### SKELETON **FOUND BEHIND CLINIC**

Seraleng/ Rustenburg - A skeleton was discovered in a field behind Seraleng Clinic on Saturday 16 July.

Seraleng resident Hendrick Thebe told Platinum Weekly that the remains were found under an electric pylon by a local community member. He immediately alerted other community members. "A local community member, out hunting with his dogs, spotted the skeleton. As one of the community leaders, I went to the scene with the other community members so that we could see the discovery for ourselves," Thebe said.

The hunter led them to a field close to the clinic, where he pointed at the gruesome discovery.

"We noticed that the skeletal remains were badly burnt and lying under an electric pylon, so we concluded that the person might have been a copper cable thief who was electrocuted to death," Thebe added. "The identity of the person is not yet clear."

The community members informed Boitekong SAPS about the gruesome discovery.

Police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh confirmed that investigations are underway.

SIU welcomes the arrest of former municipal manager in North West for awarding R215 million IT tender



Moretele – The Special Investigating Unit (SIU) welcomes the arrest of former municipal manager of Moretele Municipality in the North West province for allegedly contravening the Municipal Finance Management Act with the irregular awarding of a multimillion-rand IT tender. Theletsi Roger Nkhumise was arrested on Friday (15 July 2022) and appeared before the Moretele Regional Court. Nkhumise is accused of unlawfully appointing Flame IT Strategy to render Information and Communications Technology (ICT) services to the Moretele Municipality, which is largely rural, to the tune of approximately R215 million. The municipality inherited the contract for ICT services from Madibeng Local Municipality.

The arrest of Nkhumise follows an investigation conducted by the SIU, which revealed that the municipality increased the scope of work with two addendums to the original contract without following processes governing municipal procurement of goods and services.

Furthermore, the SIU investigation revealed that the price from that of the original contract between Madibeng Municipality and Flame IT are definitely not in sync with the pricing between Moretele Municipality and Flame IT. Madibeng paid Flame IT approximately R64 million for a similar service.

The SIU has instituted a civil action in the Special Tribunal to review and set aside the contract. This will pave way for the State's only anti-corruption, forensic investigation and civil litigation agency to recover financial losses suffered by the municipality due to negligence and corruption. # R10m theft case moved to regional court

Rustenburg - Two former employees of Sitona Mining accused of stealing more than R10 million from the company, will now appear before the Rustenburg Regional Court on Wednesday 3 August 2022.

National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson Henry Mamothame said this decision was taken on Friday 8 July when Dinah Dorothea Botes (40) and Alicia Gwanathon Cullingham (32) appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court. The two, who were arrested by the Hawks in June 2022, are accused of stealing more than R10 million from the mining company from 2014 to 2019.

Botes allegedly transferred more than R9.3 million into two of her personal accounts before disguising the source of the money. She is facing 126 counts of theft and one count of contravening the prevention of crime act (POCA). Cullingham - who also allegedly used the same method to transfer more than R1 million into her account during the same period - is facing 18 counts of theft and 21 counts of contravening the POCA. "Both of them were working in the accounts department where they were handling payments. The money was not recovered," North West Hawks spokesperson captain Tlangelani Rikhotso told Platinum Weekly.

> Botes and Cullingham were granted R30,000 and R15,000 bail respectively.

Sitonia Mining responded to questions from Platinum Weekly through their lawyers, Van Velden-Duffey: "We cannot comment on any pending criminal and/or civil matters until such a time as they have been finalised in court. We can however confirm that two suspects have been arrested in relation hereto."



Brits - Two days after the City of Tshwane secured a court ruling allowing the City to attach the bank account of Madibeng Local Municipality in the North-West province, the Madibeng Local Municipality has come forward and paid R155 million of the R258 million it owes to the City of Tshwane.





# ALWAYS BE ON THE SAFE SIDE WHEN BURNING

Rustenburg – Due to a favourable Fire Danger Index (FDI) forecast and because the unusually wet weather interfered with the ability to burn this season, the Greater Rustenburg Fire Protection Association (GRFPA) extends the deadline for the burning of firebreaks, block burns, and ash pits until Sunday 31 July.

- All risks and responsibility for burns and any consequences arising from such burn's rests solely with the landowner/ occupier of the land on which the burn is initiated.
- No burns may be conducted without notifying your cluster manager. Cluster managers are not legally entitled to give permission to burn but are legally entitled to object to a burn should they consider conditions to be unsafe.
- All laws of the National Veld and Forest Fire Act (NVFFA) must be / adhered to. Don't say you did not know the law.
- Observe the FDI. NO BURNING if the FDI is ORANGE or RED.
- Notify all neighbours of the proposed burn, when it starts and when it is completed.
- Your neighbour or responsible person should be present at the burn.
- · Make sure you have sufficient equipment, manpower and personal protection equipment to burn safely.
- Ensure that the burn is fully extinguished and monitored for at least 24 hours to ensure that flare-ups do not occur.

Please refer to the GRFPA website for the full version of chapter 4 and 5 of the NVFFA which deals with landowners' obligations and responsibilities in terms of fire breaks and firefighting.




