R10m theft lands pair in hot water

Rustenburg - It is not yet clear if Sitona Mining will recover the more than R10 million that was stolen from the company, [allegedly] by two former employees from 2014 to 2019.

Dinah Dorothea Botes (40) and Alicia Gwanathon Cullingham (32) appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday 13 June on theft charges after they were arrested by the Hawks. Botes allegedly transferred more than R9.3 million into two of her personal accounts before disguising the source of the money. She is facing 126 counts of theft and one count of contravening the prevention of crime act (POCA).

Cullingham - who also allegedly used the same method to transfer more than R1 million into her account during the same period - is facing 18 counts of theft and 21 counts of contravening the POCA.

"Both of them were working in the accounts department where they were handling payments. The money was not recovered," North West Hawks spokesperson captain Tlangelani Rikhotso told Platinum Weekly.

Botes and Cullingham were granted R30,000 and R15,000 bail respectively and the matter is likely to be transferred to the regional court for their next appearance on Friday 8 July.

Sitonia Mining responded to questions from Platinum Weekly through their lawyers, Van Velden-Duffey: "We cannot comment on any pending criminal and/or civil matters until such a time as they have been finalised in court. We can however confirm that two suspects have been arrested in relation hereto.



Guilty!

Rustenburg - Gerhard Jansen van Vuuren was found guilty in the Gauteng High Court sitting at the Palm Ridge Magistrates' Court on Monday 13 June.

He stabbed his ex-girlfriend, Andrea Venter, to death at the entrance to her housing complex in Fourways, Johannesburg on 2 May 2011. Afterwards, he attempted suicide by cutting his throat and laying down next to her body.

He managed to evade arrest for several years by fleeing the country. He was later tracked down and arrested on 18 June 2020 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

Jansen van Vuuren pleaded not guilty on account of intermittent explosive disorder (IED). A diagnosis made by a psychiatrist during January 2022. But the court found him guilty of premeditated murder of Venter and the assault of a security guard who daughter's murder has finally been found was on duty the day she was killed.

Missing boy's remains found

Mogwase - The 14 January 2022 issue of Platinum Weekly reported on the disappearance of 8-year-old Tlotso Mogomotsi Moilwe from Mogwase on Saturday 25 December 2021.

Tlotso was spending Christmas day playing with friends when he went missing.

Police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh confirmed that the boy's remains were found and positively identified.

"We can confirm that subsequent to investigations into the missing eightyear-old Tlotso Mogomotsi Moilwe of Mogwase as reported in December 2021, bones and clothes were found in January 2022," said Myburgh.

"Although the mother confirmed the clothes as those of the missing person, the bones were sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) for DNA tests, which came back positive," Myburgh

She said a reward of R50 000 that was offered for information leading to the whereabouts of the boy has now been withdrawn.



Changing Lives. Together.



Rustenburg - A video showing kids rioting and teaching at the Geelhout Secondary School and vandalising school property on Wednesday 7 June was circulated on social media. It was later established that the children in the video are learners at Geelhoutpark Secondary School and the incident prompted an oversight inspection of the school by the Democratic Alliance (DA).

Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) DA caucus wip Nelio Nhacuangue released a statement on 10 June regarding their visit to the school: The DA in the RLM is calling for immediate action

to address a number of issues that are disrupting learning and teaching at the Geelhout Secondary School. The school is facing serious challenges of ill-discipline, fighting, and bullying. Even during our visit to the school, we witnessed the sheer illdiscipline, fighting and the smoking of marijuana by some learners.

It is evident that there is a serious breakdown in respect between teachers and learners feeding a general culture of ill-discipline at the school. The disrespect teachers must endure is not only concerning, but also disappointing.

The Department of Education must carry out a swift and thorough investigation into the events leading to continuous disruption of learning and

work closely with the parents and the community to prevent similar incidents in the future.

The DA believes that bullying and violence have no place in schools which are meant to be safe places for all learners

In an interview with Platinum Weekly a parent of one of the learners shared his concern: "Before this happened, we had a meeting with the school to address some of the issues and together tried to come up with solutions. One of the teachers started crying saying that he doesn't know what to do anymore because the kids are just not listening to them. It is tragic as they are the ones responsible for upholding the discipline in the school. What worries me even more is that the school didn't even report the incident to the parents, and I only found out after seeing the video on social media. Apparently a memorandum with serious allegations that needs to be addressed was handed over to the principal.'

Platinum Weekly reached out to the school for their comment, but they declined to answer. At the time of going to print we had not yet received feedback from the Department of Education.

CIT Heist suspects caught

Rustenburg/Boitekong - Siyanda Junior Dlamini (37) and Mangoba Mavuka, two alleged cash-in-transit (CIT) robbers, appeared before the Rustenburg and Orlando Magistrate's Courts on Thursday 9 June.

The duo was arrested following investigations into a CIT robbery that took place on 6 June in Boitekong. They are facing charges of armed robbery with aggravating circumstances, possession of ammunition and unlicensed firearms.

"It is alleged that on Monday, two G4S security officers collected money from several shops at Boitekong mall and drove off in their armoured vehicle when they were suddenly rammed into by a vehicle on the R510 four-way stop," said Hawks spokesperson Captain Tlangelani Rikhotso.

According to reports an unknown number of suspects allegedly started shooting at the armoured vehicle with rifles and disarmed the security officers of their 9mm pistols.

The suspects then allegedly bombed the AV and took an undisclosed amount of money and fled the scene in multiple vehicles

A multi- disciplinary team consisting of the Hawks' Serious Organised Crime Investigation units in West Rand and Rustenburg, Crime Intelligence, Gauteng Highway patrol and Road Traffic Management Corporation (RTMC) operationalised the information on hand and utilised all available resources to trace the suspects

Dlamini and another male were stopped by JMPD officers in Soweto on 7 June. The other man allegedly jumped out of the vehicle and ran off. The vehicle was searched and a Norinco pistol was found leading to the arrest of Dlamini. Shortly after, the man who ran off returned and after firing at police officers a shootout followed. He subsequently fled the scene again.

Mavuka was traced and arrested in Tlhabane where he was found in possession of a traffic officers' uniform, a 38 Revolver and a 303 Rifle. Dlamini appeared in court on 14 June for formal bail application, meanwhile Mavuka was released on R10 000 bail and the matter was postponed to 30 November for further investigation.

The Provincial Head of the Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation in North West major general Patrick Mbotho lauded the team for the swift arrest and encouraged them not to stop now as there are still more suspects on the loose. "Let us strike now while the iron is still hot" he said

North West Department of Social Development key achievements and new service delivery plans for 2022/23 financial year



Migration of ECD to Education

The Department of Social Development will continue to provide the necessary support to the Department of Education following President Cyril Ramaphosa's pronouncement in his 2019 State of the Nation Address (SONA) that early childhood development should be moved to the department of education to improve the development of children and the quality of early education as enshrined in the National Development Plan Vision

On the 1st April 2022, all registered and unregistered ECD centres including eighty one posts from the department of social development were transferred to the department of education. The Department of Social Development remained with other functions such as child protection, psycho-social services, access to social services and parental support programmes. Other remaining services are partial care facilities that relate to aftercare services, private hostels and respite care centres for children with disabilities.

Job creation

An amount of R19, 339 200 has been set aside for the opening following some structural defects and heavy storms creation of work opportunities which are in line with the that damaged its roof twice in November 2021. EPWP ministerial determination.

Women empowerment

The department has provided a basket of interventions in the facility in the current financial year. As it is with all funded form of equipment and stock to women owned entities and small businesses as part of the support to sustain their livelihoods.

Youth Development

The department has budgeted an amount of R8m to implement a National Youth Service (NYS) programme, targeting 1000 unemployed young people who have been profiled from the deprived wards and assessed to be change agents within their respective households.

Tackling Gender Based Violence

The Department of Social Development will strengthen District Gender Based Violence Coordinating structures. Departmental plans are at an advanced stage to develop a comprehensive LGBTIQ+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Intersex, Queer Plus) programme with the aim of preventing victimisation of LGBTIQI community and promoting tolerance and social cohesion.

The department has budgeted R15m to strengthen and fund 23 Non-Profit Organisations to enable them to continue to provide care and support to victims of GBV and crime. Furthermore the department has launched Orange Day initiative to eliminate all forms of violence by wearing an orange colour on the 25th of every month.

Capacity building of NPOs

The department will provide capacity building to 2 530 Non-Profit Organisations (NPOs) in areas of good governance, compliance monitoring support, resource mobilisation and financial management. Most NPOs do not comply with the NPO Act and their non-compliance is a serious concern to the legitimacy and vibrancy of the NPO sector to partner with government and the private sector. The department will undertake 'Your NPO Status' campaigns to all districts to enhance their compliance to NPOs Act.

Social relief of distress programme

The Department of Social Development continues to provide social relief of distress in the form of food parcels, sanitary towels and school uniform to households that experience hunger and undue hardships. The target for this year, is to provide food parcels to 16 000 households across the province. A total of 5 500 vulnerable women including teenage girls will receive dignity pack on a monthly basis.

Solidifying services for older persons

The department has thrown its weight behind the Premier's flagship project on the establishment of a new old age home in Matlosana Local Municipality. The project, which is at the planning stage is in honour of the late ArchBishop Desmond Emerald Tutu. The department will continue to collaborate with the Office of the Premier, Dr Kenneth Kaunda District Municipality and other stakeholders to ensure that this directive is realised.

In the year under review, over 1 982 older persons have enjoyed the residential care services across the province. This impressive figure is despite some hurdles, experienced in Greater Taung old age home, which delayed the official

The repairs have been done on the state-run facility, which is at 95% practical completion. The facility has finalised the recruitment process of the key nursing staff and the department is now working towards operationalising this

residential care facilities, the department will ensure that they comply with the norms and standards as stipulated in the Older Person's Act 13 of 2006.

Substance abuse prevention and rehabilitation services

In 2021/22 financial year service users accessed treatment services at JB Marks Treatment centre. The Department has also reached 65 942 people through substance abuse prevention programmes across the province.

The department will intensify its collaboration with all other stakeholders and funded NPOs in the implementation of the Drug Master Plan that responds to the scourge of substance abuse through programmes on prevention, support, treatment and aftercare. An amount of R4,2m has been set aside to fund eight organisations to provide aftercare and prevention services in the communities. The department also registered six community and private organisations that also deal with the treatment and rehabilitation of substance

In the current financial year, the department will facilitate the establishment and resuscitation of Local Drug Action Committees in collaboration with local municipalities. Furthermore, the department will intensify substance abuse prevention programmes at TVET colleges in order to curb the risk and increase in substance abuse disorder among the students.

NDA and SASSA plans for 2022/23 financial year

National Development Agency (NDA) North West has been allocated R2m to implement its primary mandate of contributing towards the eradication of poverty and its causes by granting funds to civil society organisations and this will see the creation of three hundred (300) work opportunities in the current financial year.

SASSA will contribute to poverty reduction by continuing to provide social assistance to older persons, people with disabilities, children and people facing undue hardships. With regard to access to Covid-19 SRD grant, an additional qualifying and assessment criteria has been added in the new applications and those in need of assistance will have to reapply for this grant even if they were previously in receipt of the grant.





'GUILTY ON ALL COUNTS'

NSPCA wins animal abuse case for dog that was beaten and buried alive

Molorwe (close to Moruleng) – For two years, National Council of Societies for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (NSPCA) inspector Matome Semenya and inspector Oageng Mosito



National Council of SPCAs

remained steadfast in obtaining justice for a dog they rescued during the investigation of an animal abuse case that the NSPCA will never forget.

On Thursday 9 June 2022, NSPCA inspectors Matome and Oageng honoured their duty as inspectors, when they won the NSPCA case against Samuel Modise, a man who has brutally beaten a dog and buried the animal alive in his backyard.

On 13 April 2020, the NSPCA responded to a gut-wrenching complaint in Molorwe village, North West. The owner of the dog informed the NSPCA that her dog had been brutally attacked by her neighbour, Samuel Modise, and that Modise refused to let the owner see her dog after the attack.

The NSPCA was accompanied by members of SAPS to Samuel Modise's property, where Modise admitted to violently beating the dog with a spade and a brick. He further claimed that the dog had died. Modise attempted to conceal the body from the NSPCA stating that the dog had already been buried. Eventually, with the assistance of SAPS, the NSPCA was able to obtain the location of where the dog's body was being kept by Modise- a bush behind his property. When the shallow grave was dug up by the NSPCA inspectors, they made the shocking discovery the dog... was still alive!

The dog was found severely injured, covered in blood and certainly breathing her last in excruciating pain. Given the extent of the injuries that she sustained, the only kindness the NSPCA could extend at that point was to humanely euthanise her, surrounded by people who would never forget her torture, and who would fight for justice to be served! A case was then opened against Samuel Modise by the NSPCA. Both, NSPCA inspector Matome and inspector Oageng remained dedicated to obtaining justice for the dog, and pursued this case religiously for the past two years. Modise even attempted to have the case withdrawn from Court, claiming that he was trying to protect his goats from the dog, but NSPCA inspector Matome fiercely defended the NSPCAs case to keep it in Court. Magistrate Herbert Modiba, from the Mogwase Magistrates' Court, found Samuel Modise guilty on all counts. Modise was fined R1,000 for his crime, and now has a criminal record. The NSPCA hoped that Modise would have faced direct imprisonment for his crimes. Samuel Modise used a spade and a brick to beat the dog so violently that her eye even popped out of its socket. Modise then, knowing the dog was alive and in pain, intentionally inflicted further suffering to the dog by burying her alive - condemning her to a slow and torturous death. These acts of violence by Modise can only be regarded as premeditated, inhumane and barbaric. There should be no place in society for humans that display such aggression to helpless victims! Today it is our animals, tomorrow it will be our children.

Israel Mafologela and Patricia Makgopela, who both work at the college's offices in Rustenburg, gave


