SA – It is important for all South Africans to be involved in the development of new legislature. The last day for you to make like to hear your any comments on the Prevention and Combating of Hate Crimes and Hate Speech Bill is Friday 1 October.

What is a Bill?

A bill is a draft version of a law. Most bills are drawn up by a government department under the direction of the relevant minister or deputy minister. This kind of bill must be approved by the Cabinet before being submitted to Parliament. A bill becomes an Act of Parliament and Law of the Land when the President signs it, declaring it as law.

Section 4 (2)(d) 'Offence of hate speech' of the bill states:

the bona fide interpretation and proselytising or espousing of any religious tenet, belief, teaching, doctrine or writings, to the extent on Hatecrimes@parliament.gov.za.

that such interpretation and proselytization does not advocate hatred that constitutes incitement to cause harm, based on one or more of the grounds referred to in subsection (1)(a).

It is the interpretation part of this section that concerns several religious leaders, because a clear intention for one person can be interpreted as something totally different for another person.





ROBBERY OF FIREARMS



Ordinary citizens are being harassed, assaulted, and robbed in broad daylight.

WHAT TO DO IF YOUR FIREARM IS STOLEN:

- Report the incident at the local SAPS station immediately.
- A person is guilty of an offence in terms of the Firearms Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000) if he or she fails to report the loss or theft of a firearm within 24 hours.
- Section 120(11) of the act places an obligation on the holder of a licence, permit or authorisation to possess a firearm, and any other person who was in the possession of or who had control of a firearm when it was lost, stolen, or destroyed, must report such loss, theft or destruction within 24

hours after having become aware of the loss, theft or destruction of the firearm – to the nearest police station.

- Failure to comply with section 120(11), could lead to criminal prosecution with the possibility of imprisonment for up to 10 years in terms of schedule 4 of the act.
- After reporting the firearm as having been stolen, the South African Police Service will most probably open a criminal docket against you and will start the process of investigation into the matter.
- You may possibly be charged with a criminal offence in terms of section 120(8) of the act.

VEHICLE PLUNGES INTO HARTBEESPOORT DAM

29-year-old Hartbeespoort woman passed away on Monday night, 27 September, after her vehicle veered off the road and plunged into the Hartbeespoort Dam, between the snake park and the dam wall. Hartbeespoort Dam's National Sea Rescue Institute (NSRI) team were called to the scene shortly before 9pm by the police who responded to reports of a vehicle that plunged into the dam, trapping the occupants. NSRI Hartbeespoort Dam station commander Arthur Crewe said: "The NSRI rescue craft 'Sea Legs' joined the police on the scene of a small passenger vehicle which was submerged in the water. Our NSRI rescue swimmers recovered the body of an adult female from the wreck and immediately started with cardiopulmonary resuscitation. After all efforts to resuscitate the woman were exhausted, she was declared deceased."

It was initially believed that the woman had a baby with her and the NSRI rescue swimmers continued to search for the missing baby. No sign of a baby was found, and police confirmed shortly after that the baby was safe at the home of the deceased's partners' parents.

The vehicle was secured in the dam and the police deployed vehicle recovery services. The NSRI conveyed their sincerest condolences with the loved ones of the young women.

There are instances where women give birth at home and the baby is stillborn. This can cause a woman to start panicking. "If a baby is stillborn, a doctor needs to be contacted who will declare the infant dead. If it is classified as an unnatural death, the police also need to be informed," said Augoustides. If you did nothing wrong, there is nothing to be afraid

Should you ever find a baby that was abandoned by the mother, the first thing you should do is to immediately contact the police. They will obtain the required documents from the Department of Social Development to ensure that the baby can be taken to a place of safety like Môrester Kinderhuis.

Whatever your circumstances are, no matter how afraid you are or whatever your reasons may be for deciding not to keep your baby, please do the right thing and follow the right procedures to ensure the life of the child is protected

This was transactions by a 29-year-old Swartruggens backfired when the bank's investigating team queried the transactions with the account holder. On Tuesday 28 September the Swartruggens Regional Court sentenced Nonhlanhla Matinyane to a five-year jail term for fraud and an additional three years for money laundering. Matinyane, who was found guilty of illegally transferring R536,000 to three different bank accounts in March 2020, will effectively serve five years after three years were suspended.

Police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh said: "The accused illegally transferred the money to two accounts belonging to family members and another to an unsuspecting account holder, from the bank account of R17,500 to the bank.

done without the lottery winner's knowledge. The bank investigating team noticed these huge transfers and contacted the 49-yearold victim. The victim did not receive any notifications as the accused had blocked the victim's phone from receiving bank notifications.

Investigations led by colonel Peter Phale of the SAPS North West commercial crime unit traced all three transactions to Matinyane, leading to her arrest on 10 March 2020.

The bank managed to retrieve R518,500 through a reversal of the fraudulent transactions in March 2020, soon after the illegal transfers were made. The court instructed Matinyane to pay the outstanding







Impala Rugby Club will aim to score many points against Tshwane University of Technology.


