Deon's guardian angels

Rustenburg – While having fun and running through the sprinklers at his grandmother's home on a warm Thursday afternoon, 14 October, three-year-old Deon Coetzee seriously injured his right leg.

His grandparents rushed him to Medi-Care Private Hospital where he was examined, and they found that he broke his right thighbone (femur), and that an operation was required. With the family not having medical aid insurance and the doctor saying that Deon must preferably get the operation between 24 and 48 hours, they had no choice but to take him to a provincial hospital.

With it being an almost impossible task to try and raise the money for a costly operation in such a short period of time. Deon's dad went with him to the hospital where they waited in the casualty ward for hours on end. According to his parents, the little three-year-old's distressed sobs echoed through the hospital for the whole night while he was waiting for a bed, a doctor and pain medication.

The following day little Deon's leg was splinted and bandaged. The hospital informed his parents that they are not allowed to stay with their child and that Deon would have to stay in hospital, in traction, for the next three months.

"Knowing how our boy suffered the past 24 hours, we knew that we could not leave our son at the mercy of the staff of the hospital. They were deaf to his cries," Deon's mother said. More on page 2.





Rustenburg - Steel and Engineering Industries Federation of Southern Africa (SEIFSA) has revealed the nationwide strike for a 6% wage increase by National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (NUMSA) members has cost that sector about R500 million in lost output.

The negative effects of the engineering strike, which is in its third week now, is likely to be felt more in areas such as Rustenburg where the sector is closely linked to the mining industry.

SEIFSA, which represents 18 organisations employing 170,000 workers in the metals and engineering sector, fears that a prolonged strike could result in irreparable damage to a sector that was beginning to recover from the effects of successive Covid-19 induced lockdowns.

However, on Tuesday 19 October NUMSA which announced it would continue pushing for improved working conditions - released a statement justifying their demands.

"The global steel industry has recovered from the impact of lockdowns and the Covid-19 pandemic, and according to news reports, by April of this year, the global price of iron ore had doubled. The engineering industry has benefitted from this performance on the markets," NUMSA said.

"We urge all employer associations to come to the table and settle on 6% on the actual rates of pay, or based on what workers are actually earning, instead of 6% on the minimum rate so that we can put an end to the strike.

In Rustenburg, striking NUMSA members handed a memorandum of demands to SEIFSA and the National Employers Association of South Africa (NEASA) representatives during a protest on 8 October.

Deputy regional secretary for NUMSA in Rustenburg Steven Mini, who took part in the strike, told Platinum Weekly: "We have not received an increase in the engineering industry for the past four years now. We deserve fair wages."

Employment and Labour Minister Thulas Nxesi said while workers have a right to protest, they must refrain from violent conduct. He urged both parties to find an amicable solution

HITMAN ON THE RUN

Wife arrested

Phokeng/ Rustenburg - A 44-year-old woman allegedly hired a hitman to kill her 51-year-old husband. He was killed on Wednesday 20 October in Luka near Phokeng.

Tenants renting a backroom from the victim heard gunshots at about 03:45 and rushed over to investigate. They found the man in a pool of blood and alerted the police, emergency services and the

According to lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani, the man who sustained several gunshots to the chest, was certified dead on scene.

Investigations led the police in Phokeng to believe that the wife hired a hitman to get rid of her husband. Apparently, the couple argued regularly. The wife will appear before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court in Tlhabane on Friday 22 October.

The provincial commissioner of North West, lieutenant general Sello Kwena condemned the incident and congratulated the Phokeng detectives for their swift reaction that resulted in the arrest. The general also thanked members of the community for working with the police in making sure that the

HUSBAND-KILLER TOO **ILL FOR COURT**



One of the sites where some of Chipungare's

42-year-old Nancy Majonhi, who handed herself over to the Sun City police six years ago was postponed at the Mankwe Magistrates' Court in Mogwase on Tuesday 19 October due to her ill-health.

In 2015 she admitted to killing her husband and getting rid of parts of his body in three different pit toilets. She was admitted to hospital under police guard. Apparently, she refused to eat while in police custody. Majonhi stands accused of bludgeoning her husband. Prosper Chipungare (44), with a hammer. She reportedly hacked his body with a spade and disposed of his body. Then she reported her

Phokeng/ Rustenburg – The murder case against husband as missing at the Sun City police station. According to brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, the incident took place in a rented room in Ledig on 28 July 2015, after the couple had a fight. After the incident. Majonhi went home to Zimbabwe, where she confessed to her family and in-laws that she had killed her husband. The families arranged to come to South Africa, and Majonhi handed herself over to the Sun City police. She then showed the police where she buried the remains of her husband's body. A skull and bones were retrieved; DNA tests are underway. The case was postponed to 9 November 2021.

Pillay handed himself over to the police

Brits - On Monday 11 October, Kishan Kistaven Laskad Pillay (38) handed himself over to the Brits Police. He appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court the same day and was remanded in custody. The police were looking for him in connection with kidnapping and murder cases reported on 22 and 23 April 2021 in Sandfontein, Brits. Two women and a man were kidnapped on 22 April in Elandspoort, Pretoria. The following day, they were shot, killed and buried in a shallow grave in Sandfontein, Brits. According to colonel Adéle Myburgh, their bodies were discovered on Friday 30 April.

Can I consent to my own injuries?

It is not often that we come across such a fascinating case dealing with the ancient principle of volenti non

The volenti principle was formulated by Domitius Ulpian, a Roman Jurist serving as a Praetorian Prefect from 222 until 228 AD. Astonishingly, this principle is still applicable in our law. Back in ancient Rome, it was known as nullainiuriaest, quæ in volentem fia, which essentially means that a wrongdoer is not liable where an injured person. has consented to the injury or the risk thereof. What do we mean by 'consented to injury', and is it even possible for me to consent to my own injuries?

Before we can shed light on whether you can consent to your own injuries, we must first ensure a proper understanding of consent as a ground of justification. Grounds of justification are special circumstances in which conduct that appear to be wrongful is rendered lawful because the violation of the interest is not unreasonable or contra boni mores.

The following are the requirements for valid consent:

- The consent is given freely and voluntarily.
- The person giving the consent must be capable of giving the consent (intellectually mature).
- The consenting person must fully know the possible prejudice and must fully appreciate the nature and extent of the harm.
- The consent must not be contra boni mores (against good morals).

There are two forms of consent:

Consent to injury, where the injured party

consent to a doctor removing your appendix. Consent to the risk of injury. For example, rugby players accepting the risks of injuries during a tackle.

Now that we have dealt with the history of the principle and the requirements thereof, let us discuss the recent case that again gave rise to the volenti principle, namely, the case of Jackson vs RAF.

The case concerned Ms Jackson, a stuntwoman, who, while filming 'Resident Evil 6', was required to drive a motorbike, without a helmet, at an oncoming vehicle which was transporting a boom operator and a boom arm with a camera attached to it. On 5 September 2016, the day of the accident, the boom was lifted too late, and the camera struck Jackson. severely injuring her. A total of three runs were conducted in preparation for the stunt, the first and second runs were successful, but on the third run, the accident occurred hereinafter referred to as the incident run.

She instituted legal action against the South African film company, the stunt coordinator, her employer, the driver of the boom vehicle (the driver), and the camera boom operator. She also instituted a separate action against the Road Accident Fund (RAF). The actions were later consolidated, but when the matter was heard before the Pretoria High Court, the RAF denied that the driver was negligent and that even if he was, Ms Jackson, as a stunt driver, had consented to

the risk of damage - thus raising the defence of volenti non fit injuria.

Experts for Plaintiff and Defendant agreed in a joint consents to specific harm. For example, if you minute that the 'boom up' call during the incident run Rustenburg

occurred at least three seconds past the location where the boom was lifted in the first and second successful run

The question begging an answer is why did the driver deviate from the two successful test runs? Apparently, the director instructed that 'boom up' call had to come one second later than during the rehearsal run to get a more exciting shot, and the driver miscalculated the margin of error on the command. Coincidently, during cross-examination, the driver and the boom operator contradicted each other to the point that the RAF conceded that no reliance can be placed on their evidence.

Ms Jacson's evidence was that she did not consent to any other risk and that she was unaware that the director had given the driver instructions to decrease the safety margins from the rehearsal run

The Judge found that there was no evidence to substantiate that Ms Jackson had consented to a specific risk. She accepted the misadventures that might happen in the normal course of the stunt but not to the deviation from the previous successful runs. Even if she had voluntarily assumed the risk of harm of riding a motorcycle as a stunt rider, she did not assume the risk of diminishing the safety margin without her knowledge because she assumed that the incident run would be a repeat of the rehearsal

The RAF, therefore, failed to prove the facts for the volenti defence because they could not prove valid
