Health services back to normal as STRIKE ENDS



North West MEC for Health Madoda Sambatha said that the constitutional right to life has to be upheld.

Rustenburg – The nationwide strike by the National Education Health and Allied Workers' Union (NEHAWU) which started on Monday 6 March 2023 not only left a wake of destruction in various parts of the country, it is said to have cost lives. At several hospitals, health services were severely disrupted and access to people in need of medical care were denied.

North West MEC of Health Madoda Sambatha reached out to hospitals in our area to try and limit the affects of the strike on service delivery.

An agreement reached between government and NEHAWU on Wednesday, 15 March [of which the details was not yet made public at the time of going to print] brought an end to the strike.

A wage dispute triggered the NEHAWU strike. The union's demands related to the 2022 wage increase of 3%, which was apparently unilaterally implemented by the government. The unions demanded 10%, 3% on top of the rate of inflation, which is 7%.

The North West was fortunately less affected by the nationwide strike. However, not all local hospitals completely escaped the turmoil. On the 9th of March Moses Kotane Hospital's entrance was blocked for several hours before protesters gave access to people in need of medical attention.

North West MEC of Health Madoda Sambatha addressed the media on Friday 10 March at the at Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital (JST) where he said that the right to life—during any protest activity—has to be upheld.

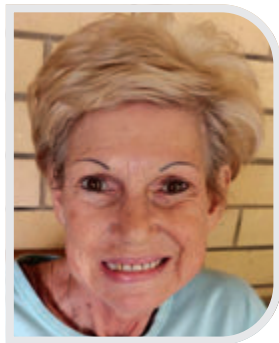

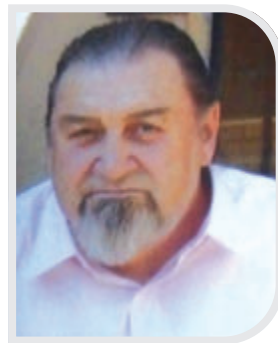

Marikana murder case removed from court roll

Mogwase – A case in which 17 people accused of murder and other serious offences committed in Marikana in 2012, has been removed from the court roll. The ruling was made on Friday 10 March 2023 by acting judge Andrew Reddy during a High Court sitting in the Mogwase Regional Court. In his judgement, Reddy highlighted the rights of the accused to have a fair trial, the interest of the families of the deceased, and the plight of the witnesses in the matter. However, Reddy pointed out that the removal of this matter is not a verdict but merely a pause to await the outcome of the review application registered by the accused persons. According to National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson for the North West Henry Mamothame, the judge also indicated that copies of the judgement would be shared with the Judge President of the North West High Court, Judge President of the Gauteng High Court Division, National Director of Public Prosecutions, Director of Public Prosecutions in the North West, and the office of the State Attorney in Pretoria. Reddy hopes that this will expedite the conclusion of the review application.

"The accused are charged with seven counts of murder, four of malicious damage to property, four of robbery, three for unlawful possession of firearms, and three for unlawful possession of ammunition," said Mamothame.

"These charges are related to the labour disputes between mine workers of Lonmin Karee Mine and Impala Platinum Mine (Implats) and their employers when they participated in unprotected wage strikes in Marikana in 2012 which led to the loss of lives and damage to property," he added. One of the accused is currently serving a life sentence for a murder related to the wage strike in Marikana.

• On Tuesday 16 August 2012 tragic events in Marikana left 44 people dead and many injured. Among the victims were 34 mineworkers who were shot and killed by police during a wildcat strike at Lonmin Mine for better wages. Prior to the event, ten people had also lost their lives, including six mine workers, two Lonmin security guards, and two SAPS members.

Rustenburg – A wage dispute triggered the NEHAWU strike. The union's demands related to the 2022 wage increase of 3%, which was apparently unilaterally implemented by the government. The unions demanded 10%, 3% on top of the rate of inflation, which is 7%.

The North West was fortunately less affected by the nationwide strike. However, not all local hospitals completely escaped the turmoil. On the 9th of March Moses Kotane Hospital's entrance was blocked for several hours before protesters gave access to people in need of medical attention.

North West member of the executive council of Health Madoda Sambatha addressed the media on Friday 10 March at the at Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital (JST) where he said that the right to life—during any protest activity—has to be upheld.

"On the 9th of March at the Moses Kotane Hospital, we had to tell protestors who had blocked the entrance of the hospital to protest peacefully and not to prevent health service delivery," Sambatha said, "We are dealing with two constitutional rights, namely the right to protest and the right to healthcare—one constitutional right should not affect the other."

While Sambatha's statement aimed to calm the issue, it should be noted that emergency services were reported to have been blocked during the strike at Moses Kotane Hospital.

In light of the situation, JST chief executive officer Gloria Tlhabi, reported better tidings as JST had not been affected by the strike. Tlhabi said that they were

prepared for the strike's arrival at the hospital and had put security measures in place. Fortunately, none of the hospital's services were affected as staff members kept to their scheduled duties. "Although we had to recall outpatients and their escort nurses from other hospitals, they returned unaffected and their treatment will be rescheduled," said Tlhabi.

On Monday 13 March, the Labour Appeal Court issued an order interdicting essential services workers from participating in the strike, but the union maintained that it would continue to disrupt public services until its demands were met.

Fortunately, by Wednesday 15 March a press release from NEHAWU was the first indication of an end to the chaos: "Our members and workers have demonstrated their commitment to defend their rights and the collective bargaining, appreciating the dire implications of the persistence of this tendency in the broader public sector as well as the private sector. It is within this background that the union is now announcing the suspension of the public service strike."

To this effect, a Public Service Co-ordinating Bargaining Council (PSCBC) special council on wage negotiations was convened on Wednesday at 15:00 to process the settlement agreement together with salary adjustment for the financial year 2023/24. NEHAWU said that it would keep its members informed on the developments and called on all its members and workers at the picket lines to prepare for an orderly return to work.

Safer City campaign a success

Rustenburg – The Rustenburg Police, including members from the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM), provincial traffic, public safety, the fire brigade, and various other stakeholders conducted a 'Safer City' crime prevention operation on Wednesday 8 March 2023.

The operation began with a briefing at the Civic Centre at 08:00 where Rustenburg station commander Brigadier Joël Pheto and other senior police officers addressed the participants on the objectives of the operation. Thereafter, non-compliant and bi-law inspections were conducted at various premises, including 15 business premises of which four were charged for non-compliance.

Said Rustenburg police spokesperson Elsabé Augoustides: "Five undocumented persons were also arrested during the operation, and the public fines issued by traffic officials totalled more than R12,000."

Certifying documents

Rustenburg – The prevention of crime and the investigation thereof, is the core function of the South African Police Service (SAPS). However, the certification of documents also forms part of the scope of services rendered to the public. Many people who visit the police station in Rustenburg, come from other towns in our district meaning that the demand for certifications is ever increasing. To ensure that the demand is met, Rustenburg SAPS have availed a side entrance for those who queue outside for certification. The new entrance ensures that the queue is in the shade, adjacent to the main building. Certification is done as a secondary function and the public's cooperation in this regard is of the utmost importance.

While the crime in the central business district area is of a main concern, understandably members on patrol will focus on preventing robberies and other serious crimes in this area.

Alternatively, members of the public can have documents certified at the following places:

- Lawyers or notary public (who are members of a recognised professional legal body)
- Actuaries or accountants (who are members of a recognised professional body)
- Members of the judiciary
- Other state departments, such as Home Affairs, the Rustenburg Local Magistrate's Court, the Post Office, as well as directors, managers, or company secretaries of a bank or regulated financial services providers.

While nobody will be refused assistance, you might have to wait longer for services as members appointed in terms of the Police Act will be attending to crime prevention duties. A floor manager is appointed on each shift who will be moving up and down the queue to ensure that those who are there for purposes of affidavits, registering of dockets, as well as reporting of accidents, clearances, and expungement, will be channelled to ensure the streamlining of the queue.

Preference will be given to elderly, pensioners, disabled members of the community, visibly injured people who are challenged to walk or remain standing for long periods of time, expectant mothers, as well as those who have obvious mental and psychological challenges.

The certification of copies is done free of charge.

Furthermore, you are requested to provide your own copies as SAPS cannot use the station's resources to make copies for members of the public. Copies will not be certified if the original document is not produced for verification purposes.

Rustenburg Station Commander, brigadier Joël Pheto expresses his gratitude to the public for its understanding, as the station remains committed to the rendering of a professional service to the Community, prioritizing the prevention of crime.

Combatting copper cable theft

Rustenburg – The South African Police Services (SAPS) are leaving no stone unturned in their objective to eradicate the theft of copper and other non-ferrous metals.

On Tuesday 14 March 2023 North West police's crime prevention unit hosted an awareness campaign on copper and non-ferrous metals at the Rustenburg Civic Centre. Representatives from Eskom, Vodacom, MTN, the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) and other stakeholders were also present.

Deliberations focused on the theft of non-ferrous metals as a serious crime which has adverse effects on the economy. Scrap metal dealers are urged to not purchase their goods from suspicious parties, and community members are encouraged to report copper theft to the police.

Goodbye to Afrikaans?

Rustenburg – The Portfolio Committee on Basic Education held public hearings on the Basic Education Laws Amendment (BELA) bill in the North West province this past weekend.

The committee paid a visit to three districts in the province and invited individuals and organisations to come and share their views on the Bill.

The first meeting kicked off in Rustenburg on Friday 10 March 2023 at the Rustenburg Civic Centre.

The other two public consultations in the North West took place in Mahikeng on 11 March and 12 March 2023. Consultations also took place earlier this year in Limpopo and the Free State.

In **Rustenburg**, the long queue to register trailed out of the door. Inside, various organisations, school representatives and community members had the opportunity to give their opinion on the proposed amendments the Portfolio Committee panel.

Some of the key amendments to the Bill aim to include:

- Making Grade R the new compulsory school starting age, as opposed to Grade 1.
- Forcing home-schooled learners to register for this type of schooling.
- Criminalising parents who do not ensure their child or children are in school, with fines or jailtime up to 12 months.
- Holding school governing bodies more accountable for disclosures of financial interests, including those related to their spouses and family members.
- Prohibiting educators from conducting business with the state or being a director of public or private companies conducting

- business with the state.
- Abolishing corporal punishment and initiation/hazing practices.
- Allowing schools to sell alcohol outside of school hours.
- **Giving government department heads power over language policies and the curriculums a school must adopt.**

With regard to language, the power of a school's student governing body (SGB) may be removed—if the bill passes.

The Department of Basic Education defines the role of the SGB as follows: A SGB must ensure that the school is governed in the best interest of all the stakeholders. All SGB members must always put the best interest of the school before any personal interests. The South African Schools Act stipulates that a SGB must:

- Promote the best interest of the school and ensure its development.
- Adopt a constitution setting on how the SGB will operate.
- Adopt a mission statement for the school.
- Adopt a code of conduct for learners at the school which sets out disciplinary procedures.
- Help the principal, educators, and other staff members to perform their professional functions.
- **Decide on school policy which should include admissions, language, and finance.**
- Administer and control the property of the school, buildings, and grounds.
- Encourage parents, learners, educators, and other staff members at the school, to offer voluntary services to the school.

According to the national representative

organisation for governing bodies of South African schools (**FEDSAS**), two of the proposed amendments give provincial education heads of departments the power to make a final decision on a school's policy on admission and language. FEDSAS has pointed out that both these amendments go directly against the principle of cooperative governance on which the model for public schools was built.

"At the heart of this matter is the fact that public schools are built on a model of cooperative governance. A school community in the form of a governing body is supposed to manage a school within the legal framework with little interference from the State. The continued existence of this model, and with it parents' input into their children's education, is on the line," FEDSAS said.

Platinum Weekly spoke to a few residents who waited to register to hear their opinions on the planned changes.

- Here are some of the comments we received:
- "I think we should give this bill a chance to see if it will improve our education system."
 - "I don't think they should allow alcohol to be sold at the school. Taverns shouldn't even be close to the schools as kids are very vulnerable. Why would we want to give them easy access. It's a no from me."
 - "We are strongly opposed against the bill. We cannot allow government department heads to have the power over language policies. They cannot have the power to decide what will be best for my child. The power needs to stay with the student governing body (SGB) of the school. They are the direct link between the school, the parents, and the learners."
 - "If you take away the power of the SGB to

decide the language, the government can decide in what language my child must be educated. My child is Afrikaans and I want him to learn in Afrikaans."

- "Anything that is run by the state is a mess, I don't want the government to make a mess of my child's education by taking away the power of the SGB."

It became clear that parents who have kids in Afrikaans schools are concerned that should government department heads have the power to decide on the language of schools, their children will no longer be able to go to Afrikaans schools.

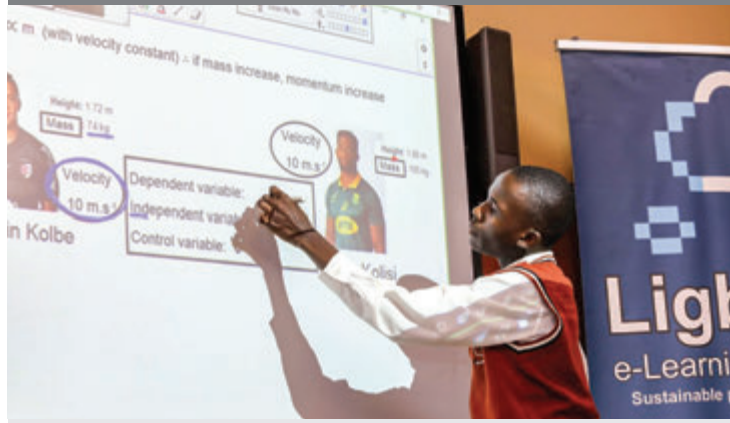

Glencore Ferroalloys partners with Ligbron eLearning to improve Rustenburg school results

Rustenburg – Mathematics and physical science are regarded as the two most crucial gateway subjects to take in high school as they can be key in setting up students for success, no matter which career path they choose. However, in recent years there has been a decrease in the number of students who select these two subjects. In 2022, The Outlier reported that only one in three Grade 12 students wrote mathematics and only one in four wrote science in the 2021 National Senior Certificates Exams.

These are one of the many reasons that prompted Glencore Ferroalloys' Boshhoek Smelter operation, together with the Department of Education to introduce the Ligbron e-Learning System to local schools in and around Glencore operations in Boshhoek and Macharora.

The Ligbron e-Learning System, which is the first in the North West Province, connects schools all over South Africa into an online learning network to live stream mathematics and science lessons using video conferencing and desktop sharing.

In South Africa, mathematics is a compulsory subject, but learners can choose to do mathematical literacy, a practical alternative to pure mathematics. However, mathematical literacy is not accepted for most STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) studies in tertiary institutions.

The Boshhoek Smelter CSR and investment strategy is to focus on the areas of social and community development, infrastructure, education, health and wellness, school sports development, arts and culture as well as local business development initiatives.

At the official launch at Charora High School situated in Robega village near Rustenburg, Glencore Ferroalloys' chief community and social responsibility officer, Conroy van der Westhuizen, encouraged the learners to embrace the subjects head-on and not let any negative views deter them from following their dreams. "Education is something very close to me, and as a previous schoolteacher, I understand the importance of these two subjects. More importantly, I understand how, when one embraces certain subjects, they liberate learners, inspiring and paving the way for others. I am indeed proud to stand here today on behalf of an organisation that believes in investing in future generations, and if one child benefits from this programme, that means the lives of one family progress, which means our communities will progress too," said Van Der Westhuizen.

The Ligbron e-Learning System continues to showcase its significant impact in various schools around South Africa, with one school in Mpumalanga growing from 19% to 85% matric pass rate.

NW government takes action to repair, maintain, and upgrade roads

North West – A massive routine roads maintenance plan will be rolled out on critical surface and gravel roads across all four districts of the province. This was revealed by premier Kaobitsa Bushy Maape while delivering the 2023 State of the Province Address at the official opening of the North West Provincial Legislature.

Maape said a total of R13 billion has been set aside by the Infrastructure South Africa (ISA) through the Presidency, which will be used for maintenance and upgrading of 39 rural roads projects in the province.

"The bulk of this amount, along with the R1,3 billion maintenance and upgrading budget set aside by the province, will be earmarked specifically for rural roads projects, most of which will be labour intensive paved roads, thus creating job opportunities," premier Maape said.

Other roads projects the premier highlighted during his address include the one between Sun City and Pilanesberg National Park to the tune of R61 million, and Haartebeesfontein to Ottsodal at R149 million. He said that work on the Lichtenburg to Koster road, and a

portion of the road connecting Koster and Derby to Magaliesberg, will also commence this year.

"As a contribution towards addressing the flood damaged roads in the province, an amount of over R100 million was received in late November 2022, and consultants have been appointed for the upgrading of a 12km road, D39 from Mooifontein to Lombaardslaagte, using paving bricks," premier Maape pronounced.

The Department of Public Works and Roads has been introducing contractors and conducting sod-turning activities in various areas across the province including the Nelson Mandela Drive Road project in Mahikeng where the contractor has already taken site to rehabilitate this main road at a cost of R50 million. The new rehabilitation project of the road from Hartbeespoortdam and Phelindaba to Gauteng boarder is the biggest projects the department has awarded this financial year. The premier said that this project of more than R600 million will contribute towards an increase in economic and tourism activities in our province.

Rustenburg – The Vroue Landbou Unie (VLU) Volmoed hosted an informative presentation by well-known environmentalist and author Vincent Carruthers at the Oppiberg Campgrounds on Thursday 9 March 2023.

Carruthers who is the author of well-known publications such as *The Magaliesberg*, and *Cradle of Life: The Story of the Magaliesberg and the Cradle of Humankind*, took the opportunity to share his extensive knowledge on the diversity of natural and heritage interests in the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve.

While guests tucked into snacks made by VLU Volmoed members, Carruthers delved into the wonders of the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve and said that its history, geology, and biodiversity are some of its most unique characteristics.

For example, the Cradle of Humankind within the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve includes sites of archaeological interest which dates back millions of years and is a one of the world's most important resources for understanding the history of humankind.

The Magaliesberg Mountain Range—which formed approximately 2,000 million years ago—extends from the north of the Gauteng province to the south of Pilanesberg in the North West province. The mountain range provides a multitude of habitats and ecological niches, as well as micro-climates that support a vast array of plant and animal life in the Magaliesberg Biosphere.

The Magaliesberg Biosphere lies at the boundary of two distinct South African biomes, namely grassland and savanna biomes. A biome refers to the plants and animals that occur naturally in an area, often sharing common characteristics specific to that area. "What makes the Magalies Biosphere so unique is that the two biomes blend together," said Carruthers, "The exceptional assemblage of flora and associated fauna of the biosphere is well recognised."

He further elaborated on the variety of plants including the everlasting plant, as well as animals like the elephant shrew, and the variety of fungal species that can be found in the biosphere.
