explained.

What is cultivated meat?

Basically, it is muscle cells that are painlessly harvested from living animal food sources like cows and game. Scientists then feed and nurture these cells to multiply, creating muscle tissue, which is the main component of the meat we eat. It is biologically exactly the same as the meat tissue of its donor... and it's delicious! "Our goal is to use cutting-edge scientific research and innovation to enhance the health, socio-economic and environmental impact of consumer meat products, one meal at a time," said Mogale Meat's chief executive officer doctor Paul Bartels.



"With a significant increase in our population, we are also rapidly exceeding our ability to supply affordable nutritious foods. Cultured meat is a giant leap forward in meat production. In the long run it will reduce the strain on our natural environment and resources, but this is not the only benefit. Growth hormones and antibiotics in meat derived from factory farms, disrupt normal metabolic processes and exacerbate antibiotic resistance, while zoonotic diseases are increasing due to the practices of factory farming and wet markets – an aspect that will significantly decrease through the process of cultivating meat. **Livestock methane gas contributes more emissions than all the transport in the world put together. In short – cows are farting the earth into an early grave.** Further livestock production would exacerbate current rates and further degrade our environment. Cultivated meat will lessen the burden on our environment. Cell-cultured meat will contribute significantly to our biodiversity. Unrelenting land clearing

and the planting of additional fodder crops needed to feed more livestock, collectively eliminate untold wildlife habitats and biodiversity. Less livestock means more wildlife habitat. However, cultivating meat does come with its own unique challenges. "Start-up businesses

The second biggest challenge is scale-up, which requires the design of purpose-built bioreactors, similar to micro-brewery bioreactors, that can make meat in bulk," Paul explained. **But does it taste like the real thing?** Currently there is only one country in the world where you can purchase cell-cultured chicken meat nuggets, and that's in Singapore. Singapore is the first country in the world to approve the sale of cell-cultured meat. Other countries which are gearing up their production capabilities and getting Health and Food regulatory approvals, include the United States of America, Netherlands and Israel. Apparently, the cultured meat is the real deal, tasting exactly the same as farm-to-fork beef.




