GRADE R TEACHER SHOT AT SCHOOL ENTRANCE

Rustenburg - A Grade R teacher was brutally The provincial commissioner of North West, lieutenant murdered by two gunmen at Rutanang Primary School's entrance in Geelhoutpark on Tuesday

The 45-year-old woman arrived at the school at 06:55 in her silver Toyota Fortuner, where two men approached her before she could enter the gate. She was shot at close range from the passenger side, and the gunmen reportedly walked away from the scene without taking anything from the vehicle.

An onlooker immediately alerted the police and paramedics. ER24 rushed to the scene but sadly, the teacher already passed away.

According to brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, the motive behind the incident is unknown and investigations into the matter continues. No arrests have been made so far.







Cable theft is extremely inconvenient and often leave residents without electricity for days on end. The members of the public are encouraged to report any suspicious activities to the Eskom Crime Line number: 0800 11 27 22 or to call the Crime Stop Hotline on 086 00 10111 or your nearest police

All scrap metal dealers, foundries and smelters should also refrain from buying stolen cables. Copper or cable theft is a very dangerous crime – it also creates huge financial losses, especially in the maintenance of infrastructure, accumulative costs of safety and security services, policing, court representation and sentencing.



They lost 300 teff bales, 656 grass bales and 7,000 bags of lucerne pellets that were ready to be distributed. Their tractor was burned beyond repair and their trailer sustained a lot of damage. The cables to their factory also have to be replaced. The damage is an estimated R2.1 million.

The Engelbrecht's are still in shock and unsure about their next steps. Although his factory can continue to produce, the season is almost over. so finding the grass and products needed to make the feed now, is close to impossible. The rainfall we had this year was great for the crops but not for the fodder industry, making it even more difficult to get grass.

"The support we got from the community is overwhelming. People that we don't even know came to help during the fire and we have received offers of lucerne and grass to help us start up

He has partnered with Olifantsnek petrol station on the R24, and together they plan to host a colour fun run, with various fun family activities on 2 July... Watch this space for more details! 




























Yarona Rustenburg goes into test phase

Rustenburg – Nearly ten years after the Rustenburg Rapid Transport (RRT) system was announced, Rustenburg residents will see the project come to fruition in June 2022.

In early June 2022, residents will see Yarona buses running up and down the CBD, including two routes that will start in Tlhabane.

The system has received the blessing from the National Department of Transport (NDoT) and the testing phase has begun. "The test phase will last for two weeks, and the team led by Rustenburg Local Municipality will conduct a series of tests to confirm the operational readiness verification ordered by the DoT," said Theron Rapoo, head of marketing and communications at RRT.



MPIMPI ON CHILD **ABUSE**

Rustenburg - The National Child Protection Week is commemorated annually to raise awareness of the rights of children. It is one of the most important weeks on many social workers' calendars

Rustenburg Child Welfare kicked off Child Protection Week on Monday 30 May with child abuse awareness campaigns at schools. This presentation is aimed at teaching children what their rights are and to speak up if they feel uncomfortable. It educates them on what channels to follow if they are abused or if they suspect a friend might be a victim

The campaign also focuses on teachers and gives them the guidelines on what signs to look out for and what the procedure to follow to report abuse. Teachers are in contact with children on a daily basis. Children don't often report it when they are abused. Giving teachers the tools to spot the signs, is the first line of defence to protect a child.

Schools have a statutory responsibility to report child abuse and failure to do so is a crime.

Rustenburg Child Welfare paid a visit to several schools in Rustenburg. They also shared a video of the issue with parents. Their mascot, Mpimpi got centre stage in the campaign. Directly translated from Setswana "Mpimpi" means snitch and it encourages children to become whistle blowers when it comes to abuse.
