

My name is Killer, and this is how I died

[Letter to the editor]

Brits – This is the story of my short life and how it ended far too soon at the hands of a short-tempered animal abuser. My story will make you very sad, but it must be told. It started when I went to live with a kind old lady called Tannie Rina and her son at their plot in Brits. There were three houses on the plot but not everyone was as kind as Tannie Rina. An elderly couple lived in one of the houses. I endured many threats from the man and his workers, who clearly hated me. They chased me, tried to kick me and threw things at me. The old man even attempted to run over me while driving in his bakkie. On Saturday 23 January 2021, I was lying in the sun outside my house when the mean old man's wife came past with a glass in her hand. Unsure and threatened by her presence, I barked at her. She refused to go away – even after I had made it clear she was in my territory. After being tormented for months and my warnings being ignored, I bit her on her leg. Nothing serious, but enough to let her know I was scared. She hurled her glass at me and immediately reported me to her husband. Although Tannie Rina apologised to the wife and later took me inside her house, that was not the end of my troubles. When I heard the husband coming, shouting all the way, I tried to hide myself in

the TV room. The old man barged into the house with something long and hard in his hands. Looking at Tannie Rina, he bellowed: "Today I will beat this ***** dog to death!" Tannie Rina tried to chase him out of her house, but he refused to go. I yelped, screamed and screamed and cried but could not get away. Tannie Rina also tried to save me, but the mean man would not allow her to do so. Tannie Rina was crying hysterically and begged him to stop... But to no avail. I was trying so hard to get away and managed to drag my broken body just a few meters outside my front door. Relentless in his effort, the man followed me. He continued to hit me wherever he could, the blows fell all over my body. I breathed my last and lay motionless in a pool of blood. My death was, apparently, not enough for this mean man. He continued to take out his rage on me, even after I was gone. Afterwards, he instructed one of his workers to bring a bag and although Tannie Rina – who was now emotionally stressed by the ordeal – begged him to let her bury me, these pleas fell on deaf ears. I was thrown into the bag and left on a rubbish dump like a piece of garbage. **Killer**

The post-mortem revealed that Killer was struck repeatedly on the cranium, leading to acute haemorrhage, swelling of tissue (brain and left eye) and multiple fractures. In November 2021, *Platinum Weekly* established that a case of animal cruelty as well as other charges is being investigated by the Brits South African Police Services (SAPS). Due to Covid-19 and the accused being hospitalised, a new trial date is yet to be set.

Hijacked truck intercepted

Rustenburg – A collective effort by police and BCI Security led to the arrest of the driver of a hijacked truck after it was intercepted at Olifantsnek on the R24 outside Rustenburg. The police highway patrol was alerted after the truck was hijacked on 7 December along the N14 in Johannesburg. The arrest was made a few hours later. Police in Johannesburg are investigating a case of hijacking.

ATM BOMBERS, GUNSHOTS IN MARIKANA

Marikana – Two suspected automated teller machines (ATM) bombers were arrested in Marikana on Tuesday 14 December after police discovered explosives in the bags they were carrying. When they spotted the cops patrolling the area near the ATMs, they fled – and the cops gave chase. The two were due to appear before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Wednesday 15 December for attempted ATM bombing and the possession of explosives. • More explosives materials were discovered by the police upon their return to the same area where the suspects were initially spotted and arrested. The arrest of the duo came just

seven days after reports of an ATM bombing in Marikana on 7 December. In this case, suspects shot at a security guard and blew up a Capitec ATM before they fled the scene in a white VW polo with no number plates. While spent rifle cartridges were found at the scene of the bombing, it is not yet clear if the suspects fled with any money. Fortunately, the security officials did not sustain any injuries. Police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone said further investigations are underway. He added that at this stage, the suspects who were arrested on 14 December cannot be linked to the first ATM bombing on 7 December. "But it has not been ruled out either," Mokgwabone said.

LOVE TRIANGLE LEADS TO MURDER?

Mogwase – Police are investigating the possibility that the kidnapping and murder of a 40-year-old man from Rustenburg, Koketso Ntsimane, was orchestrated by the lover of the victim’s fiancé. Ntsimane was reported missing at the Rustenburg police station on Wednesday 27 October 2021. Solomon Lambane, Kagiso Kube, Ali Banda, Thabang Mashiane and Thabang Mokoka (5 suspects) made their second appearance before the Mogwase Magistrates’ Court on Tuesday 14 December on kidnapping and murder charges.

National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson for North West, Henry Mamathame said the five will be back in the dock on 21 December for bail application. The suspects were arrested in Witrandjie Village near Sun City on 8 December after investigations by the police linked them to Ntsimane’s disappearance and subsequent killing. Said police spokesperson captain Aafjie Botma: “The vehicle belonging to Ntsimane was found abandoned in Mabieskraal in November.”

ARMED ROBBERY AT SQUARE SPAR

Rustenburg – Three armed men got away with an undisclosed amount of money and cellphones after entering Rustenburg Square Spar on Wednesday 8 December. The trio went inside the supermarket at around 19:20 and ordered everyone to lie down, threatening them with guns. They pointed a firearm at the



manager of the supermarket. They demanded cash and cellphones before they fled the scene. No one sustained injuries during the incident. Said Rustenburg police spokesperson captain Elsabe Augoustides: “Police are investigating a case of armed robbery. No arrests have been made as yet.”

Good morning Mxxxxx,

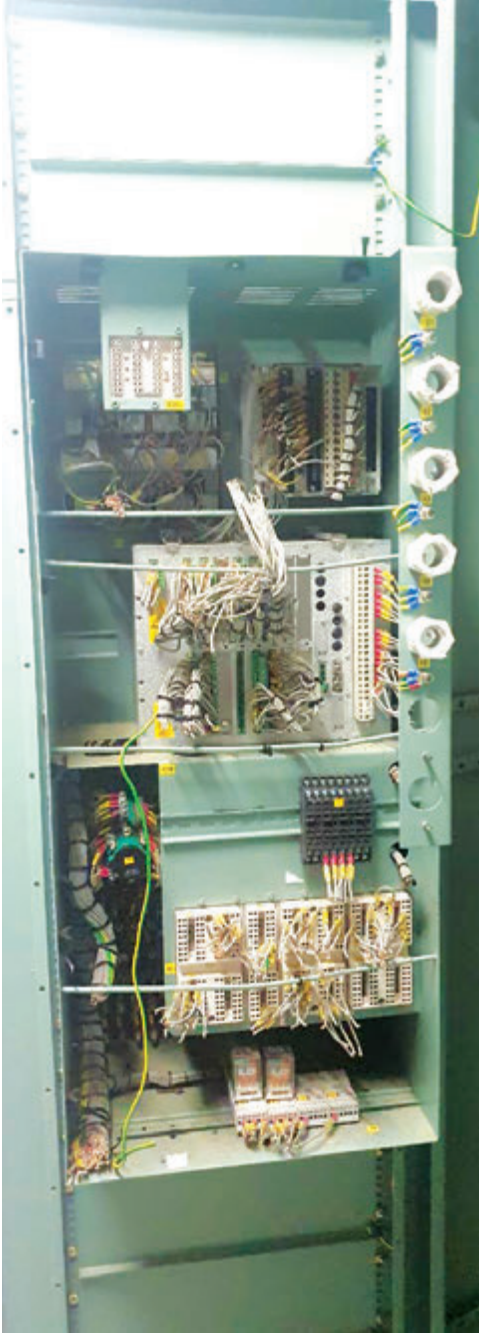
Referring to our telephone conversation earlier this morning. We as a community in the area of the Shylock and Moedwil substations feel that something needs to be done urgently to stop the ongoing vandalism and destruction of vital Eskom property. I have been the head of the Buffelshoek Farmwatch for the last twelve years (callsign L9WG) and the problem has never been at such a critical stage as right now. We as a community want to work with Eskom to stop this.

The area around the Shylock substation has partially been cleared of trees and bushes and if we want to clean it up properly, we need written permission from Eskom. The community will provide labour to do that. Mr. Jxxxxx Sxxxxx has spoken to the management of the silica mine close by and they have agreed to send a front-end loader and a grader the first week in January to clear a proper wide border around the substation in order to increase visibility for the security guards to minimise the chances of them being caught off guard.

We really think that it is time for the SANDF to be deployed at these substations to try and curb this problem. The criminals have been destroying this property for months and they keep coming back because there is no resistance.

They come in large numbers and heavily armed, and the security guards don’t stand a chance because they are outnumbered and outgunned. As a community we cannot guard the substation because we don’t have the necessary resources and equipment and we also don’t have the legal right to respond. As you know this is costing Eskom millions of rands in repairs and it has now reached a stage where the teams doing the repairs can’t stay ahead of the criminals responsible for all the sabotaging because that is clearly what it is: SABOTAGE.

The SANDF has 66,500 active troops and 15,000 reserve troops at their disposal and we cannot see why they cannot be deployed to defend these key points.

This is not only affecting Eskom but thousands of citizens (farmers, farm workers, businesses etc). We will set up a petition in our area and surrounding farm-watch areas and also forward that to you so that you can discuss it with your superiors.

All of us feel that it has come to a point where the community, Eskom, SAPS and SANDF need to tackle this problem together otherwise it will not stop before nothing is left. We will also be driving this through our local newspaper and you can be assured that a lot of help will be offered by the citizens, we just need to know what we can do and where we can help because everybody in a very wide area is being affected and want to stop this problem now.

Everybody is unhappy because there are talks of increasing the Eskom rates substantially but how can it be expected of people to pay more for a service, they more often than not don’t receive?

We are looking forward to your feedback.

Rustenburg – Having the necessary knowledge to know what to do in an emergency can prove invaluable. *Platinum Weekly* attended a first aid class at Trauma Rescue to gain vital medical knowledge and to learn how to apply it. Basic Life Support practitioner Boipelo Mothibe gave an informative presentation starting with the basics of first aid like the first steps to take when you find someone in distress, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), how to splint a broken limb, apply

a bandage and treating different types of wounds. Reading about what to do and applying it practically are very different. It's not as easy as it looks in the movies. Trauma Rescue is dedicated to saving lives and can provide you with the knowledge of what to do if you ever find yourself in a situation where you need to apply CPR or first aid. **For more information contact Trauma Rescue on 0861 789 911.**

The cruel side of fireworks

Rustenburg – The festive season is upon us and while we all look forward to having fun with our loved ones and friends and celebrating the New Year's Day, most animals spent Old Year's Eve in fear. For the Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA), 31 December and 1 January are some of their busiest days of the year. Says Rustenburg SPCA manager Marisa Kruger: "Animals, whether its birds, dogs, cats or even squirrels are not taken into account when people decide to use fireworks. It has a traumatic effect on the animals, some of them get hurt, some of them get lost and some die. Our workload is huge after New Year's Eve. I stand in amazement at people's ignorance about the effects that fireworks have on animals, and I wish fireworks would be banned altogether." **Do the responsible thing and report fireworks to the Rustenburg Police Station on 014 590 4115.**

According to Specialist Investigators' Mike Bolhuis, the noise of fireworks leads many dogs to perceive it as a threat and triggers a fight or flight response. Other signs of anxiety are barking, restlessness, panting, pacing and whining. Frightened cats appear startled, run away or hide away. Other signs cats might show are either toileting in the house or excessive grooming. It is breeding season for many species of birds and the noise may startle mother birds off their nests – leaving the eggs unprotected and exposed.

Fireworks and the law:

- The use of fireworks in South Africa is regulated by by-laws under the Explosives Act of 1956.
- This means that you need to check in with your local authorities to ensure that there are no by-laws that apply in your city or town.
- One may not light or ignite fireworks in a place where animals are present (R1,000 fine). This includes your own home.
- Fireworks may not be set off in any public place. This includes in parks, on the pavement or on streets.
- Shopping malls, restaurants, liquor stores and clothing retailers are also off-limits.
- Fireworks may not be sold by street vendors, hawkers or at any informal open-air facilities.
- Anyone who wishes to sell fireworks must have a valid licence, which is issued by

- the chief inspector of the Department of Explosives.
- It is illegal to detonate fireworks within 200 metres of a hospital, clinic, petrol station, old-age home, nursing home, or animal welfare organisation or institution.
 - No one under the age of 16 is allowed to purchase or set off fireworks.
 - It is unlawful for any person to point or direct a firework at another person, animal, building or motor vehicle.
 - No person or organisation is allowed to present fireworks displays unless formally authorised to do so by the Council (at least 14 days' notice).
 - Authorisation is also required from the Civil Aviation Authority and the Chief Inspector of Explosives.
 - A pyrotechnician and SA Police Services explosives expert must be present at all times.
 - Failure to comply with any of the above could result in a hefty fine or even jail time.

A few tips shared by Mike Bolhuis

- Microchip your pets.
- If need be – medicate your pets with anti-anxiety medication, but, consult with your veterinarian first.
- Create a safe space for your pets. Turn off other noise in this space as a TV or radio will only exacerbate the problem.
- Keep the space locked and ensure that the pets are not able to escape but also, they should not be able to hurt themselves by breaking through a window or jumping over something when they panic.
- Close windows and curtains to muffle the sound of fireworks.
- Specialised vests, wraps or coats can be bought, it is said that such pressure garments have a calming effect on pets.

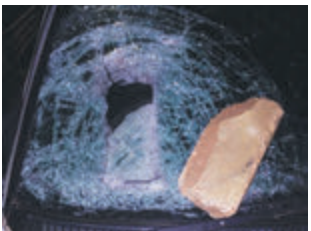
- Numerous complaints have been lodged to the ward committee, municipality, and public safety... but no action has ever been taken against the Ramochana electricity thieves.

Their actions cause safety hazards to the residents of Ramochana. The wires they use to supply this electricity are exposed. On rainy days, you can see smoke coming from the cables. Ramochana is a crime hotspot. Several so-called taverns sell alcohol with fake licences, disobeying Covid-19 regulations, and buying and selling stolen goods take place daily. **I hate living in this place.**

Operation Basadi yields success



SAPS and traffic officers issued tickets to offenders during "Operation Basadi".

Rustenburg – Police in Rustenburg took part in SAPS' provincial Operation Basadi conducted on Monday 6 December. On this day, a total of 129 suspects were arrested in the province. In Rustenburg, the national deputy police commissioner: crime detection – lieutenant general Liziwe Ntshinga – handed out gifts and food hampers to nine survivors of gender-based violence. "With these Christmas presents, we want to show you that you are not alone," Ntshinga said. Rustenburg Local Municipality member of mayoral committee for Public Safety councillor Virginia Mputle – who accompanied Ntshinga – commended warrant officer Bonita Dry of Ikageng Detectives and sergeant Obakeng Rasego of the Rustenburg Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) unit for their part in ensuring the conviction of Thabang Gordon Moloi and Tshepo Ben Moloi. The duo – who are not related – were handed lengthy jail terms for crimes ranging from kidnapping, rape, robbery, murder to escape from lawful custody. Meanwhile, some of the suspects arrested during Operation Basadi have already appeared before various courts.

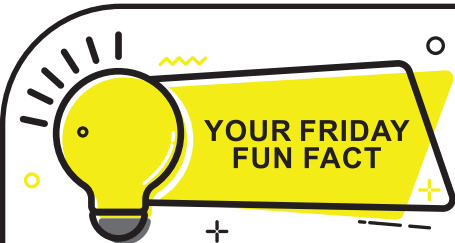

Glencore Ferroalloys heeds government's call to help fight GBVF in South Africa.

With the scourge of rape and violence against women on the rise in communities across the country, Glencore Ferroalloys has stepped up to contribute towards the fight against these crimes by supporting government's Thuthuzela Care Centres initiative and empowering women in their local communities.

Thuthuzela Care Centres are one-stop facilities that serve as a critical part of the country's anti-rape strategy. The aim of the centres is to reduce secondary victimisation, improve conviction rates and reduce the cycle time for finalisation of cases.

Glencore Ferroalloys recently committed R4 million towards the building of another Thuthuzela Care Centre at the Dilokong Hospital, located at Gowe, a rural village in the Fetakgomo Tubatse Local Municipality in Limpopo. The Dilokong Hospital Thuthuzela Care Centre being built by Glencore is expected to be completed in the first quarter of 2022.

Glencore CSR Superintendent, Ntombizodwa De Toit, said she looks forward to a time when construction of the centre is completed so it can begin the important work of supporting women and children who are victims of rape in the community.

"As an organisation we pride ourselves in ensuring that we live our values, and with this particular project our values of responsibility, openness, and simplicity resonate most," she said during a recent sod turning ceremony at the site.

De Toit said this initiative by Glencore is in response to one of the biggest challenges faced in the country.

"It is a challenge that needs all hands on deck and most importantly, it is a challenge that calls for strong partnerships because GBVF affects everyone irrespective of age, gender or nationality. To roll this project out, we aligned ourselves to Pillar 4 of the NSP which speaks to the integrated care and support of GBVF survivors and their families, and we are proud to start the process of ensuring that our community members have access to their own Thuthuzela Care Centre," she said.

The new centre will be built within the Dilokong Hospital which services 166 villages with an estimated population of 335 676. This is a welcome intervention in an area characterised by a weak economic base, inadequate infrastructure, major service backlogs, dispersed human settlements and high poverty levels.

Glencore Ferroalloys also recognised women empowerment as an important tool which can go a long way in giving a voice to the voiceless. On 26 November 2021, Glencore Ferroalloys in partnership with the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE), Women in Mining Advisory Committee (WIMAC) and Mine Health and Safety Council (MHSC), officially launched their 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence and Femicide (GBVF) awareness campaign. The campaign which calls for zero tolerance against the abuse of women and children within the South African mining industry, is a collective effort from Glencore Ferroalloys and other mining houses in the Rustenburg area to play their part in creating awareness, as well as supporting victims of GBVF near their operations.

As part of this campaign Glencore Ferroalloys announced support for start-ups founded by women, which will be mentored at their Enterprise and Supplier Development (ESD) hub which was launched in 2020 to support local businesses around Glencore's operations.

"Our aim from the ESD hub is to support recipients and uplift communities. We aim to provide them with the tools they need to equip themselves so they can equip others. Our first step is to work together with the recipients to create a development plan after investigating the needs and shortages within their businesses. We then put them through a programme with an expert in a particular field to mentor them as they develop their skills. We are proud to walk this journey with these women whom we have seen grow from strength to strength and we will continue to hold hands with them to ensure that they reach their full potential." Enterprise and Supplier Development Superintendent of Glencore Ferroalloys, Charlin Ntuli said.

Farewell Frikkie Pretorius

Rustenburg – It is the end of an era as Frikkie Pretorius retired from Van Velden-Duffey this year due to ill health. Pretorius was born in Rustenburg and raised on a farm in Marikana. He matriculated at Hoërskool Rustenburg in 1979, whereafter he pursued his BJuris degree at UNISA. In 1985, and after obtaining his degree, Frikkie started his career as a public prosecutor. By the end of 1986, and after serving as regional court prosecutor in Rustenburg, Frikkie resumed his studies and obtained his LLB degree at the North-West University (Potchefstroom Campus). During January 1989, Frikkie was appointed as a candidate attorney at Van Velden-Duffey. He was admitted as an attorney on 12 February 1991 and appointed as partner of Van Velden-Duffey by March of the same year. Since then, he has made a major impact and has become a household name in the community.

Pretorius dedicated much of his time to serving on various committees of the Law Society of the Northern Provinces, the Legal Practice Council, local governing bodies and community programmes. He will be remembered for his involvement in several controversial murder trials as well as the Marikana enquiry. His excellent legal mind and charismatic personality will be greatly missed.

Although no one can replace Frikkie, his active matters have been distributed amongst the team of expert litigators who will attend to the needs of his clients.

We hope that this time will give Frikkie the opportunity to pursue those dreams that have long been set aside and to enjoy the things closest to his heart.

Chicken bobotie snacks

Rustenburg – Boep Pensie owner Claudie Kriel started making platters three years ago. She simply loves cooking and decided to create affordable platters.

"I take great pride in the food that I prepare. Nothing is made beforehand, it's freshly prepared," Claudie said.

Her chicken bobotie snacks is a great hit and she was gracious enough to share her recipe with *Platinum Weekly* readers.

Ingredients:

- 1 whole chicken
- 1 cup mayonnaise
- spices of your choice
- salt
- 1 packet creamed chicken soup
- 1 tablespoon curry
- a pinch of turmeric
- 50ml lemon juice
- 1 egg
- 1 large onion, finely chopped
- 2 table spoons apricot jam
- a dash of milk
- a hand full of raisins

Instructions:

1. Cook the chicken thoroughly.
2. Deskin and debone the chicken before cutting it into small pieces.
3. Combine all of the ingredients (except the eggs and milk) together.
4. Place a spoon full of the mixture in a greased muffin pan.
5. Mix the eggs and milk together and pour over the chicken mixture.
6. Bake for 30 minutes at 180°C.

Uprooting invasive alien plants

Rustenburg – Invasive alien plants introduced to South Africa from other countries often threaten biological diversity and lead to environmental harm if left to thrive.

Without natural enemies, these plants reproduce and spread rapidly, taking valuable water and space from indigenous plants and causing extensive damage to the environment.

Mountain Club of South Africa (MCSA) volunteers from Magaliesberg see the removal of these invasive plants as an important part of their conservation efforts. The MCSA is more than 100 years old and is one of the oldest mountaineering clubs in the world. Club members, often accompanied by friends and relatives take part in the conservation of mountain areas through fire management, erosion control on roads and paths, weeding or hacking of invasive plants, removal of snares as well as funding research on conservation-related initiatives.

MCSA climbing convenor Magaliesberg section Roger Diamond said each weekend, volunteers spend time removing invasive plants along various trails. They hack and uproot the weeds for many hours at Castle Gorge and other areas along the Magaliesberg.

Some of the invasive plants common in the Magaliesberg area include syringa (*Melia*

azedarach), lantana (*Lantana camara*), senna (*Senna occidentalis*) pompom (*Eupatorium macrocephalum*), crofton weed (*Ageratina Adenophora*), inkberry (*Cestrum laevigatum*) as well as prickly pear cactus (*Opuntia ficus-indica*).

"We enjoy spending time in healthy natural environments, so keeping them free of invasive alien plants is imperative to preserving our heritage and enabling our members and the public to enjoy nature at its best," Diamond said.

He added that invasive alien plants bring with them an increase in the risk of fire and higher rates of water usage which leads to clogging and damage of waterways. These unwanted plants also transform the indigenous veld into an impenetrable thicket that has no ecological value.

"In other words, the local wildlife derive no benefit from these plants and so the ecosystem is gradually destroyed as the invaders multiply. Without losing sight of the seriousness of the work we do, we have a lot of fun, explore hidden parts of the Magaliesberg that hikers and climbers never see and the team spirit on a weeding trip is the best," Diamond said.

"Getting sweaty, scratched and burrowing deep into a kloof on a hot day is rewarded by being in nature so fully with a keen and fun bunch of weeders," he concluded.

AN UPDATE ON JACO

Rustenburg – At the start of 2021, Jaco Roodt started showing symptoms of Covid-19. The necessary test was done but it came back negative, however; his condition started deteriorating.

Platinum Weekly reported on 9 April that he started getting very sick, so he went to another doctor who then realised that Jaco (who is not a drinker) has a swollen liver and suffered heart failure.

He was transferred from doctor to doctor and hospital to hospital. For his family, everyday he remained alive was a miracle. Not knowing what the next day might bring, the family arranged a surprise wedding for him and his wife Elsabé Roodt on 24 April.

The next day, Jaco went to see a doctor in Koster who changed his life. Two days after taking the prescribed medicine he started getting better. By July, Jaco started working again and is back at his old job. He is eating again and has gained some weight. The family is slowly but surely regaining their financial stability, but they still have a lot of medical expenses every month that includes medication and doctor's visits. HIS GRACE, ARCHBISHOP THABO MAKGOBA VISITS MARIKANA

On 15 and 16 November 2021, Sibanye-Stillwater hosted His Grace the Anglican Archbishop of Cape Town, Thabo Makgoba, who is the patron of the Marikana Renewal programme, on his first visit to the greater Marikana area. The purpose of the visit was to meet with stakeholders as a part of the inclusive engagement process to create a renewed Marikana.

His Grace was joined by Dr Mamphela Ramphele, co-founder of Reimagine SA which is an independent social facilitator engaged by Sibanye-Stillwater to ensure that the pillars of renewal Honour; Engage and Create are realised. Some of the key deliverables of the Marikana Renewal Programme include; the finalisation of the houses for the widows and their children; educational support; support for Bapo Ba Mogale; and social programmes in partnership with government and the community.

During his time in Marikana His Grace held meetings with non-governmental organisations and municipal managers to engage with them on progress being made on partnership programmes aimed at improving livelihoods and the social environment. His visit included a tour of the community where he viewed some of the houses that have been handed over to widows affected by the Marikana tragedy and where he was able to interact with dependents. His Grace and the delegation also met and engaged with Bapo Ba Ga Mogale chief, Kgosi Kgolo Nkwane Andrew Mogale, and the members of the traditional council at the Bapo Ba Ga Mogale Royal palace.

On the final day Archbishop Makgoba was taken to the site of the tragedy, the Koppie at Wonderkop, where a prayer and reflection session was held.

Dr Mandla Yawa who lost his brother in the events of August 2012 joined His Grace on the visit to the Koppie. Dr Yawa is a beneficiary of the 1608 Memorial Trust, an educational trust set up to provide education support for children that were affected by the Marikana tragedy. He recently received his Doctorate in Animal Science from the University of Fort Hare. Our congratulations go to him for this admirable achievement.

“We can remember the past but now we have to build the future. As we approach the tenth anniversary of Marikana next year, we have to offer a new reality which reimagines the future of Marikana. A community that is united, has found healing and is working at restoring itself, and gearing itself up for greater heights.”

HONOURING THE ELDERLY

In September 2021, Sibanye-Stillwater, in partnership with Bapo Ba Mogale Traditional Council, officially handed over the Reteng Masilo Disability Centre. The centre was established by the late Reteng Masilo to support and empower the elderly and people living with disabilities in Segwaelane, Madibeng.

Reteng Masilo initially housed the beneficiaries in his home, as there were no facilities available for the elderly in the community. When the beneficiaries increased, there was a need for a facility that could accommodate everyone. The centre is now a fully functional income-generating centre with more than 90 beneficiaries. Some of the income generating activities include beadwork and farming.

The centre was initially called Segwaelane Community Centre, but has been officially renamed to Reteng Masilo Disability Centre in honor of the late Masilo who passed away in 2019.

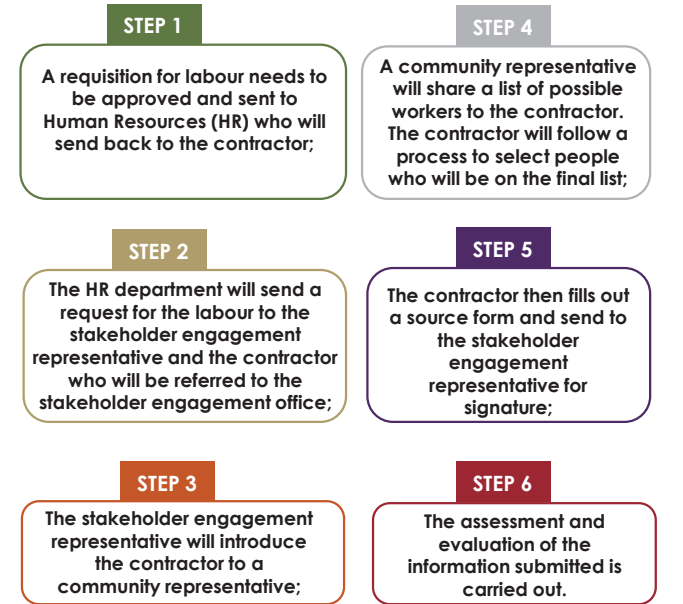

FOOTBALL FOR WATER!

Rustenburg – Glencore continues to lend a helping hand to local communities by rolling out projects and initiatives that are a direct response to their needs.

One of Glencore's divisions, Glencore Ferroalloys handed over a water-saving soccer pitch to Seraleng Primary School in Rustenburg on Wednesday 1 December.

The soccer pitch, valued at R2,74 million, is made of high-quality Astroturf and will serve both learners and the community by providing clean water while promoting sports development. The pitch is a reservoir which has support structures positioned under it to create a rain-harvesting and storage unit, then, when the rainwater is depleted, it automatically switches over to borehole water.

Connected to the pitch is a filtration system that can clean about 3,000 litres per hour. During filtration, viruses, bacteria and suspended solids are eliminated, but minerals and nutrients are retained. The handover event which also served as a scouting opportunity for local players was attended by Glencore executives, Seraleng Primary School principal Thato Modutoane, Greensource representatives, and Kaizer Motaung Junior who was also representing the Kaizer Motaung Junior Foundation.

Glencore's senior human resource manager at Wonderkop Smelter, Fatima Hayat said they decided to partner with Greensource in building the soccer pitch after taking a tour

of the school and the community to identify pressing needs.

On the day, the school held a skills drill for 12 kids from the different local schools, after which four players were selected to attend trials at a camp that will be held by Atletico Madrid in Cape Town early in 2022.

The boys played two matches, one with primary school learners, the other with high school learners.

The skills drill was facilitated by Gillash Sports Group who selected the four players that would represent Rustenburg in Cape Town.

Kaizer Motaung Junior motivated the boys to reach for the stars and to value the important

role sports can play in their lives.

"Glencore's support is changing your lives!" Thato Modutoane thanked Glencore and Greensource for their support.

"Sports has the ability to play a critical role in the lives of young people and that's why this day is a day that will make an indelible impact in the lives of the parents as well as students in this community.

This is the only Primary School in Seraleng and thanks to Glencore, it will be the centre of developing talent in the community because education is not just classroom-based, we must mentor kids inside and outside the classroom," he said.

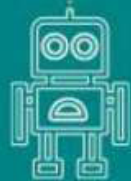
