FORMER MM FACE CHARGES

Rustenburg – Rustenburg's former municipal manager (MM), Nqobile Sithole appeared before the Rustenburg Regional Court on Monday 15 August.

Sithole (39) is being charged for contravening the Municipal Finance Management Act (MFMA) in connection with the alleged appointment of a service provider for a contract worth more than R11 million. The case has been postponed to 19 September 2022.

Says Hawks spokesperson captain Tlangelani Rikhotso: "It is alleged that in August 2017, the Rustenburg Local Municipality unlawfully adopted a contract by the Free State Department of Transport, supposedly in terms of Regulation 32 of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulation. The Department of Transport had appointed a service provider to render services related to the hiring of a construction plant and machinery (yellow fleet). It is alleged that when Rustenburg Local Municipality adopted the contract, the prescripts of Regulation 32 were not followed, in that, they did not get permission from the Department of Transport before adopting the contract."

• Rikhotso said instead of sticking to the original scope of the contract, the municipality deviated and purchased light motor vehicles worth approximately R11,983,271.50.

"The accused was charged with contravening section 173 (1) (a)(ii) and 174 of the Municipal Finance Management Act read with Regulation 32 of the Municipal Supply Chain Management Regulation," Rikhotso added.

OUT IN THE COLD

Ledig – More than 150 families were evicted, and their houses demolished from a portion of land located next to Mahobieskraal village near Ledig on Wednesday 3 August.

The eviction stems from a court order obtained by the Bapolomiti Community Property Association (CPA) that was granted in 2020.

“We were initially granted permission by the

Bathalerwa Traditional Authority who are said to be the rightful owners of the said land to occupy the land. Some of our community members took out loans to build their houses, we are deprived of our right to land, we are now on our own. Imagine being thrown out of your house without any notice,” local community member Tshepiso Molelele Morobane told the *Platinum Weekly*.

Bapolomiti CPA belongs to members of 95 families who were forcefully removed from farm Palmietfontein JP208 by the apartheid government. The last families were moved in 1937. The land was initially claimed by Kgosi Phera Shongwane who was the then chief of Bathlhalerwa. Following the investigation the DARLLD restored the land to the previously dispossessed families as per the restoration act. The land was transferred to the CPA which is the custodian. The initial claim was for five portions. Only four were restored. Portion 2, portion 3 and 4 which are in the Pilanesberg Game Reserve and Portion 5. We have the title deeds for Portion 2, 3, 4 and 5. Portion 6 was not restored, and the matter is at Land Claims Court to have it restored back to Bapolomiti. In 2019, CPA approached the municipality to assist in establishing a proper township. The municipality prepared a town plan, CPA appointed a land surveyor to peg the stands as per town planning for the area as per town planning. We spent about R300,000 to prepare the land for township development proper occupation. We were in a process of allocating the land to the beneficiaries of Bapolomiti CPA when the illegally occupants invaded the land. We approached the courts. On the 20 February 2020 were granted an eviction order and a demolition order on 20 August 2020. We tried to engage the illegal occupants and physically served some with notices to evict. Those who were there were given order to vacate by 20 March 2020 or be evicted by 31 March. Unfortunately, the Sheriff could not proceed with evictions due to lockdown. The Sheriff served them and also put up a board to advise them that there is court order to evict and demolish. At the time there were only shacks and no permanent structures. Despite all action taken they proceeded to occupy the land and even build formal structures. The illegal occupiers put an application to have our order rescind, the process we defended. Bathlhalerwa Tribal Authority joined their application later represented by Benito Motlatswe. The court dismissed their application on the 11 November 2021. We preferred to have a properly planned township by involving the municipality. We wanted to ensure that we have proper planned roads so that emergency services can enter easily. They went in and built houses, destroying the pegs and not even following the town planning layout. We are suffering financially having to fight legal battles with monies we did not have.

The Chief of Bathalerwa Tribe, Kgosi Gaositwe Shongoane, together with the Royal Family and the Traditional Council wish to place the following on record: The land claim of farm Palmietfontein 208JP was lodged by his father, Kgosi Simon Phera Shongoane, working with Bathalerwa Land Claim Committee, on behalf of Bathalerwa around 1997 and was successfully accepted around 2008. Tensions started to emerge after the land claim was approved and some opted to establish Bapolomiti CPA around 2011. Kgosi and Bathalerwa were advised by officials from the Department of Rural Development and Land Affairs (DALRRD) in Pretoria and Mahikeng that Bapolomiti CPA is a legal entity of Bathalerwa. Bapolomiti CPA are not the land claimants of Palmietfontein. Bapolomiti is a direct Setswana translation of Palmietfontein and therefore merely a name given to the CPA and the land claimant. The demolition was an inhumane and insensitive act on the part of Bapolomiti CPA, and must be condemned in the strongest possible terms as a violation of not only the rights of Bathalerwa as the land claimants but equally a violation of the rights of the individuals and families who were regularized by Bathalerwa to occupy Portion 2 of Palmietfontein, and are now suffering pain and loss. Bathalerwa calls on the provincial and national departments responsible for CPAs to undertake a full forensic investigation on the operations and ownership of Bapolomiti CPA. Bathalerwa also calls on the Human Rights Commission to undertake a full investigation on the violation of rights of all affected and interested individual and communities as a result of the eviction and demolition including whether or not the two court orders were properly obtained and implemented. Bathalerwa further demand payment of losses suffered by all affected and interested individuals and communities, including taking action against individuals who were part of the decisions to evict and demolish houses in Portion 2 of Palmietfontein. Bathalerwa view the continued harassment of individuals and families who are rendered homeless by Bapolomiti CPA which has deployed armed security to stop individuals and families from picking up bricks, fences, and other belongings as unfortunate and arrogant.







NO MONEY FOR ATM BOMBERS!



The criminals who bombed the ATM fled the scene without any cash.

Rustenburg – Just before an ABSA ATM was bombed at Wildey Centre on Friday morning at around 03:00 in the morning, a gunshot was heard. Quick reaction by the community neighbourhood watch prevented the suspects from getting any of the money from the damaged ATM. Said police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh: “The suspects did not get away with any money and when the police arrived, the suspects had fled the scene.” The police are investigating the incident.

Over the past few weeks Landbank has been accused of using ‘bullying tactics’ to recover outstanding debts from farmers. An alarming number of farmers have been liquidated, summonsed, and evicted. Farmers who have been farming for generations on their farms are now being liquidated after failing to pay their debt. In this day and age, food security is top of mind for South Africa and the world, which needs to be protected. In a struggling economy, there is a reason why it’s becoming more difficult for farmers to turn a profit... and as a result more farmers turned to Landbank for help. The Bank will continue to act in the interest of all its stakeholders, including its clients, to recover debts owed to it in accordance with the applicable laws. Land Bank’s clients are encouraged to contact the Bank when they face challenges in meeting their loan repayment obligations to ensure that an assessment of potential solutions may be undertaken to obviate the need for the Bank to resort to the legal processes. The Bank’s debt recovery methods are based on risk mitigating strategies that are intended to work with its clients in finding solutions that will mitigate risk to their business operations, and also provide targeted solutions in instances where farmers experience distress and default on their facilities as a result of such risk factors. The Bank therefore strives to assist farmers as a starting point, and will only proceed with legal action against defaulted clients as a last resort.

We call on those clients who may feel that they were unduly treated to contact the Bank, and to utilise available avenues to constructively address their matters.

Beware the cellphone thief!

Koster – Several residents residing in the Cedrella area of Koster are victim to a girl who has been going around stealing cash and cellphones from their homes, after having asked them for assistance to buy books. One of the victims, who preferred to remain anonymous, told *Platinum Weekly* how the girl’s mother pleaded with him not to open a case with the police after he managed to recover the cellphone she had stolen from his wife. When the girl arrived at their home, the girl showed them a forged letter from a school indicating the girl was ‘in need of textbooks’. “This girl used to come to our house to ask for money and we would give her out of the goodness of our hearts,” the community member explained. “I told her to stop coming to our house after the visits became too frequent. Early this year, she came to our house while I was not there and showed my wife a letter from the school for her to buy textbooks. My wife was suspicious and kept the letter, which turned out to be a forged one. She discovered her cellphone and money was missing and we then confronted the girl after another person living in our area told us he had also fallen victim to her fabrications,” he added. He urged Koster victims to be vigilant when a girl comes to their houses requesting for help.

[Major] security forces deployed

Rustenburg – A massive concentration of state security details at the Rustenburg Civic Centre from 12 to 15 August 2022 has raised many questions and comments on social media. There was a heavy presence of law enforcement agencies from the South African Police Services (SAPS) North West, Rustenburg Department of Public Safety and other security clusters that are part of the provincial joint operational and intelligence structure (PROVJOINT) during the four days. They were assigned to maintain law and order on the roads and to provide security around the venue during the African National Congress (ANC) provincial conference. There was a particularly heavy presence of security clusters along the Heystek and Job Shimankane Tabane road, the R24 road between Engen Garage Nelson Mandela, the Kloofweg and Greystone Traffic Light and the Bodenstein Park stop sign. Said police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone: “The activation and deployment of the PROVJOINTS role players is done to ensure safety at the conference, ensure minimum disruption to the day-to-day activities as well as to prevent crime in Rustenburg and surrounding areas.” Some residents questioning this decision feel that securing a single venue in anticipation of violence and paying less attention to other crime hotspots is a waste of crime-fighting resources. “It is the type of security which could have made a huge difference at the KZN looting spree,” one of the comments on social media read. Some of the delegates who attended the conference chose not to use the designated dustbins to throw away their refuse. Plastic bags, used disposable food containers, and other waste could be seen lying around.

Spiking incident on N4 Shylock area

Rustenburg – In the early hours of Tuesday morning 16 August, a woman travelling on the N4 kept her cool when one of her bakkie's tyres were ripped to pieces in a spiking incident. It happened on the N4 between Eskom's Shylock substation and the Koster turnoff. She did not stop and slowed her vehicle down, driving towards her family who stays a short distance away. Apparently, immediately after the spiking incident, a vehicle appearing from nowhere drove towards her, but they changed direction when she turned off the road towards her family. “Please be careful and don't stop if this happens to you,” a local community member said on social media.

MARIKANA MASSACRE MARKS 10 YEARS

Marikana/ Rustenburg – Tuesday 16 August 2022 marked exactly 10 years since the tragic events of August 2012 which resulted in the loss of 44 lives and left many injured. Among the victims were 34 mineworkers who were shot and killed by police during a wildcat strike at Lonmin Mine for better wages. Prior to the protest, from 12 August to 14 August 2012, ten people were killed, including six mine workers, two Lonmin security guards, and two SAPS members. With the acquisition of Lonmin in 2019, Sibanye-Stillwater embraced the inherited Marikana legacy and set out to ensure that the change of ownership served as a catalyst for transformation. Sibanye-Stillwater has done much to honour and accelerate actions to contribute to the healing process for the widows and children of those who died. Chief executive officer (CEO) at Sibanye-Stillwater Neil Froneman led the process of bringing about renewal and assisting the community of Marikana to move away from the painful events of the past by embracing a future of hope and optimism. FARM ATTACKER FENDED OFF



Rustenburg – A farmer and his workers averted what could have been a farm attack by contacting personnel from Buffel Sekuriteit and Rustenburg Landelike Diens to give chase after four perpetrators tried to gain access to a building on the farm. This took place earlier this week near Barnardsvlei. “They are determined to cause damage,” says Buffel Sekuriteit and Rustenburg Landelike Diens owner Charl Visser. Close by, another resident warned that danger also lurks all the way from Kroondal, and in areas between the Old Pretoria Road and the R24 Road. “Criminal activities are escalating in our area; we need to be vigilant 24/7,” the community member told *Platinum Weekly*. “What we've noticed these past few weeks, is that the perpetrators in these areas are either cutting through fences or digging underground (in the case of electric fences) to illegally gain entry,” Visser said. Visser advises cutting trees and bushes to prevent criminals from hiding under thick foliage is a good crime-prevention habit. “Early security warning systems need to be in place and are vital to curb crime,” Visser said.

REPORT ELDERLY ABUSE!

SA – The news of an elderly woman who passed away after she was allegedly left outside an old age home in Ceres, Western Cape, on Sunday 7 August has shed light on the care of the elderly in South Africa. It is reported that the elderly woman, believed to be in her eighties, was taken outside the previous evening to have a cigarette. When police arrived at the scene the next morning at around 07h54, they found her lifeless body in the wheelchair outside. Mahatma Gandhi once said: “The greatness of a nation and its moral progress can be judged by the way its animals are treated.” Gandhi obviously never thought that the elderly would be mistreated like this. At the root of this quote is that as a nation we should look after the vulnerable. We have to fight for those who are unable to fight back. Stand up for those who cannot do it for themselves... This most vehemently include our elderly. The abuse of elderly people often goes unnoticed. They are sometimes isolated because of immobility or due to their age, or they don't get many visits from friends anymore. In some cases, children ‘dump’ their parents at old age homes where they are forgotten and controlled by those who are appointed to take care of them. Abuse of the elderly, like any other form of abuse, is illegal in South Africa. Section 10 of South Africa's Constitution states

that everyone has the right to have their dignity respected and protected. In addition, the Older Persons Act criminalises all forms of elderly abuse. Those found guilty can be fined or imprisoned. **Elderly abuse is more than just physical abuse, it can also include:**

- Neglect where the caretaker fails to fulfill a caretaking obligation.
- Financial exploitation where the person's money is being withheld or misused by someone else.
- Emotional abuse where the elderly is being intimidated, humiliated, ignored, isolated or terrorised.

I am married in community of property – can I sign a separate will?

Rustenburg – There are no prescriptions in the Wills Act on which persons must sign a joint will. You could therefore execute a will together with your neighbour, your friend, or your domestic worker. On the other hand, you do not have to sign a joint will with your spouse, irrespective of whether you are married in or out of community of property. You could do your own will separate from your spouse. However, you can only deal with your assets in your will. Where you are married in community of property, you can, for example, not take your spouse's 50% interest in the joint estate away from him or her in your will. Your spouse will always be entitled to his or her 50% after you have passed away in terms of the marriage in community of property, irrespective of what your will stipulates. This principle applies to each asset in the joint estate. You can, therefore, for example, not bequeath your farm to your son on your own where you are married in community of property. This is because 50% of that farm belongs to your spouse. Your spouse will have to cooperate to get the farm to your son after you have passed away. The will has to cater for

massing, and the surviving spouse will have to adiate (accept) the will and the massing after your death. My advice to married persons is to do a joint will whether they are married in or out of community of property. This makes it easier for everyone if there is one document catering to three scenarios, namely:

1. One scenario is where the husband passes away first,
2. One is where the wife passes away first, and
3. The third one is where they pass away together or within 30 days from each other.

I would say that about 95% of the people that I talk to accept my suggestion that they sign a joint will with their spouses. About 5% of them, however, prefer to do a single will in which they separately deal with their estate planning and finances without their spouses, for example, in the case of a second marriage.


