STOCK THEFT THIEVES BUSTED ON THE N4

Rustenburg/ Zeerust – Four suspects briefly appeared before the Zeerust Magistrates' Court on Monday 9 January 2023 on charges of stock theft and the possession of suspected stolen stock.

"The accused, Boikano Kamoli (26), Peter Katlego Mogotsi (19), Bradley Diketso Nonyana (28), and Agostinho Rafael Savela (33), were arrested on Friday 6 January 2023 at around 10h00 on the N4," said captain Sam Tselanyane. They were travelling in two Ford Ranger bakkies, one towing a trailer loaded with eight cattle, when they were pulled over by traffic officers along the N4 between Zeerust and Rustenburg. Upon inspection, the traffic officers called for police assistance.

Said Tselanyane: "The suspects could not give

a satisfactorily account of the livestock and it was also noticed that the brandmarks of the cattle have been tampered with. Preliminary investigations led the police to Sempe Cattle Post near Dinokana where it was discovered that one of the suspects was a shepherd at the cattle post. The livestock owners were traced, and all eight cattle were identified by their owner, valued at R100.000."

Two of the suspects, Kamoli (from Lesotho) and Savela (from Mozambique), also face charges of contravening the *Immigration Act no 13 of 2002, Section 49(1)*.

All four suspects were remanded in custody. Their next court appearance will take place on 12 January for formal bail application.

When something becomes available, they have to jump regardless of the state of the house. Most of the houses aren't animal friendly and tenants have animals which they don't want to part with. Many families are stuck between a rock and a hard place as there are landlords who don't allow children—three bedrooms or not!

> A landlord who owns several properties in the Rustenburg area said that within 30 minutes of placing a listing on social media, she had 18 requests from people who want to view the house. Over the years she has become very strict with whom she rents to and what she allows. "It's not that we have something against animals, but there are a lot of problems that come with tenants who have animals," she said.

> In many cases, it's also not always the landlord that doesn't allow the animals or children but rather a decision that was made by a body corporate of a complex. They have to take all their tenants into consideration and children playing in the streets or dogs barking can be disruptive to some residents. In other cases, the property might not be fenced off, it might be paved, or the garden might be too small, so keeping a dog on the property is not viable.

> Every coin has two sides, but those who need to rent a house in Rustenburg will have to scrape together every penny, downsize drastically or take up a property far from town.

Her brownie recipe is an old family recipe that has proven the test of time as it was passed down from her greatgrandmother.

Brownie ingredients

- 720 ml flour
- · 720 ml sugar
- 180 ml cocoa
- · 90 ml milk powder • 1/3 teaspoon baking powder
- · 115 ml water · 263 g butter
- 4 eggs
- 3/4 teaspoon vanilla essence
- 1 cup pecan nuts (optional)

Icing ingredients115 g butter

- ¼ cup cocoa
- · 3 tablespoons milk powder
- 2 to 3 tablespoons of milk
- · 1 teaspoon vanilla essence
- · 450 ml icing sugar

Method for brownies:

- 1. Sieve dry ingredients together.
- Add nuts to dry ingredients and mix
- Add butter, whisked eggs, water, and vanilla to the flour mixture and mix gently.
- 4. Bake at 150°C for 35 minutes.
