

The spirit in which members from the Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), SAPS and the community came together to aid and rescue a calf in distress, is inspiring.

Armed with straps, Labuschagne and Kruger braved the mud and were also sucked in knee deep as they struggled to secure the straps around the calf's body. After partially digging the calf out of the mud and pulling at its legs to free it from the mud, they started pulling the calf out with the straps. The poor thing was eventually freed, exhausted and thirsty, but alive!

These heroes proved their mettle. They dedicate their lives to protect the most vulnerable in our society - our animals.

"We would like to thank the true hero of the day, the person who didn't turn a blind eye and called the SPCA to assist. It's because of you that this episode turned out to be a success story. This is apparently the fourth cow that got stuck in the mud at this watering hole, and the only one that was saved,"

She added: "This is a concern. The owners of the farm animals will have to come up with an idea on how to protect their animals from getting stuck in the mud at this spot. We would like to urge anyone who might have an idea or good advice as to resolve this situation, to come forward and share it with us."

Third attack on Eskom sub-station

Rustenburg - The Eskom sub-station on the N4 just outside Rustenburg is being targeted by criminals. On more than one occasion it has been vandalised leaving residents in the area without electricity. The latest incident took place on Thursday 11 November. Security was hesitant to respond.

During two previous incidents in October, heavily armed intruders attempted to ransack the station. The first attempt claimed the life of a security guard and the corpse of what is believed to be one of the attackers was discovered later close to Eskom's gate.

"The fact that these people do not immediately electrocute themselves when tampering with such a high voltage is cause for concern. This can only mean that they have gained the necessary experience while on the job " a community member commented. The question now is why Eskom is not ensuring that there is enough security at such a crucial point of infrastructure that supplies electricity to a widespread area?

Eskom provincial spokesperson Sebata Zondo said: "Eskom is working with the police and also encourages the community to report the perpetrators to the police. We are working on installing security technology at the identified high-risk subs."

WOMAN JAILED FOR STEALING

Rustenburg - A woman has been jailed after she was convicted of stealing a newborn baby from a hospital and pretending the infant was her own.

Details of the date the baby was stolen and how the woman went about committing the crime were not yet available at the time of going to print.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said overwhelming evidence presented by the state before the Marikana Magistrates' Court was key in securing the conviction. Mokgadi said the evidence proved how the woman, who had just given birth at a hospital in Marikana, proceeded to steal another infant.

"People at the hospital actually thought the woman had twins, only to discover that the other baby was not hers," Mokgadi said.



Successful operation to eradicate second-hand goods crimes

Rustenburg - The Police launched a successful crime prevention operation on Wednesday 10 November to address crimes involving second-hand goods.

Various multi-disciplinary agencies were involved such as SAPS' Provincial Second-Hand Goods, Rapid Rail, K9, Crime Intelligence, Mounted Unit, Vehicle Crime Investigation Unit, District Designated Police Officials, Employee Health and Wellness, Detectives and Communication personnel and representatives from Transnet, Home Affairs, Telkom CPI, and the Motor Industry Ombudsman.

Four undocumented citizens were arrested during the operation. Compliance inspections were conducted and fines of R22,000 were issued. Various second-hand dealerships, as well as scrap metal dealers and recyclers were visited.

Bojanala acting district commissioner, brigadier Reginah Ntoagae expressed her gratitude to members of all of the sectors and the police officers involved.

More of these compliance inspections are on the cards. Second-hand dealerships are warned to refrain from buying second-hand

Disturbing the dead?

is investigating the conduct of workers who were allegedly spotted cutting down trees inside the cemetery adjacent to the Rustenburg Crematorium.

Motorists travelling along Watsonia Road on 11 November raised the alarm after they allegedly saw workers from the RLM's Parks and Cemeteries Unit chopping down the trees inside the cemetery. Chopping down, not pruning... During a visit by Platinum Weekly to the cemetery, one of the employees said: "We are cutting the branches of the trees because they must be pruned. The owners of the graves often come to us and express their unhappiness at how some of the tree branches hang over the graves. If we leave them, the tree branches can fall on the tombstones and cause damage."

However, completely chopping down a tree versus pruning and maintaining the area, are two separate issues.

The wood is also being used for cooking purposes. "When we cut the branches, we take the dry wood and use it to cook our food," the worker added.

The municipality, however, expressed its concern at what it fears could be uncontrolled cutting down of trees.

Said RLM spokesperson Thapelo Matebesi: "According to the Unit Manager for Parks and Cemeteries, Linda Jele, the municipality has not commissioned any work to cut trees at the cemetery adjacent to the crematorium. The municipality is therefore investigating the activity to establish who commissioned it so that we can apply appropriate municipal bylaws."



Her powerfully delivered speech, which advised educators and learners about how to confront bullying, resulted in her appointment to the position of Junior Deputy Provincial Commissioner: Support Services.

In an interview with *Platinum Weekly*, the bright and brave Ntsie said: "I am the head of house for the junior boarding house, and I have learned that leading is about serving. A good leader must always listen to people and help them to overcome the challenges they are facing."

Lebone II College of the Royal Bafokeng deputy principal Dave Ryan described Masego as a multi-talented learner. "She was very enthusiastic right from the start of the project and proved outstanding during the district and regional stages of the competition. We are elated that she made such an impression at the provincial competition because this is a shining example for other learners," Ryan said. "Masego is also part of the school athletics team and competes in the 100m and 200m events.







At the beginning of August 2021, Glencore Ferroalloys sought out to empower and uplift young girls in their communities by rolling out sanitary pad donations and saying no to girl children missing school due to a lack of sanitary pads. The initiative which began with a partnership between Glencore and the Imbumba foundation was aimed at providing over 6 700 sanitary pads to girls around Glencore operations.

"Imbumba is a non-profit organisation that was established to bring about social change and economic upliftment within rural and economically marginalised communities. We found great synergy between Glencore and ourselves because they too have shown that they are committed to making a difference in the communities where they operate. Cooking?

Ingrid Gloy perfected the art of macaron making. Macarons are a delicious French dessert.

French Macarons

Rustenburg - Anyone who has ever tried to make macarons will tell you... it's no easy task! But Ingrid Gloy from Rustenburg was determined to learn how to make this delicious French dessert "After a lot of research on Google and YouTube and many flops after... I eventually managed to get it right. You must have patience to make macaroons and every step must be followed to the letter T, or else you will have to start over again. But once you get it right, you won't be able to stop!

Ingredients:

- 200g confectioners' sugar
- 100g finely ground almond flour
- 120g egg whites (at room temperature)
- 1/8 teaspoon salt
- 40g granulated sugar (sifted) 1/2 teaspoon flavouring
- 1 to 3 drops liquid or gel food colouring (optional)

- 1/4 cup unsalted butter (softened)
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 tablespoon milk/almond milk
- 1 and 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar
 1 small pinch salt (optional)

Instructions:

- Sift the confectioners' sugar and almond flour together, and set aside.
- 2. Beat the egg whites and salt together on medium speed for 1 minute. Switch to high speed and beat until stiff peaks form (check every 30 seconds so you don't overbeat the egg whites - it takes about 1 minute).
- Gently fold in your sifted granulated sugar 1 tablespoon at a time.
- On low speed, beat in any flavouring or colouring of your choice - only mix until it is combined so you do not overmix.
- Using a rubber spatula, gently fold in the confectioners' sugar/almond flour mixture until combined. Be very gentle as you fold in the dry ingredients. Once combined your mixture will be smooth, sticky and glossy. Do not use a hand mixer or stand mixer for this step!
- Let batter sit uncovered at room temperature for 10-30 minutes
- As the batter sits out, prep your piping bag using
- a 1.3cm circle tip for piping. Fill the piping bag with batter and pipe even round circles onto the baking sheets. Traditionally, silicone baking sheets are preferred but parchment paper parchment covered baking sheets can also work. Keep a piping bag close to the baking sheet, holding it upright to get an even circle as you pipe. Make each circle about 5cm. The batter will slightly spread as you pipe. Gently tap the bottom of baking sheets after your finished the piping to remove any large air bubbles.
- Let your piped macaroon shells sit out to form a dry shell for 45 minutes to 1 hour. This step is super important so don't skip it!
- 10. Preheat oven to 160°C (do not preheat until macaroons have finished sitting out so you do not create a lot of humidity in your kitchen).
- 11. Bake macaroons for 9-10 minutes, one baking sheet at a time. If you have a convection oven do not use the fan. Just stick to it as a
- 12. Allow macaroons to cool completely on the baking sheet before removing and filling.

WHAT'S THE CHEAPEST **CIGARETTE OUT THERE?**

SA - In a national study commissioned by the British American Tabaco South Africa (BATSA) published on 5 November, research was carried out into the cheapest purchase prices in the tobacco cigarette market. The study took place from 8 October to 3 November.

Researchers were briefed to ask the following question: "I want to by the cheapest 20 pack available", and/or "I want to buy the cheapest carton available". No price negotiations were allowed.

- · The cheapest pack purchased was R8.00 and was purchased in Gauteng Wholesale. The R10.00 price point was prevalent in Western Cape, Free State, and Gauteng Provinces, with the Wholesale, Spaza, Tabletop/ Hawker channels where it was most prevalent.
- The foreign brand, Remington Gold (owned by or licensed to GLTC Zimbabwe) is the most widely accessible

brand at the cheapest price point, at 59% selling below R21.60 and a purchase universe of 441 stores out of 748 stores.

- Pine (owned by or licensed to KTNG), had a higher incidence of R21.60 and below, although off a lower base, when in comparison to Remington Gold.
- Pall Mall (owned by or licensed to BAT) has a high prevalence in sample stores, however the brand is not sold at the cheapest price points.
- New brands, not purchased in the previous studies in 2021 and new to the cheapest prices purchase list, include Liberty (R18.00), Roxbury (R10.00 and R15.00), Chief (R10.00 to R18.00), Ecco Nano (R18.000), and GMB (R10.00).

The cheapest carton purchased was R70.00 in Gauteng, within a wholesale trader. Isn't that interesting...
