# By-law... vehicle impounded



Our company, A.E Scheepers Drilling Contractors, was promoting our services on the corner of Helen Joseph Drive and Nylrivier Avenue on Wednesday 17 August. We have been doing this for the past 42 years in and around Rustenburg. Our drilling machine was standing next to the road and some of our employees were handing out flyers to the public.

Four law enforcement officers arrived and stopped next to the truck and instructed my employees to follow them to the Traffic Department and told them that they are impounding our truck. We were told that we we're not allowed to do marketing in Rustenburg without the permission of the

We proceeded to Bergsig Academy where we pulled over asked the officers to provide us with the law where it stated we're not allowed to advertise without a permit and that it gave them the right to impound our truck. They showed us a section in the Municipal Street Trading Code, but it was not clear on how the specific code had any bearing to our truck being impounded.

We did state that we had no knowledge of such a 'law' and that we have been doing marketing like this for the past 40 years and that no one ever had any issues with it. We also asked them to provide us with a impound letter stating their reasons for impounding our truck. They said that we will receive the impound letter at the Traffic Department.

After three hours, we finally gave in and followed the officers. We were then issued with a Written Notice to appear in Court. No impound documentation was given but I was told verbally that the truck must stay with them and that after 24 hours, a storage fee will be charged. The only way I could get my truck back was to pay the R2,500 fine.

The fine stated that our borehole drilling business was conducting sale (marketing) without the permission of the local authority.

vehicle (drilling machine) because of unapproved outdoor advertising in the form of distributing handheld leaflets next to a public road.

I have considered the municipality's Outdoor Advertising By-laws 1 of 2019. As per section 2, outdoor advertisement should be approved by the municipal manager.

What is classified as an offence in terms of the By-laws? In terms of section 25 (1), any person who displays or causes or permits to be displayed or distribute an advertisement, directional sign, election material or banner in a street or other public place without having permission thereto.

Does this mean that the municipality may remove or destroy the motor vehicle (drilling machine) in terms of the above because they were distributing offensive flyers (5.1). No, they may only remove or destroy the advertisement. In terms of section 1, an advertisement is defined as;

"a representation of a product, message, was standing on the spot. So, in other words announcement in the form of a logo, picture, the truck was not the issue... it was the flyers image, sign, art, figure, drawing, fliers, posters, lighting and any other designed graphic medium that is displayed on private property, arrest the people who was handing out the municipal, regional, provincial or national flyers? Daily everywhere in and around roads and reserves within the jurisdiction of the city/council; and viewed in a public space, to inform readers or the public of a product, entertainment event, message, business, advertising boards on lamp post and next to enterprise, facility, person, headline news, activities related to public benefit projects, religious, educational, social, health, safety, security and government meetings; that is fine? Any truck or business that is doing subject to the provisions of all applicable

It would be worthy to determine whether the impounded vehicle (drilling machine) had any form of advertising displayed on it (see definition of advertisement). If the necessary documents were at the office and vehicle itself is seen as an advertisement, that they can only write the fine when we are then the municipality MAY argue that they impounded the vehicle as a result of it being an offensive advertisement and not because of the offensive handheld flyers. But, if the vehicle (it does not form part of its permanent advertisement can be removed or destroyed in terms of this section. This however has nothing to do with the distribution of flyers, but rather using the motor vehicle as a form of advertisement. Thus, if the municipality specifically stated that they are impounding the vehicle as a result of the distribution of are being prevented to do marketing for our flyers, then this argument would not hold

Also, if this argument is followed and

actions by impounding a motor around in RLM could be removed or destroyed.

Section 25(3) states that any person who places or causes to be placed a circular, handbill, directional sign, or any other advertisement on or in a vehicle in a public street or place commits an offence. I would assume that this is only applicable to 3rd party vehicles and not your OWN vehicle, although it is badly drafted and unclear. Again, if this was interpreted to be your own vehicle, it would mean that simply branding your vehicle would constitute an offence and would make it the vehicle eligible for impounding.

However, does the drilling machine form part of the advertisement. Could it be argued that the drilling machine itself was an advertisement? Then yes, they could have impounded the vehicle under this section. If they did not see the drilling machine itself as the advertisement, then they were not permitted, in terms of these by-laws, to impound the drilling machine as a reaction to the handing out of offensive flyers. (offensive flyers being flyers not permitted by the local authority)

### Attorney's fraud case postponed for mediation

**Rustenburg** – The case in which an attorney is facing charges of stealing about R700,000 from the Road Accident Fund (RAF) claimants has been postponed to 14 October 2022 for mediation

During Betty Diale's appearance before the Rustenburg Regional Court on Monday 29 August, her defence attorney pointed out their intention to provide the state with mediation proposals to settle the matter. Said National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson for the North West Henry Mamothame: "The state did not oppose the postponement and will study the proposals for consideration."

It is the state's case that Fidelity Funds, a body that oversees the conduct of attorneys, received several complaints from the RAF claimants, whose payments were deposited into Diale's trust

Claimants alleged the money did not reach them after the pay out and proceeded to report the matter to the police.

Diale was practising as an attorney during the alleged commission of the crimes from 2009 and 2011 and was subsequently charged with six counts of theft in June 2021

She cannot practice as an attorney after the Legal Practice Council struck her off the roll.




# ACCUSED MOTHER-MURDERER ON TRIAL

Said National Prosecution Authority (NPA) regional spokesperson for the North West Henry Mamothame: "Police reports reveal that Boons police were called out to a horrific murder scene in Mathopestad on Monday afternoon 9 May 2022. Upon arrival at the scene, police found Kedisaletse's body with numerous stab wounds - in their shack."



# Illegal settlement on the R24

**Rustenburg** – Portion 173 of the farm Waterkloof 305, better known as the Sonderwater settlement on the R24, just outside Rustenburg, has become a looming headache to its surrounding neighbours over the past couple of years.

This is not the settlement on the Dinie-Estates Road, which is close by. This settlement is situated on the R24, before the first circle from the mall when driving direction Johannesburg [on the left].

It's not visible from the R24 but its roots are settled firmly.

The property belongs to Born Free Investments 552 (Pty) Ltd and has been earmarked for township establishment but due to illegal occupiers, the development could not proceed.

With just a few structures erected in 2016 the 'new neighbours' aparently started becoming a problem in the area with crime and noise levels skyrocketing. Neighbouring property owners were informed by Born Free Investments' attorneys that they are aware of the situation and that the matter had been reported to the police on several occasions. Legal eviction processes commenced.

But since this initial correspondence, the number of illegal occupants increased weekly.

An eviction order was obtained by Born Free Investment in July 2017 and the illegal occupants were given 30 days to leave. In June 2019, the Rustenburg Sheriff of the High Court was given an instruction by Born Free Investment's attorneys to proceed with the eviction. The cost of the eviction at the time was estimated to be R130,000 and a deposit of R80,000 was required. The neighbouring property owners undertook to pay the deposit, but due to growing concerns about the effectiveness or the court order which was already obtained in 2017, it was

decided to rather not pay over the deposit immediately. A wise choice seeing that the court order could not be carried out, it seems.

Born Free Investments' attorneys reached out the Rustenburg Local Municipality in July 2020 informing them that there are between 180 and 200 structures on the property and that in accordance with the *Prevention of Illegal Eviction from and Unlawful Occupation of Land Act ("the PIE Act")*, the municipality had an obligation to engage in an exercise to determine the availability of alternative land for the settlement to be relocated to.

The process has since come to a standstill and the surrounding property owners have become the victims of serious health risks due to sewerage leaking into their groundwater.

The noise complaints and sewage concerns have been reported several times over the last few years – all while the settlement just keeps growing in numbers.

Platinum Weekly reached out to Born Free Investments who confirmed that a court order was sought in order to evict the unlawful occupants from the property. It subsequently transpired however that the court order was unenforceable and despite attempts to invoke the assistance from the municipality, no such assistance was forthcoming, and that they have been forced to go back to the drawing board.

"We are in the process of considering, together with our legal team, how best to deal with the matter and it is anticipated that appropriate legal steps will be taken in the not-too-distant future," director of Born Free Investments 552 Dominique Haese said.
