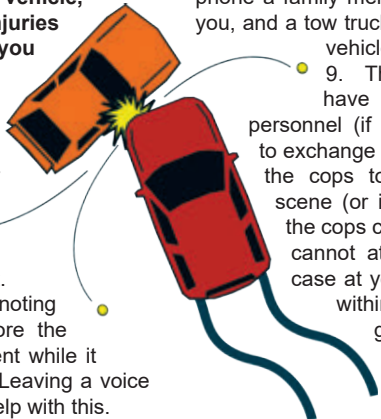


10 STEPS TO FOLLOW IN CASE OF A VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SA – A vehicle accident can be a very traumatic experience. Whether it's merely a fender bender or a serious accident in which people get injured, knowing what to do, is critical. The first thing you need to remember, is to stay calm. You will probably be in shock... So, take a moment to breath and get your thoughts together. Be vigilant and make sure that it is safe to get out of your vehicle. Check for any oncoming traffic and be aware of your surroundings as criminals sometimes deliberately cause accidents, forcing you to stop so that they can rob you.

If it's safe to get out of your vehicle, you are conscious and your injuries allow you to move around, you can follow these steps:

1. Check if anyone else at the scene has been injured.
2. If there are injuries (yourself or others), contact emergency services immediately. Make sure this number is saved on your phone or where you can easily find it.
3. Document the accident by noting exactly what happened before the accident and after the accident while it is still fresh in your memory. Leaving a voice note and taking photos can help with this.
4. Take photos of the vehicles before they are moved.
5. Get the details of the other driver(s)
 - a.) Full name and surname
 - b.) Contact details
 - c.) Make and model of the vehicle (photo!)
 - d.) Vehicle registration number (photo!)
 - e.) Physical address
 - f.) ID number



6. If there are any witnesses, get their details also. Do not leave the scene before you have taken all these steps.

7. According to *Section 61(1) (a-e) of the National Road Traffic Act, 1996 (Act No. 93 of 1996)*, it is the responsibility and duty of every driver to report an accident in which a person or animal was killed or injured immediately, or at least within 24 hours after the occurrence, and not to remove any vehicle until such removal is authorised by a police official.

8. Should your vehicle be unable to drive, phone a family member to come and collect you, and a tow truck company to collect your vehicle.

9. That means, after you have summoned emergency personnel (if needed) and made sure to exchange details, you should phone the cops to come to the accident scene (or if it's a small accident or the cops cannot be reached, or they cannot attend the scene, open a case at your nearest police station within 24 hours). Remember to get the case number!

10. Once you have a case number, call your insurance company and let them know you have been in an accident, and then some paperwork!

If you are seriously injured or unconscious, make sure you have a document in your car containing your personal and medical information. If emergency services have access to this information, it can save vital time when it comes to saving your life.

Wildfire causes havoc, claims a life

Koster/ Swartruggens/ Derby – Wildfires have hit the Koster, Swartruggens and Derby hard over the past few weeks.

According to Kgetlengriver Fire Protection Association (FPA) chairperson Hanna van der Walt, preliminary calculations indicate approximately 20,000 hectares have been affected.

In the Derby area, a labourer tragically died fighting fire on a neighbouring farm on Thursday 18 August.

The fire started at around 12:00 on a farm located on the R30. Due to strong winds, the fire spread rapidly over more than 755 hectares. Vegetable tunnels, four vehicles, a workshop with tools as well as three blowers were damaged during the fires and investigations are underway.

The Kgetlengriver FPA would like to bring the following to the community's attention:

- Please report all fires to the fire department – big or small!
- Where possible, send a pin location of where the fire is.
- Make sure that workers who assist in fighting fire have the necessary training.

Join the FPA and make sure that your membership fees are up to date. Although landowners or land

users do not have to belong to a Fire Protection Association (FPA), all landowners on whose land veldfires may start or burn or spread have legal obligations and responsibilities in terms of the National Veld Fire and Forest Act and municipal by-laws.

Please be safe. Remember a vehicle and buildings can be replaced, grass can grow again but a life cannot be replaced.

Filling station robbed, ATM bombed



Robbers bombed the ABSA ATM after stealing cash and cigarettes from the filling station shop.

Rustenburg – Armed robbers held petrol attendants at the Geelhout Park filling station at gunpoint on Tuesday 30 August before stealing money and cigarettes from the shop. Police spokesperson colonel Adele Myburgh said the robbers proceeded to bomb the ATM next to the SPAR in Geelhout Park before they fled with an undisclosed amount of cash. The incident occurred at around 02:00. “Witnesses said there were five males wearing black, all armed with firearms. Investigations continue,” Myburgh said. A man working at Engen garage’s shop

told *Platinum Weekly* that the armed men threatened the workers and forced employees to open the shop before taking the cigarettes and cash. “They were speaking in Sotho and were not wearing any balaclavas. There were more men outside and as soon as the first group robbed the shop, the others bombed the ATM,” he said. “All the suspects fled on foot. It’s a huge loss on our part but I’m thankful that nobody was hurt during the robbery because a human life is more important than anything else,” he added.

Making schools safer is a priority

Rustenburg – As part of their Safer Schools initiative, the Rustenburg Police paid a visit to Grenville High School on Tuesday 23 August. “Police and schools need to work hand in glove. Crime, violence, substance abuse, and abuse affect all aspects of our community. It’s important that we address these critical issues as well as its impact on individuals, families, and education,” said Rustenburg Police safer schools coordinator warrant officer Obakeng Moswete. Sergeant Dipuo Sebetlele spoke to the

youngsters about the prevention of gender-based violence and shared information on how to prevent teen pregnancies. She also cautioned the learners against getting too serious in relationships while they are still so young. Sergeant Moswete, who is the sector representative, was also introduced as the school’s Adopt a Cop. The Adopt a Cop programme is aimed at addressing factors that cause or enable crimes in schools and opens the channel of communication between the police, learners, and educators.

PAROLED RAPIST SENTENCED AGAIN

Tlhabane/ Rustenburg – A convicted rapist, who had been granted parole, is back behind bars after he was found guilty of committing a similar crime. On Wednesday 24 August, the Bafokeng Regional Court sentenced Kleinboy Nakana Kwele (52) to a 20-year jail term after finding him guilty of raping a woman in December 2018. Police spokesperson colonel Amanda Funani said Kwele was convicted for raping the 45-year-old woman in a December 2018 incident which occurred in Lethabong near Rustenburg. “The incident took place merely six months after the accused was released on parole,” Funani said. In his latest offence, Kwele approached two women who were collecting firewood and offered them money in exchange for sexual favours. “Both women flatly refused. He then threatened them with a knife and eventually grabbed and dragged one of them into the bushes and raped her. The matter was reported to Lethabong police and Kwele was effectively traced and arrested a few days later. It was discovered after his arrest, that he was on parole, subsequent to serving a sentence for rape he committed in 2006,” Funani added. North West provincial commissioner of police lieutenant general Sello Kwenia commended investigators from the Rustenburg Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) for their efficient work.

LENGTHY JAIL TERM FOR RAPIST

Mogwase – A man who raped and robbed a 27-year-old woman of her cellphone in 2021, was handed a hefty sentence by the Mogwase Regional Court. On Monday 15 August 2022, the court sentenced Tshepo Njikelane (34) to 15 years for rape and a further three years for robbery with aggravating circumstances. He will spend at least 15 years behind bars as the two sentences will run concurrently. Said police spokesperson captain Aafjie Botma: “The victim was walking home on Saturday afternoon, 18 September 2021, in Lerome village near Mogwase outside Rustenburg when the accused attacked, overpowered, and raped her.” The long arm of the law soon caught up with Njikelane thanks to effective investigations by sergeant Ntesang Mankheli.



FATAL ACCIDENT INVOLVING BREAD DELIVERY TRUCK

Rustenburg – A tragic accident claimed a life on the N4 in the Shylock area outside Rustenburg on Monday 29 August at approximately 20:30. A man in a Datsun Go was traveling towards Rustenburg when he collided with a bread delivery truck. ER24 responded to the scene but on arrival, the driver of the Datsun had already passed away. The driver of the truck did not sustain any injuries.

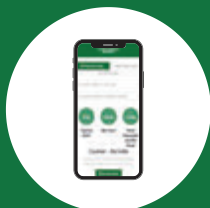

Royal Bafokeng Platinum partners with NWDoE to deliver two new schools in Rustenburg

BPlat CEO Steve Phiri said the labour union, National Union of Mineworkers envisioned building schools for the residents of Waterkloof Hills and the surrounding communities.

“The union did not demand these schools. Their members conceptualised the idea and reasoned with the company. Once we bought into their reasoning, we obliged and engaged the North West Department of Education,” he stated at the school’s official opening ceremony on 5 August 2022.

In 2019, RBPlat and the NWDoE entered into an agreement on an equal financial contribution basis to construct the much-needed primary and secondary schools. The Waterkloof Hills Primary School and Waterkloof Hills Secondary School are conveniently located within the Waterkloof Hills Estate, which is RBPlat’s flagship employee housing development in Rustenburg that offers employees ownership of quality family housing in a secure lifestyle estate.

Phiri said: “This community empowerment can best be achieved through education and the programmes that accompany that. Our investments in education over the years have included building classrooms and infrastructure, information and technology installations and upgrades, teacher development programmes, tertiary education bursaries and graduate programmes.”

The schools opened their doors in the beginning of this year (2022), with the Primary School

catering for Grades R to 4, and currently having 470 learners enrolled, and the Secondary School catering for Grades 8 and 9, with an enrolment of 375 learners. Plans are in place for additional Grades to be phased in over the next few years. The schools, which are also wheel-chair friendly, are fully equipped with state-of-the-art resources, including interactive boards with projectors, laptops for the educators, soccer fields, multi-purpose courts, multi-function rooms, science laboratories, libraries, computer rooms, sickrooms, eating halls and over 250 parking bays, amongst others. Whilst RBPlat was responsible for the successful and timeous completion of the construction of the schools, the schools will be administered by the NWDoE, as per the relevant legislative protocols.

“Our partnership with the NWDoE, has resulted in the successful construction of these two new schools, which will not only serve the children of our employees residing in Waterkloof Hills Estate, but also children from the surrounding communities. Our purpose has always been to create economic value that can be shared with all our stakeholders and this project offers a legacy of sustainable benefits, through quality education, for the next generation of leaders in our communities,” added Phiri.

The project is valued at R140-million, including buying the land at R18-million. A road between the estate and the R24 was also constructed, which was paid for by RBPlat in full. RBPlat has also committed themselves to equipping the school’s libraries with books, equipment and other learning materials. “All the new, modern technology that is necessary for libraries will be installed by RBPlat,” Phiri said.

He added: “In the mining industry, we have something called a social and labour plan – a concept whereby mining companies make a

social investment in the communities where they operate. It’s a fee they pay for their survival and protection, and not a favour. Mining companies must pay their social licence to the communities where they stay”.

Motshekga spoke about the exceptional standards of the schools and said: “This is now the benchmark for all new schools going forward.”

In his closing remarks, Phiri said: “It is now up to the Department of Education, the teaching staff, the learners, and the parents to carry this legacy forward and ensure that our children are given every opportunity to succeed. RBPlat has made a difference beyond mining – we have impacted lives and are contributing to future generations in the most impactful way possible: through education.”
