AN ACCIDENT WAITING TO HAPPEN

Rustenburg – This stretch of the N4 (see photo – passing through Rustenburg) is usually very busy but in the mornings and afternoons, as motorists head to work or home, the traffic volume increases exponentially.

The N4 close to the Helen Joseph off-ramp is becoming a particular area of concern. Most pedestrians cross the N4 directly, not making use of the pedestrian sidewalks which is on both sides of the bridge, or of the footbridge which is 300 metres away.

Platinum Weekly has received reports from concerned motorists who have witnessed pedestrians often duelling with death as they cross the N4.

The barricade that was constructed to prevent motorists from making U-turns has turned into a temporary 'island of safety' where pedestrians wait for their next chance to cross. Some pedestrians have already lost their lives on this stretch of the N4, one of them being a cyclist (a few years ago) who picked their bicycle up to put it on the other side of the barrier to cross the road.

It might be said that there are not enough legal places along the N4 in Rustenburg for pedestrians to cross, but... most pedestrians choose to cross the N4 directly, right next to the footbridge. This footbridge can be accessed from Moepel Avenue on the one side and Maroela Avenue on the other side. It seems that convenience is more important to some than safety.

Pedestrians crossing the N4, not only put their own lives at risk, they also risk the lives of motorists.

RLM head of communications Thapelo Matebesi said: "In terms of the Road Safety rules, pedestrians are not allowed to walk on the national road driveway. This is dangerous as national roads are busy. Pedestrians are urged to refrain from using the N4, but rather use the provided walkways and bridges when they cross the N4 national road."

Just as drivers are required to abide by specific laws, pedestrians also have a duty to follow the rules. Freeways are prohibited to pedestrians and cyclists, and those found to be walking along or across freeways can even be arrested. Are the authorities doing enough to limit this risk? Have you for instance ever seen a traffic officer fining or arresting a pedestrian?

Motorists using this stretch of road are warned to be vigilant as they are sure to encounter pedestrians who do not abide to the rules of the road and who are apparently not being held accountable for their actions.



SECURITY COMPANY tracks gunmen - five suspects arrested



Rustenburg - Geelhoutpark Spar was robbed at gunpoint on Sunday 2 October. At around closing time, 20:00, 12 robbers entered the Spar and held the people inside the shop at gunpoint.

The suspects were unsuccessful in their attempt to blow up the safe and fled the scene with cigarettes and a hand radio that belonged to Oracle Protection Services who manages the security at the SPAR. Oracle Protection Services immediately started tracking the radio which led them to a residence in Protea Park. The Quantum used during the robbery was not on the premises, but closer investigations confirmed that they were at the right place and the Rustenburg Flying Squad was called in.

Within minutes, the Flying Squad arrived, and five suspects were arrested. Some of the stolen goods were found in the house as well as Oracle's radio.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi confirmed that the suspects appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on 4 October and that they were all remanded in custody.

Rustenburg - Cellphone snatching is on the increase. According to METASEC Security Solutions general manager Morné Engelbrecht, there were two incidents on Thursday 29 September at local shopping centres.

In one of the incidents, the thieves successful, the other attempt was unsuccessful. "When people enter or exit a shop while on their mobile phones, they are usually not aware of their surroundings or on alert for thieves. Criminals take advantage of this and that is when they snatch the phones," Engelbrecht said. He added: "Even when you are in a restaurant, rather put your phone away. Criminals just wait for that one second when you are not paying

Engelbrecht shared that you should also be careful of using your phone at a traffic light, intersection or at any place where you need to stop your vehicle - and keep your windows

Children should be taught to not use their phones while outside their school yard waiting for their parents. It's a grand opportunity for cellphone snatchers to strike.

"If you are targeted, do not resist. Some of these criminals may be armed and there is a possibility that they might stab you to get your phone," Engelbrecht cautions.

Grade 11 learner drowns at Life Skills seminar

Rustenburg - A Grade 11 learner attending Michael Modisakeng Secondary School sadly lost his life in a drowning incident at Sparkling Waters Hotel on Saturday 1 October. He was attending a Life Skills Peer Education Seminar

for boys when the incident took place According to North West Education spokesperson Elias Malindi, the seminar was attended by 92 boys from Moretele and Madibeng sub-districts. Learners were engaging in different indoor activities in the morning and during lunch they were given time to play soccer. It is alleged that the learner disappeared without anyone noticing, apparently to cool off in the swimming pool. Hotel guests who were close to the swimming pool, reported to the authorities that a learner jumped in the swimming pool. The departmental officials immediately rushed to assist and got him out of the swimming pool.

They tried to save him by applying cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) while waiting for the ambulance to arrive. Unfortunately, when emergency services arrived, he was declared deceased at the scene.

The MEC for Education, Mmaphefo Matsemela conveyed her heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family. "On behalf of the department, I wish to convey our heartfelt condolences to the bereaved family and the entire community of Michael Modisakeng Secondary school."

GOAT TIED TO BICYCLE, DIES

Rustenburg/ Olifantsnek - Niel Vermaak is part of a local neighbourhood watch and immediately responded to a report of a goat in distress near Olifantsnekdam on Saturday

A man had a goat tied to his bicycle and was traveling along the R24 when Vermaak found him. It was clear that the goat was in great discomfort, so he stopped the man, untied the goat and called in the assistance of the Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

The poor animal was still alive when the SPCA arrived but died at the scene soon after.

The goat was so bloated that they initially thought it was pregnant, but a post-mortem done by a vet however confirmed that this was not the case. The post-mortem also revealed that the goat died due to hyperthermia (an abnormally high body temperature - or overheating) accompanied by suffocation/ affixation

According to Rustenburg SPCA manager Marisa Kruger, the man was an employee at a farm and was tasked with taking the goat to sell it. Kruger confirmed that they are in the process of filing charges against the owner of
