Rustenburg – A couple from East End, Rustenburg's lives changed for ever on Tuesday 14 September when their house burned down.

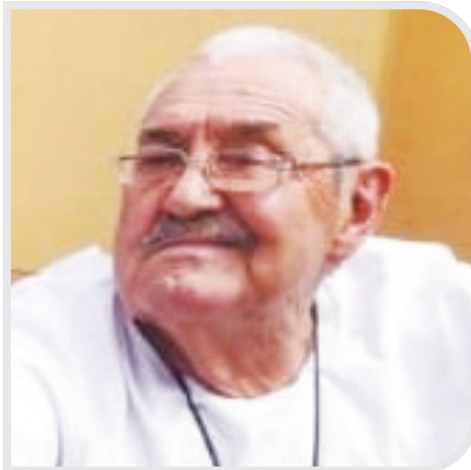
The fire spread through their house room by room. The couple and their mother managed to escape before everything they own went up in flames.

No conscience when money is involved... Transformer oil theft

Rustenburg – As long as there is a market for something, it will be stolen and sold. If there is no market for it, thieves create a market for it. This is what is happening with transformer oil. They even sell it as cooking oil, threatening the health and lives of the end user.

The theft of transformer oil and electrical cables is on the rise in Rustenburg. Municipal infrastructure has also been vandalised by criminals. It causes power outages that frustrates local businesses and households alike. At this trend, it will definitely hamper the local economy.

METASEC Security Solutions general manager Morné Engelbrecht told *Platinum Weekly* that criminals operating in Rustenburg (targeting Rustenburg East) are vandalising electrical substations and draining oil from the transformers. He says that there is a lucrative market in South Africa and beyond the borders of the country for transformer oil. Says Engelbrecht: "Transformer oil is sold as cooking oil – for which there is a large market."

Power utility Eskom has previously warned that using transformer oil to cook food could result in serious health complications or death.

Engelbrecht also explained why transformer oil is so in demand in the fuel sector: "Diesel is an expensive fuel and when diluted with oil, can be sold more profitably. I believe criminals are selling the stolen oil to businesses at a fraction of the cost that they normally pay for diesel."

Engelbrecht also fears that the high demand for transformer oil in Southern African countries like Zimbabwe, Zambia and Mozambique could result in further vandalism of electrical infrastructure and theft.

Protestors throw stones at police

Rustenburg – On Monday 6 September a group of ANC members threw stones at police vehicles before blocking the entrance to the Rustenburg Civic Centre during a protest.

The three-hour protest was held to demonstrate their unhappiness over the list of councillors that have been nominated in Rustenburg to represent the ANC during elections scheduled for 1 November.

“They threw stones at a police van. Some of them went to the entrance of the Civic Centre and attempted to open the gate forcefully,” an eyewitness said.

The protestors declined to be interviewed by *Platinum Weekly*.

Similar protests, some much more violent are taking place every day of the week against the process by which the ANC selects its councillors. Some members even threaten to boycott the upcoming election.

They must keep in mind that ‘a house divided cannot stand’.

ANOTHER R24 VICTIM Kidnapped, assaulted and robbed

Rustenburg – A 21-year-old man was kidnapped and assaulted before being forced to hand over his bank card and pin, robbing him of R1,000. “The victim was driving a silver Polo Vivo on the R24 at around 15:00 when a black Golf 4 overtook his vehicle. The driver of the Golf then slammed the brakes in front of the victim’s vehicle,” police spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides said. “Four African men, who got out of the Golf, allegedly assaulted the victim

before forcing him into their vehicle. They drove with him to the filling station where they forced him to hand over his bank card. A withdrawal of R1,000 was made,” Augoustides added. The four men fled the scene with the money and left the injured victim at the filling station. The victim, whose vehicle was found abandoned along the R24, is recovering from his injuries. Police are investigating a case of kidnapping, robbery and assault.

Oh, what a wicked web they weave! There is a scam for everything under the sun

Rustenburg – In 2017, Arthur Moyo secured vehicle finance from a car dealership in Rustenburg using fake bank statements, salary payslips and identity documents. They were but one of four companies targeted by the 32-year-old Moyo in a fraud scheme he carried out across three provinces.

On Friday 10 September 2021, Moyo was caught in his own wicked web when he was jailed for an effective 15 years by the eMalahleni Regional Court. This was after he was convicted on four counts of fraud and contravening sections of the Identification Act 68 of 1997.

Moyo was found guilty of defrauding a total of R1.6 million from banks. He was also sentenced for fraudulently securing vehicle finance from a motor vehicle dealer in Rustenburg, Klerksdorp Motor Smart, Polokwane Galactic Auto and Nel Auto Mazda Witbank from 2016 to 2017. His activities have highlighted the need for dealerships, banks and anyone involved in the buying and selling of cars to be aware of vehicle scams targeting unsuspecting victims.

Police spokesperson colonel Adèle Myburgh told *Platinum Weekly* that about 8% of reported fraud

cases in the North West province were linked to vehicle finance incidents.

“Whether you are buying a car or selling a car, always be on the lookout for car scams and take the necessary precautions to avoid being scammed,” Myburgh said. “Scammers will refuse to provide sufficient contact details. The phone number provided is either faulty, remains unanswered or goes directly to voice mail. They will also usually make an excuse for not being available via telephone. Scammers may demand the full price of the car, or a deposit, to be transferred immediately. Once they have received the money, they fail to release the vehicle and become difficult to contact,” she added.

On how best to avoid being scammed by a car buyer, Myburgh advised against allowing a person to test drive a car alone. “Never leave the car or the keys unattended or left in the ignition. A key swop is a common method used by criminals to steal a car.”

In instances where buyers offer to pay in cash, Myburgh advises car owners to arrange to meet at a bank where the authenticity of the money can be verified.

‘Prime’ picnic property

Rustenburg – A piece of land next to the N4 (Swartruggens Road) in the vicinity of Ananda has once again become prime picnic property for landgrabbers as they started with another attempt to illegally occupy it on Sunday 11 September.

This piece of land was first targeted in 2016 when a group of people started demarcating stands on it to put up informal structures. When they tried again in 2018 the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) obtained a court order to have the trespassers evicted. Large boards with copies of the court order on it was erected on the site. One of the boards has since been removed. In 2019, there was another attempt by a group of people to get their slice of the illegal cake, but they were again evicted. This piece of land falls under a natural biosphere which means that it cannot be used as a residential area and may only be used for tourism or agricultural purposes. Soil samples were also tested, and it was declared unstable for residential development. No sewage or water systems can be installed here which really makes it not fit for a settlement.

However, it would definitely make for a nice picnic area and can easily be developed into a tourism attraction.

There is a genuine need to resettle many people in the area, as many of them worked on nearby farms which were sold over the years and by now, many of these people have nowhere else to go. Funny enough, it was not these people that popped up at the property. Many of the photos that were sent from various stakeholders to the *Platinum Weekly*

show well-to-do people, driving expensive cars, staking their claim.

The *Platinum Weekly* received information from various sources indicating that action will soon be taken but that there is more than meets the eye behind this land invasion.

Another portion of land has since been identified where those who qualify for resettlement can be relocated to, but all attempts to get the project rolling has apparently been stonewalled.

Platinum Weekly contacted the RLM for comment but at time of going to print we had not received an official response.

TRAIL BLAZING



A proactive group of Majakaneng community members have started to create a hiking trail along the Magaliesberg mountains.

Rustenburg – Majakaneng is nestled at the foot of the Magaliesberg mountains about 50km from Rustenburg. While the settlement has often made the news because of their protests, demanding basic service delivery, a group of locals are busy changing this perception. They decided to roll up their sleeves and take a hands-on approach to bettering their community, while protecting their heritage and the environment. That is where the idea for the Majakaneng Hiking Trail started. The team are learning and developing as they go along and are proud to take tourists through the mountains in guided tours. *Platinum Weekly* had the privilege to go hiking along this trail. This unique experience starts when you drive through the settlement

towards the mountain. Friendly locals wave while you drive past and you are soon captivated by the unique ways they have found to bridge obstacles, and their zest for life. The world where Covid-19 rules every conversation and people are stuck in the rat race is soon forgotten. As you walk along the trail, you uncover its beautiful hidden gems like natural pools, a variety of bird and plant species and scenic views. “I have been living in Majakaneng for most of my life. Even as a child I remember playing in the mountains with my friends. It is part of our heritage, and we knew we had to preserve this heritage for future generations,” trail developer Joseph Mokwena said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*.

Many locals are dependent on the mountains. While hiking along the trail, *Platinum Weekly’s* journalist was out of breath and taking a rest when an elderly man carrying a large pile of dead wood passed her with a big smile on his face. The Eco Rangers explained that the man is already in his 90s but that he goes up the mountain every other day to collect the wood either to sell or to use himself. “We want to preserve this heritage for our people because we want others to experience the same adventures that we experienced. To do so we need to protect this environment and educate people on sustainable harvesting. Like this old man who has been utilising the mountain’s resources for many years but in a responsible manner,” Rangers in Mission Eco Ranger Butie Mokwena said. The Magaliesberg Biosphere in collaboration with the landowners of Majakaneng and the SOS Eco-Rangers has finally launched the Majakaneng Hiking Trail Project.

- Through this project they will assist the Majakaneng community to develop an interpretive heritage hiking trail and associated trail infrastructure. At the same time, they plan to restore some degraded habitat and highlight the indigenous heritage of Majakeneng.

Every day, 12 community members hike up the mountain. They have started clearing the trail, repairing erosion damage, and adding steps to the steeper hills. Educating youngsters about the importance of protecting their environment and assisting teachers through eco tours is a priority for the rangers. They hope that this will attract more people to their community, develop local businesses and in the long run create employment to better the lives of the people.

COVID-19, ALZHEIMER, AND WILLS

Rustenburg – Section 4 of the Wills Act, 1953 stipulates that “every person of the age of sixteen years or more may make a will unless at the time of making the will he is mentally incapable of appreciating the nature and effect of his act”.

Whether the testator is mentally capable of appreciating the nature and effect of his act is a factual question that needs to be answered for each case. The mere fact that someone suffers from an illness or a disease, such as Covid-19, Alzheimer's disease or cancer, or uses painkillers such as morphine, does not invalidate a will.

In terms of section 4, “the burden of proof that he was mentally incapable at that time shall rest on the person alleging the same”. Therefore, the person attacking the validity of the will has to prove that the illness or disease affected the mental capacity of the testator to such an extent that he did not appreciate the nature and effect of signing the document. The signatory's mental capacity when he signs the document consequently has to be determined. Therefore, a person might be very forgetful, disorganized, physically disabled, and not have a clear grasp of his assets, but still sign a valid will.

In this regard, it should be noted that a person can also ‘sign’ a will with a cross or a fingerprint in front of a commissioner of oaths. Make sure you get expert advice to assist with this.

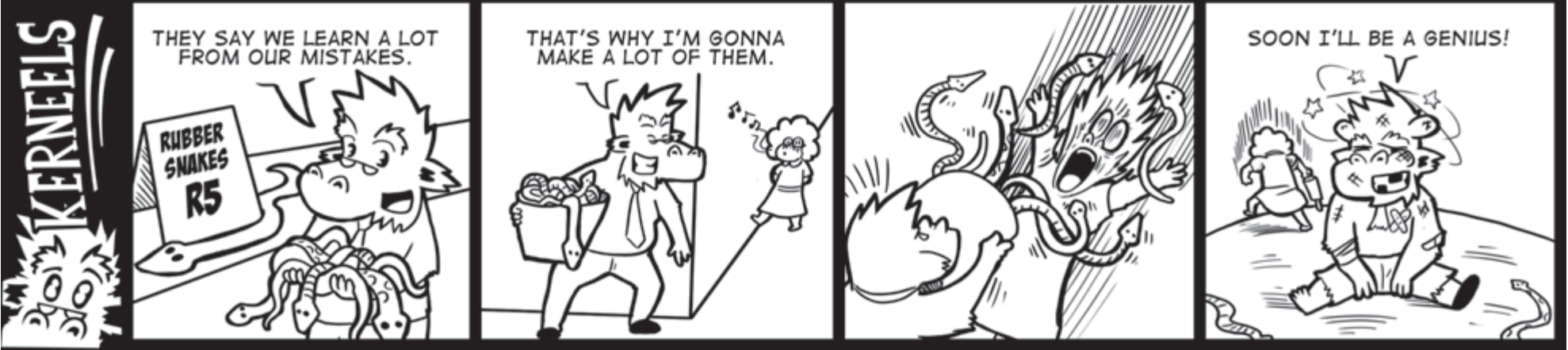
