Rustenburg – "Rustenburg as a community rotten apples to infiltrate our beautiful city," The Square Centre's press release reads. This is after a 37-year-old man is currently in a serious condition after he was shot by armed robbers in Tuesday 9 November.

After withdrawing money at the Waterfall Mall, the victim and a passenger noticed that they were being tailed. They drove around for a while until they thought they lost them. They stopped in the Rustenburg Square parking area to go and have breakfast at Milaneza.

spokesperson captain Elsabé Augoustides said: "Before they could even exit to them, one at each side pointing their guns and demanding cash. The passenger reacted and got out of the vehicle whereafter a struggle ensued. When the driver got out of the vehicle, he was shot in his left thigh."

The suspects fled the scene with an undisclosed needs to stand together and not allow these amount of cash in a white Kia Rio with fake number plates.

Security at the Rustenburg Square centre immediately raised the alarm. The police and ER24 were summoned who arrived shortly after. the busy parking lot of Rustenburg Square on ER24 found the man laying on his stomach on the walkway in front of Milaneza where bystanders were attending to him.

SAPS' forensic team collected evidence on site. The man, said to be a Hungarian national who own several internet cafes and gambling parlours in town, was taken to hospital after by ER24.

"The Square Centre management and security want to thank all of the bystanders who assisted their vehicle, the robbers were standing next the victim, as well as SAPS and ER24 who responded swiftly. We would like to reassure our clients that The Square together with our security team will strive to keep The Square Centre safe to the best of our abilities," the Rustenburg Square centre's statement concluded

Stick-up at Marikana filling station - followed by shootout

Rustenburg - Kabelo Mkhakha (21) and Lekoa Mopata (25) were arrested on Saturday 6 November for armed robbery, attempted murder and for the possession of an unlicensed firearm. Police are also looking for a third suspect in the case.

The duo made their initial court appearance on Monday 8 November and were charged with the possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition. Additional charges of armed robbery were added during their second appearance on 11 November.

Mkhakha was granted R1,000 bail and is expected back in court on 27 January 2022 for trial. Mopata, who is still in police custody, will be back in the dock on Thursday 18 November for a formal bail application.

Police spokesperson captain Aafje Botma said the armed robbery took place at around 04:00 on Saturday 6 November.

"The suspects fled on foot and a shoot-out between them and security members of the filling station who followed them ensued at the Big House section in Marikana. Meanwhile, police were informed about the incident and the suspects were arrested," Botma said.

During the arrest, the suspects were found in possession of firearms and ammunition.

"Investigations into the matter, including the tracing of the third suspect, are underway,"

Police spokesperson in Rustenburg sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said a petrol attendant sustained minor injuries during the robbery. "No items from the robbery were recovered," Mokgadi added

Herdsman shot and killed during cattle robbery

Lefaragatlhe/ Rustenburg - A herdsman was shot and killed in Serutube village near Rustenburg on Thursday 4 November during a cattle robbery incident.

A manhunt launched by Phokeng Detectives and Stock Theft Unit immediately after the incident, led to the recovery of 21 cattle in the Lefaragatlhe village. Eleven of these cattle were positively identified and linked with the incident. At the site police also discovered two cows and calves that had been stolen a week ago in Serutube.

Refilwe Tau (45) and her son Kgalalelo Tau (18) were arrested and charged for the possession of stolen livestock.

At their first court appearance before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court, they were each granted R2,000 bail and are expected back in the court on Monday 20 December.

It is alleged that on 4 November at around 17:00 three men were herding cattle in Serutube village when the three men emerged from the bushes.

"The trio caught one of the herdsmen and tied his hands with a rope. They robbed him of his money and a cell phone. The suspects went to another herdsman (25) and tied his hands and robbed him of his cell phone and cash," police spokesperson captain Aafje Botma said.

"The suspects then demanded the cattle and shot and killed the 25-year-old. They also assaulted his colleagues with the butt of a firearm. The suspects then drove out a herd of cattle from the cattle post," Botma explained.

and are a homeowner's worst nightmare. Imagine moving into your brand-new house just to find out these little pests have been chomping away at the structure of your dream home and the previous owner failed to disclose it...

In one case where a seller failed to disclose that they had a termite infestation, the buyer turned to the courts for help. The plaintiff sued for compensation for expenses incurred in repairing the house and ensuring its structural integrity. The services of an expert witness had to be called in and Vivienne Uys, the termite taxonomist at the National Collection of Insects was subpoenaed by the Magistrates' Court in the District of Rustenburg to testify. The Court ruled in favour of the plaintiff following expert testimony provided by the ARC entomologist.

Termites can enter buildings from under concrete slabs, brick walls and pavers. Conditions that put properties at risk of termites often involve moisture and warmth and the areas that are usually attacked include:

- · decking timbers/ bearers, joists, and decking boards
- timber cladding
- fences and garden edges
- · stored timber items (stored firewood, building timbers, play equipment etc.)
- structural framing timbers (roof voids)
- electrical wiring and built-in units
- carpets and furniture
- books and wall hangings
- clothing

Platinum Weekly spoke to Mostert Pest Control Rustenburg to find out what steps you can take to prevent termites from moving in and what to do when you suspect you have termites.

Rustenburg - Termites are known as the silent destroyers "It is important to treat your foundation beneath your building structure for subterranean termites before construction. It is always better to take preventative measures to avoid termites from infesting your home," Mostert Pest Control branch manager Lindiwe Dichabe said.

> Soil poisoning can be conducted in two ways: Pre and Post construction with a five-year guaranteed certificate. Subterranean termites are controlled in pre-construction foundation trenches and under solid floor areas. In post construction, they can be treated by drilling the entire outside building wall one metre apart and the solution of termicides injected according to label direction. The control of harvester termites is normally accomplished by establishing where their shallow nest is, and then solution of termicides is injected into numerous nests.

Signs that you might have termites:

- Hollowed out skirtings and door frames Damage underneath wooden furniture
- Cracking walls this is a sign of a huge infestation
- Heaps of hard soil attached to the walls, and it contains small pieces of glass if you break them
- Small holes appearing in the carpet

Lindiwe added: "Termites can easily spread through neighbourhoods so if you suspect that you have termites, call in an expert. I also recommend that you get your house inspected before selling or buying so that you are not stuck with these critters feasting on your home."

Rustenbura/ Shvlock - A fire that broke out on a farm located in the Shylock area on the N4/ Swartruggens Road, and which burned a massive store and its contents to the ground, continued to burn until the following day.

The fire started at around 11:00 after an Eskom overhead electric cable broke loose and came into contact with the store. The fire raged on for the next 36 hours. Neighbours reported that explosions of gas cylinders could be heard from kilometres away and that the dark cloud of smoke could be seen from afar for hours. One of the gas cylinders which exploded flew into the air and landed on a nearby thatch roof. Luckily it could be extinguished in time.

Even though a few nearby buildings could be saved, the initial estimated damage is about R5.7 million. Luckily no one was injured during the incident.

The owner of the farm, Manny Fernandes extended his gratitude to the Rustenburg Fire Department and the community members who rushed to his aid.
