## MAN SHOT AND KILLED

**Rustenburg** – The murder of a National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (NUMSA) member on Friday 26 June 2022 left his colleagues at Impala mine traumatised. Mahlomola Hlothoane, who was a shop steward, was shot and killed by two unknown suspects outside his home in Rustenburg. NUMSA spokesperson Phakamile Hlubi-Majola said: “Our deepest condolences to the friends and family of Hlothoane. This is a very tragic loss.” Police are investigating a case of murder and no arrests have been made yet.

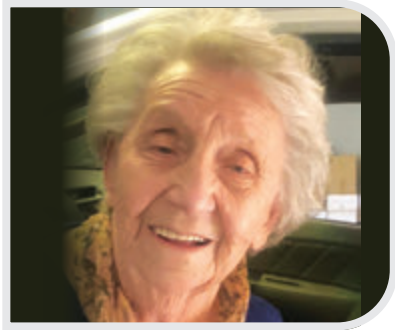

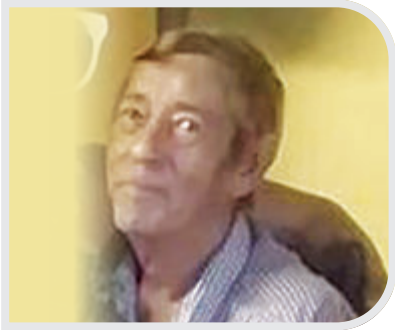

STRAY BULLET PIERCE THROUGH ROOF

The bullet hole in the ceiling.

**Rustenburg** – A young family living in East End was shocked to find a bullet hole in their ceiling on Wednesday 22 June.

When they came home that evening, they noticed the hole in the ceiling of their one-month-old son's room. It looked a lot like a bullet hole, but they couldn't confirm. Later that evening as the woman was busy in the baby's room, she noticed something lying on the wet wipes. It was a bullet.

Further investigations showed that the bullet damaged the tiles as it pierced through the roof, it then went through the ceiling, landing up on the wet wipes.

She went to the police station to report the matter and was told that there were two instances that day where shots were fired between police and criminals in the area. The bullet was handed over to the police for a ballistics investigation. It is unknown if it was a stray bullet from the two shoot outs between police and criminals in the area or if it was another stray bullet...

"What scares me the most is to think what could have happened if we were at home. What if I was standing there when the bullet came through the ceiling. Or worse... What if I had my baby with me and it hit him," the young mother said in an interview with *Platinum Weekly*.

Police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone confirmed that a case of 'unlawful discharge of a firearm in a built-up area' has been opened for investigation. He advised members of the community and firearm owners to always report incidents relating to stray bullets to the police.

According to the Firearms Control Act, it is an offense to discharge a firearm in a built-up area without a good reason to do so. A warning shot should be the last resort and you still have to do so in a responsible manner and never fire a shot into the air.

You are responsible for where the bullet goes from the moment it leaves your firearm.

Reward increases to R100,000

Rustenburg

– Twenty-nine-year-old Juandr  Kidson was brutally shot and killed in front of his wife and their one-year-old daughter while they were on their way home.

An object placed in the road by highway robbers damaged a tyre of the Kidson family's vehicle on the N4 (Brits-area) on Saturday 7 May.

While busy changing the tyre, three attackers overpowered him. He begged them to take everything they wanted and pleaded with them to not hurt his family. They ransacked the car for items including a cellphone and then cold-bloodedly shot him in the head.

The killers then turned to his wife Johanette Kidson who was holding their baby girl. They attempted to take the baby from her. She fought tooth and nail to keep her daughter safe and in the process was shot in the shoulder.

The reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the three highway robbers involved in the murder of Kidson was increased to R100,000.

Police spokesperson captain Aafje Botma said that an attempted murder and murder case was opened, and police are busy with the investigation. No arrests have been made yet.

"A R100,000 is a lot of money so I can't understand how no one has any information about my brother's killers," said Marco Kidson, Juandr 's younger brother.

"Please come forward if you have information."

Juandr  Kidson was brutally gunned down in front of his wife and daughter.

# NAKED CHURCH MEMBERS, FOUND WITH 11 SMALL NAKED CHILDREN... GRANTED BAIL!

**Boitekong/ Rustenburg** – Six church members who appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court for the second time on Monday 6 June for contravening the Sexual Offences Act and *crimen injuria*, were each granted R2,000 bail. Sibusiso Fuzini, Vuyo Mgadi, Mantubulo Mkiva, Siphokazi Kombela, Linda Govo and Zoliswa Menziwe are due for their next appearance at the same court on 18 August. Our 10 June 2022 issue of *Platinum Weekly* reported how a tip off led to their arrest on Friday 3 June at a house in Sondela Phase 1, which was apparently used as a 'church'. They were all naked at the time of the arrest, except for the 34-year-old female 'church leader'. With them were eleven children aged four to 12. Said police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone: "Their bail conditions are that they are not allowed to gather in the church. They do not have any criminal records. The children went for counselling with social workers," he added. Soon after their arrest, a neighbour told

*Platinum Weekly*: "We are angry. The kids were there for days without food, and they were locked inside the 'church'. The 'congregants' said they were waiting for Jesus to come. I don't think the church leader is mentally stable. The children were traumatised." This disgraceful incident occurred while South Africa was commemorating National Child Protection Week [Sunday 29 May to Sunday 5 June]. It is supposed to be a time for all of us to renew our commitment to protect children... Police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone says the children – six boys and five girls – were removed from the house and handed to social workers for intervention. "The house that was used as a church was burnt partially on Friday after a couch and other items were set alight by the church leader. She was arrested and charged on Sunday 5 June 2022 after she had been discharged from the hospital where she was admitted on Friday 3 June. We are investigating the matter," Mokgwabone said.

**Rustenburg** – Loadshedding is a shining light for a new criminal trend in Rustenburg. In the past, criminals had been vandalising transformers to make money from the parts. This was not easy money and came with risks, like electrocution. As we entered stage 6 this week, these criminals now have easy pickings as the danger of electrocuting themselves has

# TRUCK CAUSES EIGHT-DAY ELECTRICITY OUTAGE (and that on top of load shedding!)

**Rustenburg** – Residents of East End were once again left without electricity for more than a week after a truck damaged an electrical pole in Tuin Street on Tuesday 21 June.

Apparently, the truck was on its way to a local mechanical workshop. Damage was caused on two separate occasions to electrical poles in the area by trucks on its way to this ‘workshop’, on 21 June and on 26 June. According to an eyewitness, the driver of the truck causing the damage on 26 June fled the scene.

A complaint was lodged with the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM). “Every time we phoned to follow up, a different excuse was given.” the *Platinum Weekly* was told. Democratic Alliance ward 18 councillor Cobus Nortje voiced his concerns about electrical problems in the area. “I asked for feedback numerous times, but the teams didn’t arrive as promised.”

According to Nortje, the Tuin Street area – at the truck shop – has live electrical wires lying on the ground “but my pleas fell on deaf ears”. Fed up with a week without electricity, residents took to the streets on 27 June and set tyres alight in protest.

The MMC for infrastructure and technical services Thabang Rampou, came to address the protestors and a meeting was arranged for 28 June at 09am. This meeting had to be rescheduled several times during the day. The proposed meeting finally took place on 29 June, eight days after the electricity went off and by 13:15 that afternoon the power was finally restored.

“It’s like the RLM just forgets about us. In December, I lost a lot of food due to electricity. Again, I had to throw away everything in my fridge. It doesn’t even help if you lodge a claim with RLM, because we have had pending claims for the past eight years,” a resident told *Platinum Weekly*.

We reached out to the RLM for comment but at time of going to print we had not yet received a response.

## R700,000 FRAUD

**Rustenburg** – Betty Diale (52) appeared before the Rustenburg Regional Court on Monday, 27 June, on charges of fraud amounting to R700,000.

According to information available at this stage, reports suggest that Fidelity Funds received several complaints from the Road Accident Fund (RAF) claimants whose payments were deposited into Diale’s trust account.

The money never reached the claimants. Diale allegedly committed fraud from 2009 to 2011 and was charged with fraud in June 2021. She is out on a warning and has been instructed not to interfere with investigations. She is due to appear again in court on Thursday 4 August for pre-trial conferencing.

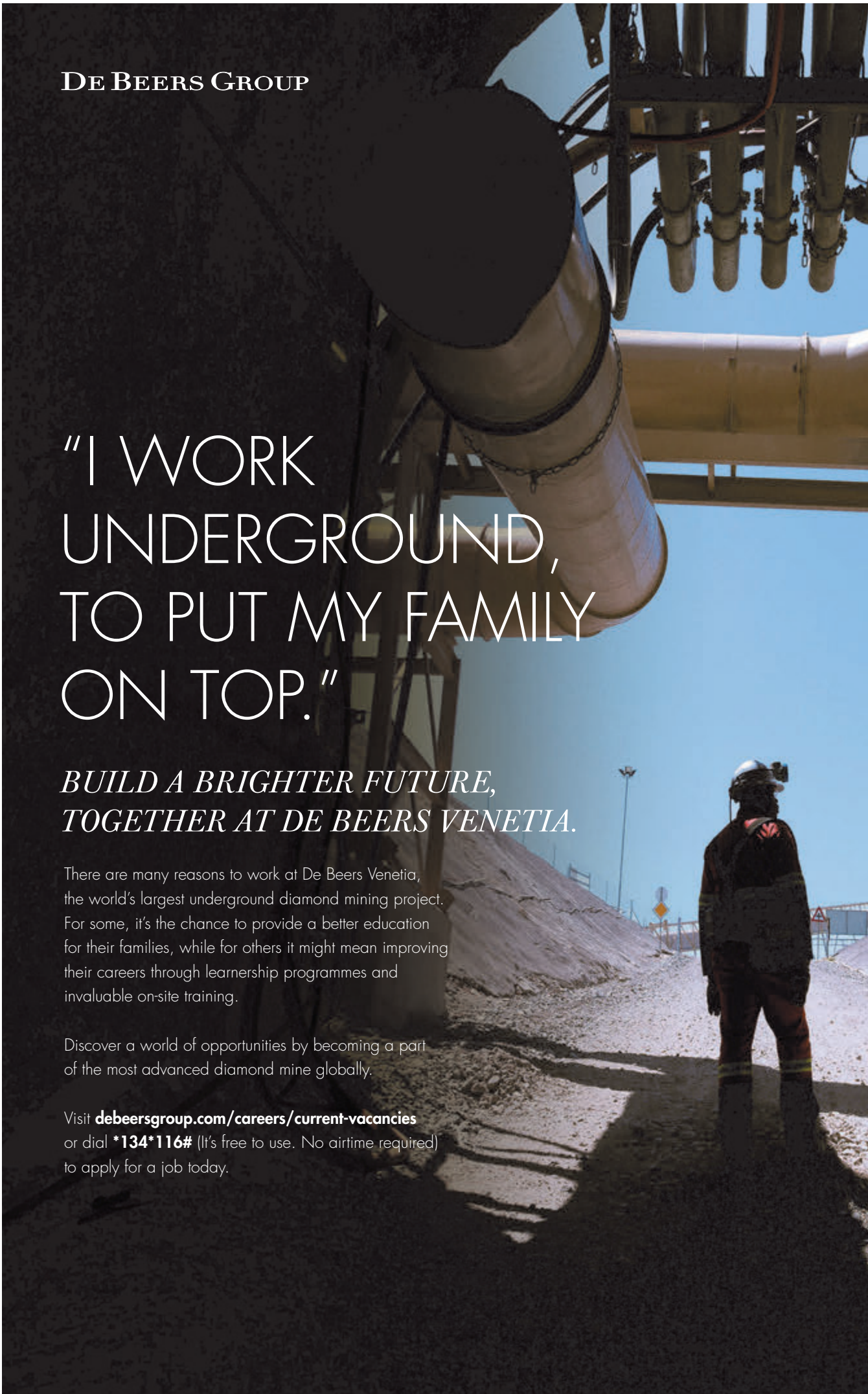

## Apology to Jewish community, visit to holocaust centre part of steps against learners after Nazi salute at Hoërskool Rustenburg

**Rustenburg** – The disciplinary hearing of five learners at Hoërskool Rustenburg who were in the news recently after doing a Nazi salute at a karaoke competition at the school, has been finalised.

“The school governing body maintained throughout that the incident was of a very serious nature. In accordance with the school’s code of conduct, the learners were found guilty of unbecoming conduct of a serious nature,” says Mr Bernhard Visser, Chairperson of the SGB.

The governing body also met with the South African Jewish Council of Representatives (SAJCR) about the incident. “The Council requested the school to handle the matter in an educational manner rather than simply punishing learners. This is also the approach of the disciplinary committee of the governing body, and the decision about disciplinary action was based on this approach.”

Bernhard says the learners involved have to sign an apology to the Jewish community on behalf of the school. “The governing body is of the opinion that ignorance is not an excuse for behaviour like this. It is the duty of everyone involved in the education of our children to make sure that they understand why their behaviour has an impact on other people.”

The five learners will visit the Holocaust and Genocide Centre in Johannesburg during the third term. Members of the Jewish Council will accompany them and provide guidance. They will also provide the learners and the school with material to continue the awareness actions.

“While specific awareness actions are focused on the learners involved in the incident, the governing body is also committed to creating awareness among the rest of the school about the history represented by certain symbols. The learners will therefore have to prepare a presentation and address the school about their visit to and their experience of the centre.”

The governing body is satisfied that the incident was investigated properly, and that the outcome of the disciplinary process befits the serious nature of the incident. “An incident that could have caused serious damage to the school’s reputation has afforded us the opportunity to equip our learners to look at similar incidents with more understanding.”

Bernhard says the governing body has great appreciation for the manner in which the South African Jewish Council of Representatives became involved in the matter. “The Jewish community is directly affected. However, the Council immediately offered their assistance with awareness and emphasised throughout that the matter be handled in a way that promotes learning and understanding.”

Bernhard says the SGB is also satisfied that the school’s code of conduct for learners as well as the internal disciplinary processes serve Hoërskool Rustenburg’s ethos of tolerance and inclusion.

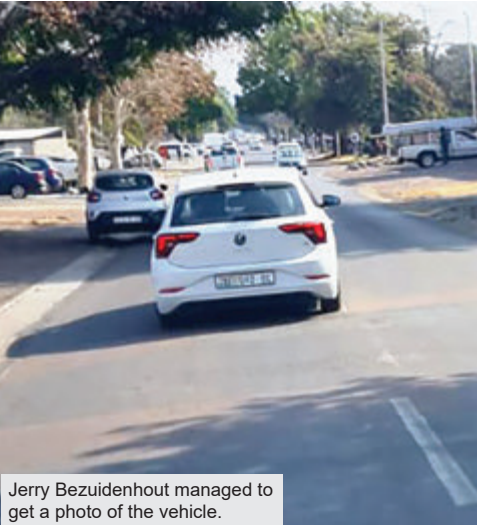

# Something smells really bad... and its heading towards our drinking water

**Rustenburg** – A dreadful foul smell of sewage has been polluting the air around a residential complex on the Arnoldstad road for months on end. The cause of this smell is an uncontrolled flow of raw sewage emanating from this particular complex since January.

After receiving numerous complaints from residents in the area, AfriForum Rustenburg-tak chairperson Dawie Conradie set out to investigate. “I found that the pump system that is supposed to pump the sewage to the Rustenburg sewage treatment works, was removed by Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) for repairs. Apparently both pumps were taken and haven’t been returned as yet,” Conradie said.

He again alerted the RLM about this issue on Tuesday 14 June, listing that one of the main concerns is the raw sewage finding its way into the Hex River.

According to Conradie, raw sewage has been flowing into a ditch from where it eventually finds its way to the Hex River, which flows into the Bospoort Dam.

The Rustenburg Water Services Trust draws water from Bospoort Dam as potable water for the community of Rustenburg. “I am sure that you can see the problem herein as raw sewage could now possibly be contaminating drinking water. This poses a serious health risk to our communities along the river as well as end users of potable water supplied by the Bospoort scheme,” Conradie added.

Human waste naturally contains coliform bacteria and other bacteria that can cause diseases. Contaminated water becomes a health hazard and has a dire effect on the environment – and... it stinks.

• In the meantime, residents of the complex had taken their own initiative and had the pump repaired and rewired. All that is left to do, is for the pump to be refitted on the RLM line so that the sewage can be reverted to the sewage plant. At the time of going to print the sewage was still flowing.

Conradie has also brought this to the attention of the RLM on multiple occasions over the past week. He also raised questions about RLM’s plan of action to avert an environmental catastrophe, the proposed timeline of when residents can expect the pumps to be fully functional, and remedial steps that can be taken by the RLM regarding the flow of sewage towards the Hex River, agricultural research council irrigation dams as well as possible contamination of Bospoort Dam.

*Platinum Weekly* reached out to the RLM for comment but at time of going to print we had not yet received any feedback.

# NUMSA strike at three Impala Platinum contractors regretted

Rustenburg – The management of Newrak Mining, Triple M Mining and Reagentswe Mining regret the strike action being carried out by members of the National Union of Metalworkers of SA (NUMSA) at our operations at our client Impala Platinum’s Rustenburg mining operations. In this joint statement, the three companies would like to correct a number of incorrect claims that have been made by the union in respect of our operations. To the extent that the strike relates to demands for union recognition, there are different circumstances applying at the three companies. AMCU is the majority union at Reagentswe and Triple M, with NUMSA representing between 16% and 26% of employees. At Triple M, NUMSA was given limited organising rights to enable them to improve their representation. However, after 14 months, they were unable to improve their representation. In contrast, NUMSA is the largest union at Newrak and is recognised by the company. Newrak cannot offer NUMSA access rights on Impala’s property. They were however offered office facilities outside the Impala property. This offer was rejected by NUMSA.

We trust NUMSA will recognise that unprotected strikes could have implications for members’ job security, and that they make the responsible decision of calling off the strike. Job security is an important issue, and the companies would like to avoid any job losses for all of their employees and the impact it would have on their livelihoods and families. The companies are small businesses and can ill afford a loss in production. Losses this week have amounted to some R30 million. We have noted claims that NUMSA has made about “exploitative” wages and working conditions. This is false, including the claim that some earn “R5,000 a month”. a very different type of mining from standard Impala operations. We are hired to mine shorter-life and hence higher cost mines. This means that our cost structures are very different. One of the shafts was identified for closure by Impala in 2017 and is being mined by one of the contractor companies, preserving 3,000 jobs over the past five years. It would be helpful if NUMSA were to recognise these facts and allow their members to continue to sustain the lives of the mines, their own livelihoods and the sustainability of the companies.

**Joint press release extracts, Newrak Mining, Triple M Mining and Reagentswe Mining, dated 23 June 2022**

**NUMSA response:**  
**Rustenburg** – The National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (NUMSA) met with its members who are employed by mining contractors Triple M, Reagentswe, and Newrak. All three contractors provide services to Impala Platinum mines in Rustenburg. At the general meeting, workers decided to suspend the strike at Newrak mining company. This is because NUMSA won in court against the employer when they attempted to interdict the strike. The judge dismissed Newrak’s application for an interdict on Friday 24 June. She found that the strike was lawful, and she ordered that Newrak must engage Implats to allow NUMSA to access the



workplace. NUMSA has the right to represent workers inside Implats and hold meetings. Our members agreed to suspend the strike at Newrak to allow for talks between the employer and the union to resolve these issues. We will be meeting with Newrak on Tuesday 28 June. If these talks fail and we do not find each other, we have the right to continue with the strike. The strike at Reagentswe and Triple M has been interdicted and therefore strikes at both these companies have been suspended. Workers have returned to work. This week, NUMSA will be approaching the CCMA head office in Johannesburg to enforce the labour court order, ordering it to conduct verification at Reagentswe. The CCMA in Rustenburg failed to implement the order that was handed down last year June which is why the application is being made at head office. NUMSA will also be pursuing the unfair dismissal of 97 of our members who were dismissed unfairly for participating in the strike this past week. Reagentswe dismissed them because they expected that workers would return to work same day for their shifts after the interdict was granted. However, that was impossible to achieve because some of them were out of town when the interdict was granted on Tuesday last week. NUMSA requested that workers be given until Thursday to return to work. But Reagtswe management dismissed them through an SMS! We condemn them for blatantly violating the workers’ right to strike. Our attorneys have sent them a letter of demand informing them that they must be re-instated immediately. Failing which we will take further legal action. The strike was protected and there was no basis for the dismissal. On 8 July the CCMA will conduct verification of NUMSA at Triple M. This verification process is to deal with closed shop agreement which was imposed on workers without balloting taking place. The closed shop agreement has expired, and we believe that NUMSA is the majority union. # Chrome plants popping up like mushrooms

- Questions that need to be answered:
- Are all these operations legal?
  - Where do the chrome-processing operations get their ore from?
  - Are these operations registered as water users with the Department of Water Affairs?
  - Should these operations have an environmental authorisation?
  - Who is going to carry the burden of any negative impacts their operations might have on our environment and the health of the people exposed to any negatively affected environment?



**Rustenburg** – One of *Platinum Weekly's* long-time readers, who has over the past few years taken on several questionable operations and business dealings in our area, has her eye on the chrome plants that are popping up like mushrooms in and around Rustenburg. She is busy preparing a document for Parliament and we have advised her to stay anonymous for now, as we are of the opinion that she might be putting herself in danger by doing so. There is a lot of money to be made in the chrome mining industry, especially if you don't have to pay all the fees and taxes

and adhere to all the regulations... which a legitimate mining operation has to do. She recently visited eight such plants in our area and was accompanied by a representative of the Department of Mineral Resources and Energy (DMRE) to one of the operations. Not one of the operations she visited could show her an environmental impact assessment (EIA). The plant she visited with the DMRE was solely a chrome processing operation. Apparently the DMRE representative told her that because it is not a mining operation, it does not fall under the scope of their

department. *Platinum Weekly* also spoke to a DMRE inspector who confirmed the same. He said that they can only get involved if it is a mining and processing operation, which by the way... are also popping up like mushrooms... We received video footage and photos which she took during her visits, showing how water from one of these operations finds its way to a nearby stream, which eventually finds its way to Bospoort Dam. "The trees were cut off and huge areas were flattened to make space for new waste dumps and wash plants, and they cannot show an

EIA," she says. What about the Fauna and Flora? She says complaints have come in from community members staying in the area of the operations. Apparently, the trucks of these operations are running at a rate of eight trucks an hour. The *Platinum Weekly* asked a well-known environmental expert for an opinion on the matter. We have also made contact with a local mining company who is in the process of responding to us. We will delve into the matter further and relay the feedback we have received in the meantime, in next week's issue.
