Stolen car used in CIT heist

Benz was used in a cash-in-transit (CIT) heist by a group of heavily armed robbers who blew up a G4S van near the Rustenburg Civic Centre on Sunday 21 November.

Police are looking for the suspects who rammed the vehicle (registration number JZG 985 NW) into the van and forced it to stop. Security guards were forced out of the van at gunpoint. The gang blew up the van and escaped with an undisclosed amount of money.

"Shots were fired between the suspects and the escort vehicle, but nobody sustained injuries. The suspects are believed to have fled the scene in various vehicles including a white Q7," said Hawks national spokesperson colonel Athelda Mathe

Video footage showing people picking up cash at the crime scene were widely circulated on social media. Mathe warned community members about the dangers of approaching a crime scene that may contain explosives. "It is possible that not all of the explosives detonate at the time a robbery is committed".



Eskom Pylons meet their match

Rustenburg/ Zinniaville/ Shylock/ Moedwil - Two pylons near Moedwil were struck by lightning on Saturday 20 November, causing power outages in the area. Due to the geographical area, the pylons were rather inaccessible.

Repairing the poles and pylons were no easy task. At one of the sites, a Babcock crane could not access the pylon. Another vehicle had to be hired to dismantle and plant the pole. Working around the clock, the power to that area was finally restored at around 23:00 on 23 November. Meanwhile, another team was attending to a vandalised pylon in Zinniaville. According to Democratic Alliance ward 43 councillor, the steel at the bottom of the pylon was forcefully removed and when the wind picked up during the afternoon of 20 November, it tipped over leaving residents without power for more than 24 hours. Platinum Weekly reached out to Eskom, but at time of going to print, no response was received.





Conveyer belt fire causes major pollution

Rustenburg - The dark smoke billowing from a pile of conveyor belts took days to finally subdue. The fire broke out on a property on the Koster road (R52), turning off from the N4, near Mogro Lodge on Tuesday 23 November. According to the owners of the property, the conveyor belting caught fire after someone set the veld alight. They apparently try to limit the damage caused if a fire like this should break out on their property by stacking the conveyor belting into blocks (sections with open space in between).

The cloud of smoke could be seen from afar. Neighbours pitched up to ensure that the fire is contained, but they could not extinguish the fire as water is of no use if you have rubber burning.

The fire brigade could also not do much as they only had water and no foam, which is needed to fight these types of fires. Apparently, their budget does not allow for foam. Long after the heap of conveyor belting burned out, it was still smouldering. The smoke from conveyor belts burning is highly toxic.

Baby kidnapper pleads guilty

Rustenburg/ Marikana - A 32-year-old woman which was contrary to her claims after she from Marikana pleaded guilty to kidnapping charges after the state proved before the Brits Regional Court how she took the baby of another woman and pretended it was her own.

Investigations by warrant officer Obed Ramahoyo from the Rustenburg Family Violence Child Protection and Sexual Offences Unit (FCS) established that Dibuseng Rapitsi kidnapped the infant in 2018 and pretended it was the twin of her own child.

Rapitsi was sentenced to eight years behind bars on Wednesday 17 November 2021 thanks to Ramahoyo's airtight evidence. His investigations took him to Kwa-Zulu Natal where the two children were found living with Rapitsi's boyfriend. Both children have since been taken to a place of safety.

"When the mother of the kidnapped baby died mysteriously, her baby was kidnapped. Rapitsi then took off with both kids to the coast," police spokesperson Ofentse Mokgadi said. The grandmother of the kidnapped infant opened a case of kidnapping.

"Rapitsi was arrested in December 2019. DNA evidence in court proved she did not have twins,

was questioned during police investigations. Her bail application was successfully opposed," Mokgadi said.

It was during her trial that Rapitsi pleaded guilty to kidnapping the child



Jailed again for contravening presidential . pardon

Rustenburg - A man was sentenced to 10 years' imprisonment by the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Thursday 18 November after he was found guilty of contravening his presidential pardon conditions by committing a business robbery.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said Tshegofatso Maruma was convicted of stealing seven laptops worth R90,000. In court, the state proved how Maruma was caught red handed with the seven laptops he had stolen from offices located in Landros Street.

His attempt to outrun a security guard proved futile after a community member also joined the chase and together apprehended him. "During his arrest, one of his previous victims residing around the vicinity managed to identify him and immediately contacted detective constable Morongwa Makhoye, who handled his housebreaking case in 2019," Mokgadi said. Mokgadi said Maruma was granted a presidential pardon after being sentenced to five years imprisonment for housebreaking.





SA - Children love water and don't always realise the dangers associated with it. Anyone can have a water-related accident — even children who know how to swim. Bathtubs, drains, buckets and even fishponds can be just as dangerous as a swimming pool.

An accident can happen very quickly and that is why you have to take all the necessary precautions you possibly can to keep your child safe from drowning.

- · Any open water containers should always be emptied.
- · If you have a swimming pool, make sure it has a fence around it. The fence shouldn't block the view of the pool from outside the fenced area and ensure that the lock cannot be opened by a young child.
- Never leave a child alone in the bathtub or in the care of another child.
- During gatherings, adults who know how to swim can take turns being the 'designated watcher,' who isn't distracted.
- Don't leave toys in the pool. Children might innocently try to get them and fall in.
- Teach children how to swim once they are ready
- Learn Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation
- Save emergency numbers on your phone and keep it in a spot where you can easily

find it. Every second counts and you don't want to waste time to search for a number.

If you have any open water bodies near your home, teach children to never go near water without adult supervision. Even if they are in a group and can swim.

What to do in a drowning situation?

The child should be removed from the water and placed on a flat surface. When you find yourself in a situation where you have to apply CPR start with the basics of HHH.

Hazard - Make sure that the environment around the child or person is safe and there are no obstacles.

Hello - See if the child or person is responding to your voice.

Help - Make sure emergency services are contacted for help.

CPR should be started immediately and should be continued until emergency services arrive.



Report all crime!

SA – All crime must be reported! If a crime was committed on your property, YOU MUST open a case.

When crimes are not reported, the fight against crime is already lost – regardless of whether the cops follow up. It is your responsibility and as a citizen, your moral duty.

You cannot blame the police for their service, or lack thereof, if you're not going to report cases. Also, you can't follow up on anything if a case has not been opened. This information is used to compile the crime statistics and if you don't report cases, the statistics won't reflect the correct information.

Reported cases are the crux of fighting crime in an area. The more cases that are reported in a particular area, the more police members are deployed in that area. In other words, if there is too little manpower in a particular area, it is because people do not report or open cases.

There have been reported instances where police have refused to assist complainants to op criminal dockets. If this happens to you, you can report it at the South African Police Services National Complaint Centre.

National Crime Assist (NCA) would like to reiterate the importance of opening a case. The case needs to be opened by the owner of the property so that there is a record of the person that has been apprehended.

Even if there is nothing that you can charge the perp with, in the case if he has not been found with stolen property... his details will still be on file – helping the next case should his name appear. This gives authorities legal backing if the person is caught again. This is being proactive regarding the fight against crime. It also makes the hard work and effort from crimefighters worth the while.

 NCA response members work probono assisting in case of emergencies, and often crime related instances.
 Can you imagine the disappointment when a suspect was caught, only to be released because the prosecutor decided not to open a case? They do their duty, please do yours.

Why are statistics or record keeping of crime important?

When looking at *modus operandi*, cases could possibly be linked. When a specific crime is intensified in a particular area, residents can be warned, and vigilance will increase. Patterns can be picked up, problem areas can be identified – promoting pro-active crime combatting.

Dog poisoning

If suspects who poisons dogs are identified, a case should be opened at the police against the suspects. If there are no suspects to be linked to the poisoning, insist that the police write the poisoning incident in the incidents book. You can also ask that they give you a reference number. The police occurrence book (OB) or the incidents book is read through and signed off by the station commissioner every day.

Don't waste the system's time and money

It is a serious matter if you are going to lay a complaint against someone and open a case. It's not something you can use as extortion against someone. I

t sometimes happens that people open cases and then retract the case after a week or two. You are wasting the system's time and money. It's a huge amount of administrative work and in the meantime, there are important matters that could have been addressed.


