Phokeng/ Rustenburg Maithufi, who runs Victory Christian Centre, is on a mission to eradicate drugs in her community by changing the lives of young people who are caught in the grips of drug and substance abuse.

Platinum Weekly set out to find out more. Located in the Masosobane section of Phokeng, the Victory Christian Centre is a rehabilitation centre which currently caters to 76 youths who are recovering from drug and substance abuse.

Using the word of God as a lamp to light their path, Maithufi-who is also a pastorhelps the young people in her care to find a light in their darkness.

While the centre receives support from well-wishers, Maithufi always encourages recovering addicts to be self-sufficient. She believes that equipping them with the means to look after themselves is a vital component in the fight against drug and substance abuse.

"Many unemployed young people lose hope and end up turning to drugs," said Maithufi. "I talk to them, counsel them. and encourage them with the word of God. Additionally, they are also given activities from which they can learn."

Maithufi empowers them with skills in poultry farming, gardening, and bricklaying, which might enable them to establish self-employment projects after they have completely rehabilitated. The young people take turns to maintain a thriving garden that produces spinach, cabbages, and other vegetables of their choice. A total of 20 chickens, that make up a poultry project, also ensures that there is a constant supply of eggs for everyone during breakfast.

"Within a week of eating healthy food and living without drugs you can notice positive changes because they can sleep better, their appetite is better, and they slowly start to adopt a more positive attitude towards life," Maithufi said.

The young people in her care affectionately refer to Maithufi as 'mama'-which is a gesture of gratitude, love, and respect for the positive role that she is playing in their lives.

BE PART OF MAKING OUR ROADS SAFER

Rustenburg - Reckless drivers need to be held accountable and you can assist. The Rustenburg Traffic Department has a system in place where you can report careless drivers who refuse to obey the traffic rules. Platinum Weekly communicated with Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) head of traffic services Lydia Mangope to find out how the community can assist in making our roads safer. According to Mangope, if you spot a reckless driver, you can contact the Rustenburg Traffic Department's control room and report the driver. The case will then be allocated to an officer who will then attend to the complaint. Take photos or videos and make sure that you have the date, time, and location of the incident that you can provide as proof of your complaint. Next time you see someone not obeying traffic rules such as skipping a robot or traffic sign-or committing any dangerous act in a vehicle-follow them and take a picture of their registration number plate. You can also take a video if you see someone driving under the influence of alcohol.

CIT ROBBERS UNDER POLICE GUARD

Brits - Four suspects involved in a cash-in-transit (CIT) heist that occurred near Brits on Monday 30 January 2023 are set to appear in court. The four, who are facing charges of attempted murder, the possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition, as well as possession of stolen property, have been arrested. The suspects are currently recovering from injuries under police guard in a local hospital.

This follows the incident on Monday where the suspects blew up a CIT van along the R556 in Mmaditlhokwa near Brits, after using a vehicle to crash into it, forcing the van to a halt. Two security guards were shot and injured during the incident, and the suspects fled with an undisclosed amount of money. Police spokesperson colonel Athlenda Mathe said the four were arrested along the R511 after an intelligence-driven operation by the Brits Trio Task Team and Crime Intelligence Officers had been activated. "The four were found travelling in a Hyundai H1. A shootout ensued which led to their arrests. The suspects were also found in possession of an undisclosed amount of money," Mathe said.

The police will liaise with the medical team treating the suspects to establish when they will be medically fit to appear in court. Further investigations are still underway, and the police are currently in pursuit of more suspects linked to the incident.



Maithufi decided to register Victory Christian Centre as an NPO in February 2014 after she was moved by the plight of those who are battling drug addiction. Drugs such as marijuana, nyaope, crystal meth, and cocaine are ever present in her community and easily tempt the youth to open the door to selfdestruction. Therefore, after working as a financial manager

decided to leave her desk and set up the centre where she devotes all her energy towards creating drug-free communities. "Drug abuse is a huge problem in Phokeng, Tlhabane, and she said. A former drug addict, who is now a caretaker at the centre, is grateful for the help he used drugs for 15 years. I advise young people to turn to God, pray, and get help as I did," he said. The Victory Christian Centre is equipped with a security fence that makes it virtually impossible for anyone to venture outside the premises, whereas the housing units of the recovering addicts are provided with bedding and television sets and are supplied with water from JoJo tanks. "Many of the young people in our care were brought to us by their parents or guardians, who pay an initial registration fee of R2.250-which also includes the first month's stay-after which a monthly fee of R2,000 is paid every month. The rehabilitation period depends on the individual's progress, and relatives are welcome to visit them at appointed times. We welcome anyone, even those who might not be able to afford the fee, to come and seek help," added Maithufi. African National Congress (ANC) ward six councillor Sipho Tause has acknowledged the impactful role of the rehabilitation centre and is using his influence to support the initiative. "I have written a letter to governmental departments so that they can assist with the rehabilitation

process," Tause said, "I'm also going to liaise with the South African Police Services (SAPS) so that they can conduct more awareness campaigns in areas where drug abuse is rife.'


CONCERN OVER CHILDREN SUSTAINING BURNS

Rustenburg – Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital (JST) is concerned with the high number of children that have been admitted to the health facility after sustaining burns. A total of 61 patients aged from six months to 12 years have been admitted to the hospital's children's wards for burn-related cases between January 2022 and January 2023.

A nurse at JST Hospital, sister Hope Banda, said that the most prevalent causes of burns displayed by children admitted to the ward are thermal and electrical burns. "These are burns from flames, or liquids such as tea, or from hot surfaces such as stoves," Banda said.

She advised that as soon as a child gets burnt, parents or caregivers should avoid applying banana peels, toothpaste, and fermented maize meal, as such applications could aggravate the burnt area and cause infection. She encouraged the use of cold water to cool the affected skin area with a clean cloth as an effective way of avoiding infection. Banda also underlined the importance of taking the victim to the nearest clinic for further treatment and management of burns.

She encouraged parents and caregivers to prevent potential burns of children by ensuring that electric cords and handles of hot pots and pans should not be within



reach of children.

Banda further pointed out that paraffin and other chemicals used for cleaning must be locked in a safe place that cannot be accessed by children. She said that parents should also ensure that all wall plugs are switched off and covered when not in use, as it is an effective way of avoiding potentially dangerous situations for children.

ARMED RESPONDER KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY

Rustenburg – A 24-year-old armed responder lost his life in the line of duty when he responded to a call out on Sunday 29 January 2023.

According to North West police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh, five suspects were robbing a supermarket in Rustenburg when one of the employees pressed the panic button. The victim, who was employed at a local security company, responded to the scene where he found the suspects exiting the shop.

A shootout ensued during which he was fatally shot. It's alleged that one of the suspects was also shot but that he managed to get away. A case of murder and business robbery is being investigated.






Teamwork gets the goods back

Moedwil/ Rustenburg – Teamwork led to the recovery of stolen cellphone tower batteries on Thursday 26 January 2023.

Rudolf de Kock, a member of National Crime Assist (NCA) was busy working in the Moedwil area outside Rustenburg when a message requesting assistance came through. The message stated that there was a GWM double cab bakkie travelling on the N4 towards Rustenburg that was suspected of being involved in the theft of cellphone tower batteries near Zeerust. De Kock then confirmed that he would be on the lookout for the bakkie.



Around 11:41 the vehicle passed him on the N4 and De Kock set

chase. He was soon joined by police and together they managed to force the suspects off the road. A shootout ensued, and the three armed men fled the scene. Further backup from the NCA, a helicopter, and a K9 unit responded to track the suspects—unfortunately without success. North West police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh confirmed that a case was opened in Motswedi. The owner of the batteries was identified, and 12 batteries, as well as the suspects' vehicle have been recovered. The batteries will be handed back to the owner and the matter is under investigation.
